# **Rodeo Affiliation Policy**

#### Purpose:

The National Rodeo Association (NRA) aims to assist affiliated associations and their committees and other bodies and committees in promoting competitive and professional rodeos. The purpose of this Policy is to ensure that affiliated rodeos do not adversely impact each other, due to timing and location, and that priority is given to those rodeos that benefit the majority of the members.

#### Policy Statement:

This policy will apply to all rodeos affiliated with the National Rodeo Association. When considering the affiliation of a rodeo the following underlying principles shall apply:

- 1. Each state in Australia will be considered a separate region for the purposes of rodeo affiliation except for Queensland which will be broken in to three separate regions (Northern, Central and Southern) as per Attachment 1.
- 2. Super All Round and All-Round Rodeos will be given preference over all other rodeos (Points Award Rodeo or Bull Rides) as they cater for the majority of the NRA members.
- 3. No other rodeos will be affiliated in the same region against an All-Round Rodeo that has already been affiliated in that region unless competitors can easily compete at both events and the location of the event will not adversely impact the promotion of the All-Round Rodeo.
- 4. Where a Points Award Rodeo or Bull Ride is already affiliated in a region an All-Round Rodeo can be affiliated against it but the Points Award Rodeo or Bull Ride will not be affected regardless of the timing. As long as the Points Award Rodeo or Bull Ride keeps the same date from year to year then they will not lose that date to an All-Round Rodeo.
- 5. There is no restriction on the number of Points Award Rodeos and Bull Rides that can be affiliated on the same date in the same region.
- 6. A Non-Points Rodeo can be affiliated against any other rodeo in a region.

#### Implementation:

The Executive Board of the National Rodeo Association will ensure that all rodeo affiliations are done in compliance with this policy. Where a variation to this policy is requested, this can only be approved by a majority vote of the Executive Board.

## Definitions:

Super All Round Rodeo	Includes a minimum of five standard Men's events (Bull Ride, Saddle Ride, Bareback Ride, Rope & Tie and Steer Wrestling), two standard Ladies events (Barrel Race and Breakaway Roping) and Team Roping with a minimum prizemoney of \$1500 per event. Competitors receive full points and a half to event titles and all-round titles.
All Round Rodeo	Includes a minimum of five standard Men's events (Bull Ride, Saddle Ride, Bareback Ride, Rope & Tie and Steer Wrestling), two standard Ladies events (Barrel Race and Breakaway Roping) and Team Roping with a minimum prizemoney of \$750 per event. Competitors receive full points to event titles and all-round titles.
Points Award Rodeo	Includes a minimum of three or more standard events with a minimum of \$750 prizemoney per event. Competitors receive half points to event titles only.
Bull Ride	Includes Open Bull Ride, Novice Bull, and U18 Junior Bull Ride with a minimum of \$2250, \$500 and \$250 prizemoney respectively. Competitors receive half points to event titles only.
Non-Points Rodeo	Any other rodeo promotion that does not meet any of the other rodeo criteria.
