RULES.

1. There shall be two (2) or more timekeepers, a field Judge and a Barrier Judge.
2. Arena conditions determine length of barrier which is set by Director prior to commencement of the event. Calf is accepted as sound and released on contestant's first call or signal.
3. Animal's used for this event to be inspected by a Director of the S.E.Q.R.A. or an official of the S.E.Q.R.A. and stock must be approx. 100kg live weight minimum and be score 3 calves in condition. Larger cattle or calves may be used subject to inspection and unsuitable stock, i.e. unhealthy stock, to be rejected.
4. One (1) rope only will be permitted and, should contestant miss with first cast of the rope she must retire, and no time will be allowed. Roping calf without releasing loop from hand is not permitted.
5. Rope is to be tied to saddle horn with heavy duty string. Bright ribbon must be attached to the end of the rope which is attached to the saddle horn and such ribbon's dimensions to be approximately 12" long by 1 1/2" wide.
6. Loop must pass over calf's nose and head, half head acceptable to be a legal catch. If steers are used for this event, a horn catch is acceptable.
7. The Flag Judge will flag the contestant when the rope breaks away from the saddle horn.
8. Contestant shall receive no time should she break the rope from the saddle horn by hand or by touching rope or string after catch is completed.
9. A ten (10) second penalty will apply if barrier is broken.
10. There will be a thirty (30) second time limit on this event.
11. Arena must be cleared of loose stock.
12. Director of event can direct person releasing stock from chute to release calf if, in the opinion of the Director, competitor has had sufficient opportunity to take head of stock out.
13. Contestants may only wear spurs which are fitted with blunt rowels which are not completely locked.
14. Prodding - No continual prodding of animal will be allowed while animal is in chute. Prodding to only be allowed in either the shoulder or rump of the animal. Electric prods - these should be powered by battery or dynaro and should be of a type approved by the Standards Association of Australia.

DISQUALIFICATIONS.

- Not having made a catch within time limit allowed.
- Failing to answer third call by chute boss.
- Riding with locked or sharp rowels.
- Cheating with calves or position of calves in the chute.
- Once contestant misses calf with maximum of one cast she is allowed, she will be disqualified.
- Roping calf without releasing loop from hand.
- Ill treating stock.
- Altercation with Judge's or Officials of the Rodeo Committee or Board members.

1. If a horse is considered to have been marked by a competitor, the two officiating Judge's and the event Director will examine the animal and assess the extent of marking and its cause. Should a decision be made that the animal has been marked due to negligence on behalf of the competitor, then said competitor will be subject to disqualification and/or a fine which will be decided by the two Judges and event Director in accordance with the circumstances relating there to.
2. Re Saddle Ride and Bareback - The Centre of the front girth must be a minimum of 6" wide. The back cinch on saddles must have a space from the front to the back cinch so that the back cinch does not go into the horses flank.
3. When a competitor is awarded a re-ride/re-run in any event, his re-ride/re-run head of stock will be the first turn-out animal after such re-ride/re-run has been awarded.
4. Bareback Pads must go from "D to "D and have a 4" X 6" piece of leather under the Bareback Rigging.
5. Barrier Judge cannot compete in any event he is Barrier Judging.
6. Riding competitors will be able to Judge providing they arrange for a Qualified Judge to Judge in their place, Bareback, Saddle Ride, Bull Ride.
7. If a competitor is on the grounds and turns out his head of stock a Director will bring his reason to the next Board Meeting, the Board will then bring a fine if thought appropriate. In this case the Stock Contractor will be paid and the added entry will go to prize money.
8. All nominations from members MUST be written. It will be Judged if they are late by the date on the post stamp.
9. If there is a difference of 0.5sec or more in a girls time in the Barrel Race she is to receive a re-run.
10. When a watch fails the competitor has the option of taking the time off one watch, before they are told the time, or have a re-run.
11. Horses to be a minimum height of 14 hands at (3) score condition or at the Directors discretion .
12. The time shall be taken in time events when the barrier breaks off the neck of the head of stock.
13. Calf Roping Flag Judge to be issued with a stop watch, which will be used to determine the five (5) seconds clear tie period.
14. The decision of a foul barrier will be left to the discretion of the Barrier Judge.
15. Only points won in events where all Junior members are eligible to ride be awarded toward Junior Championship.
16. In the event of the ribbon becoming detached from the steer, in the Steer Undecorating, when the competitor has incurred (10) second penalty the resulting re-run time to have (10) second penalty included.
17. Local Riders may do one free rodeo per year, at his/her home town without paying day membership.
18. In riding events a refund of all stock leavey of nomination fee to be paid to competitor if second head of re-ride stock fails to perform to the Judges satisfaction.
19. In the event a head of stock has to be destroyed at a rodeo, the stock contractor will be paid Sale Yard Price.
20. The Barrier Judge, chute Boss and Director in charge of the event on the day, has the right to release any head of stock after competitor has been warned for undue delay in calling for their head of stock to be released.
21. After a certain date near the end of the rodeo season, new competitors may do the last ten (10) rodeos of the season on day membership.
