S.E.Q.R.R. A RODEO NEWS

ITEM FROM A.G.M.Western dress to be worn in front of the chutes and round the arena area
runners may be worn with the permission of the chute boss.

A.G.M - Affiliation fee for Committee's will raise to \$65.

A.G.M. - Steer undecorating stock are to be on the grounds in time for the Director to pre-run steers to his satisfaction to make it a fair competition, unless they are contract stock.

A.G.M. - Once a calf is flanked to the ground, if it is dragged a distance of 2 MTS or more (this distance to be measured from tail of calf to end of drag mark made by such dragging) by the contestant's horse, contestant shall be disqualified. The decision of if calf has been dragged excessively will be made by the Flag Judge and his decision shall be final.

A.G.M. - Officiating Judges at a Rodeo - If the occasion should arise that a Officiating Judge is injured during the course of a rodeo and subsequently unable to continue to carry out his duties as Judge, a substitute Judge (who is a current member of the Judge's Panel) shall be appointed to continue the Judging of the rodeo, but said rodeo shall become a Minimum Points Rodeo for all events as well as All Round event












