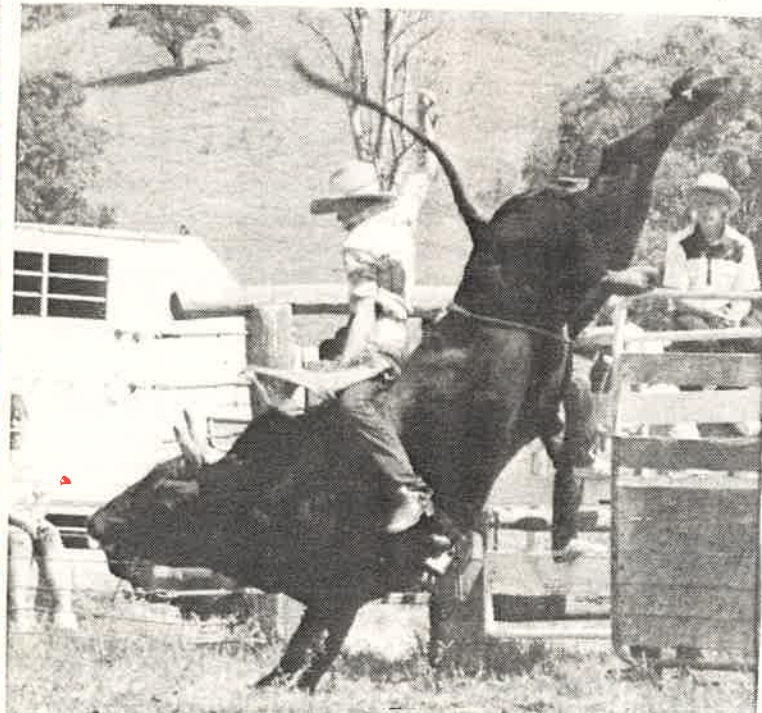

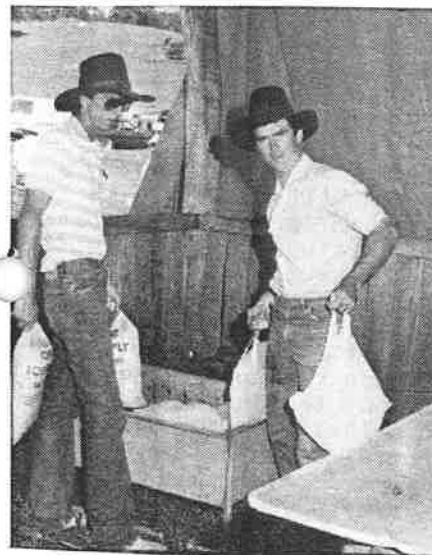

# Our Adventurous Princess...



How many of you have ever experienced a white Christmas? How many of you have ever been to Canada for a 7 week holiday at the age of 13? Well, I'm Nikki Percival, your rodeo princess; and I've been there and done that!

I departed Brisbane on the 6th December 1986 at a temperature of about 32<sup>o</sup>, only to arrive in Vancouver, Canada at a teeth chattering, frozen limbed, knees knocking temperature of -5<sup>o</sup>. On arrival in Vancouver, I saw the remains of the Expo '86 sight. Some

people, like the Japanese were still dismantling their exhibition but some buildings will remain as tourist attractions. From there I travelled on to Fort McMurray, Alberta where I lived with my Uncle and Aunt for 6 weeks. I attended school while staying there and found it to be an interesting experience to see a different nationality at work. They were different in many ways to our cultures. One example of this would be that instead of taking a school bag to school, they take their lunch in a brown paper bag and carry their books under their arm. Talk about weird! I lived an extremely hectic life while in Fort McMurray. I went skiing, ice skating, curling, tobogganing, horse riding, and to school social activities like discos. I spent Christmas here too; it was an extremely white one.

From here I travelled by bus for 5 hours before reaching Edmonton where I went shopping at the largest shopping centre in the world: West Edmonton Mall. It has it's own fantasy land which is as large as Dreamworld, and this is in the actual shopping centre. It was fantastic; pity we don't have things like that here in Australia. I travelled on in the bus for a further 2½ hours to Calgary. I stayed at a farm about 5km outside of Calgary for a couple of days. I went riding at night on what I call a poor excuse for a horse. They had hair on them about 2 inches thick. Guess what they say about our horses! They say they're wimps because we rug them during winter, and our coldest weather is like their hottest during winter. While staying here, I asked the owner if he knew any Australians over in Canada. He said, "Yeh, Frank Green, The Man From Down Under That Spurs Like Thunder." I thought it quite amusing, but appropriate. While in Calgary I could see the tough, cowboy image personified here. It is portrayed throughout the city in a number of ways. Everybody wore western gear around the streets, except for the business men.

Even though I was in Canada during the non-rodeo season, I was interested to see the location for the Calgary Stampede. It takes place in the Saddle Dome, which is situated in Stampede Park. I think the Saddle Dome is shaped like an upside-down cowboy hat, but the critics say it is shaped like a saddle. It was opened in 1983 and seats 17 000 people. During the off season, it is used for figure skating and ice hockey. I travelled on to Colorado, flying over the Rockies. What a magnificent sight! Nobody should ever leave Canada without seeing them. My holiday was nearing an end, but I enjoyed it immensely. I was fascinated to see many animals roaming wild. Just as we have our koala bears and kangaroos that Canadians are fascinated by, I was equally pleased to see a partridge, woodpecker, moose, wild sheep, coyote, deer, squirrel, mountain goats and elks. The Canadians said to me that they heard our kangaroos roam around the streets: I said in reply, just as you see a grizzly bear in winter. They realized just how wrong they were.

One thing I forgot to mention, was that they have a special channel on television that features rodeo. It runs everyday, but it is a channel that you must pay for. So after telling you all about my holiday and how much I enjoyed it, I would recommend Canada as a worthwhile place to visit, especially during the rodeo season when the Calgary Stampede is on. To see the difference between their rodeos and ours is unbelievable. The venue for the Stampede seats many people, and if I ever had the chance to go to Canada again, I would like to be one of the people sitting in the grandstand watching the rodeo, or maybe even competing.

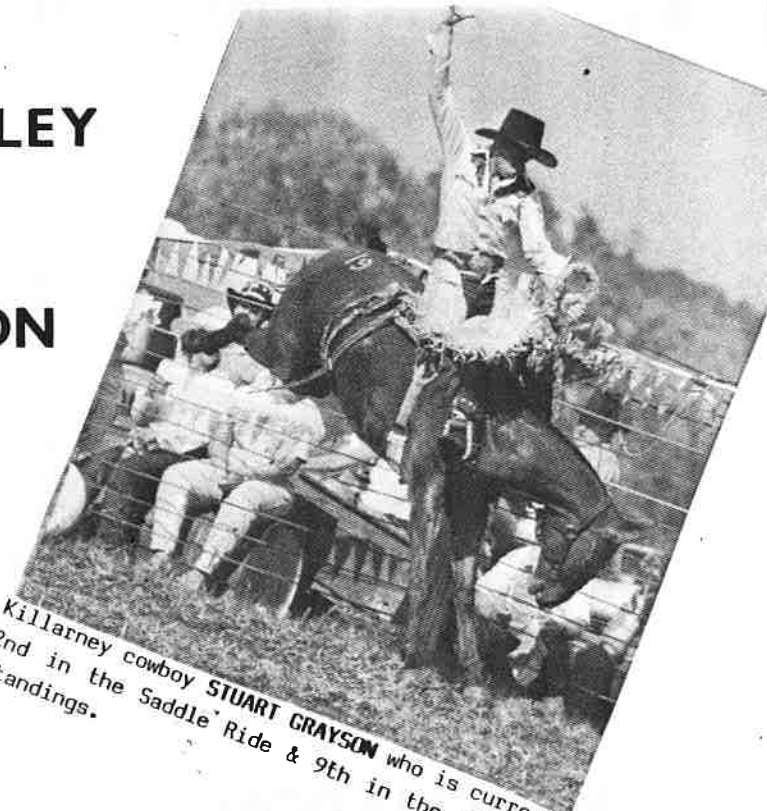

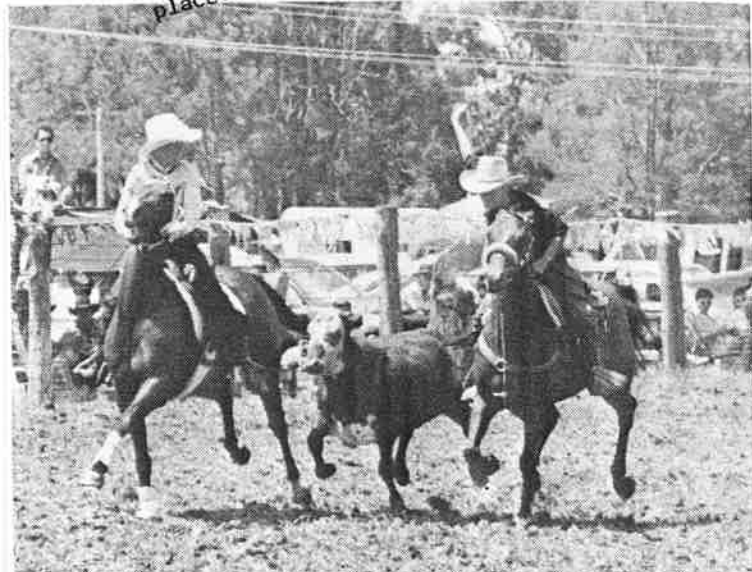
1986 Steer Wrestling Champ., **IAN ALLEN** recorded a time of 10.25 seconds which gave him 2nd place.

Killarney cowboy **STUART GRAYSON** who is currently 2nd in the Saddle Ride & 9th in the All Round Standings.



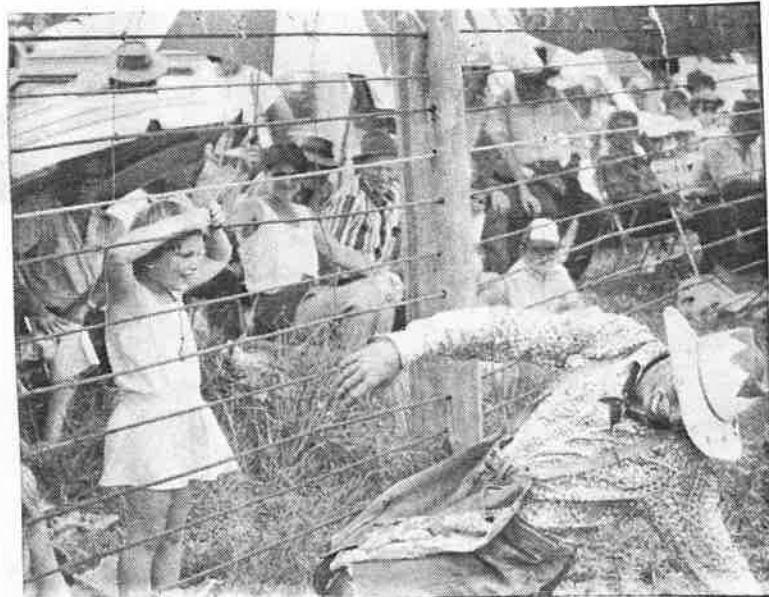
**YVONNE WALLACE** hazes the steer in for **CAROL BROWN** to record a time of 4.65seconds in the Ladies Steer Undecorating.

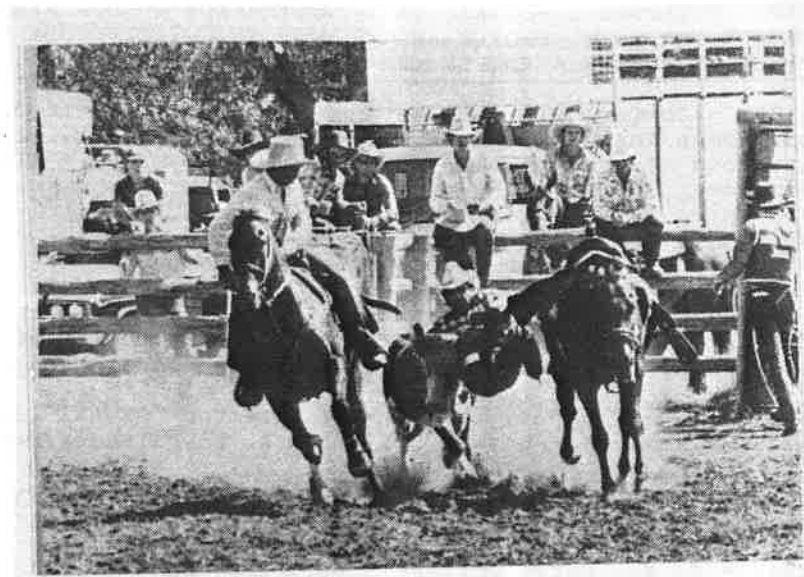
