BARRIER JUDGES AND JUDGES RULE REGARDING BARRIER JUDGING.

A Judge is a Barrier Judge and there is five appointed barrier judges to relive judges at anytime during a rodeo. THEY ARE. Daryl Cavanagh, Ian Allen, Don Stevenson, John Wallace, Bub Kennedy. This is to take effect from June 1985. members disregard April 1983, page 4, paragraph 3 newsletter.

A BARRIER JUDGE'S DUTIES.

A barrier Judge acts in an official capacity at a rodeo to decide on all ruling which may arise in time event box. The Barrier Judge has the final say in matters in this regard, please note that during the event of ladies steer undecorating, the barrier judge is not only in control of the Barrier decisions, but also any decisions relating to what happens in the arena during the Competitors run.
