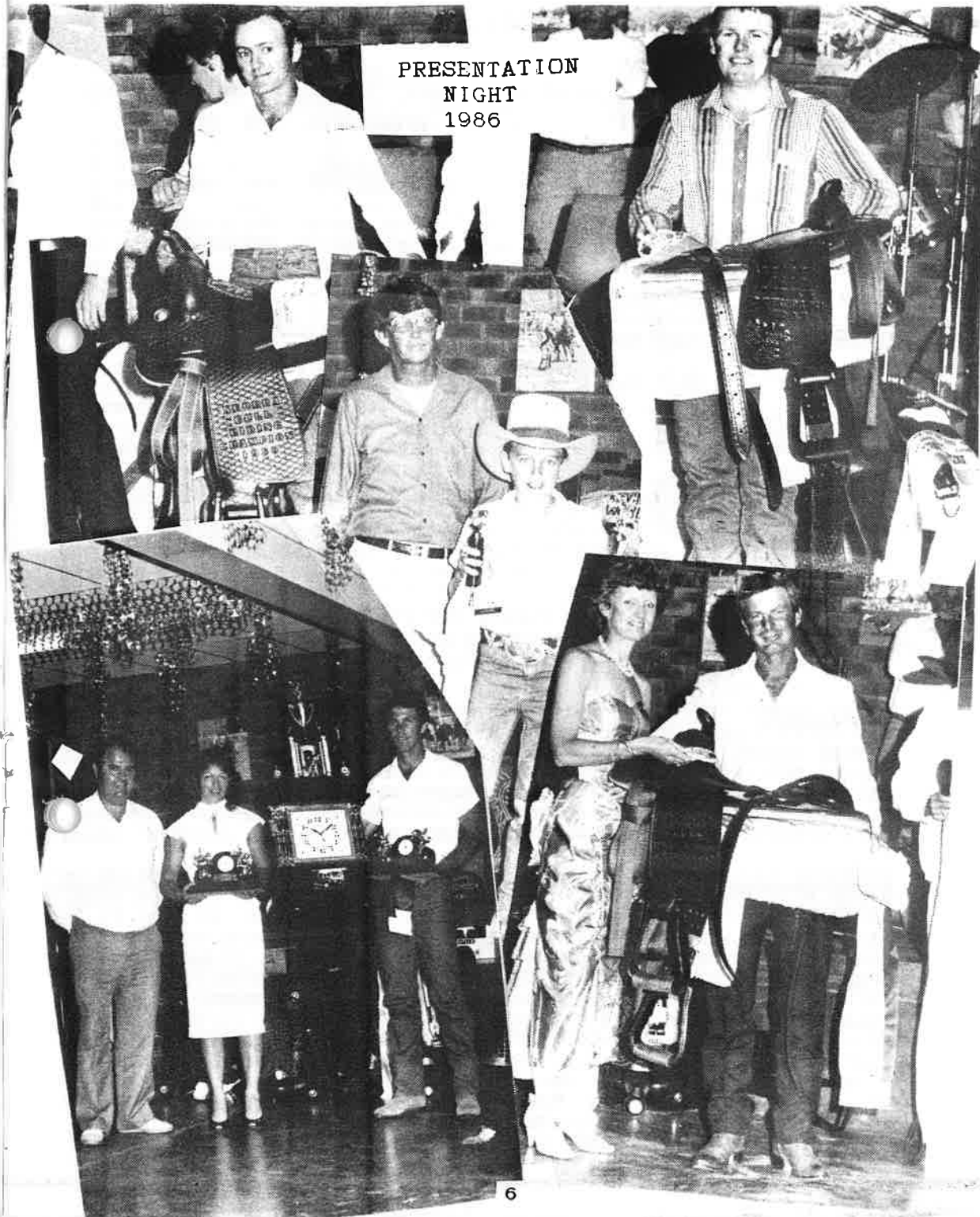
We would also like to see as many little cowgirls under 14yrs as we can for next years Rodeo and Charity Princess. So all you mum's why not put your little girl in its great fun.

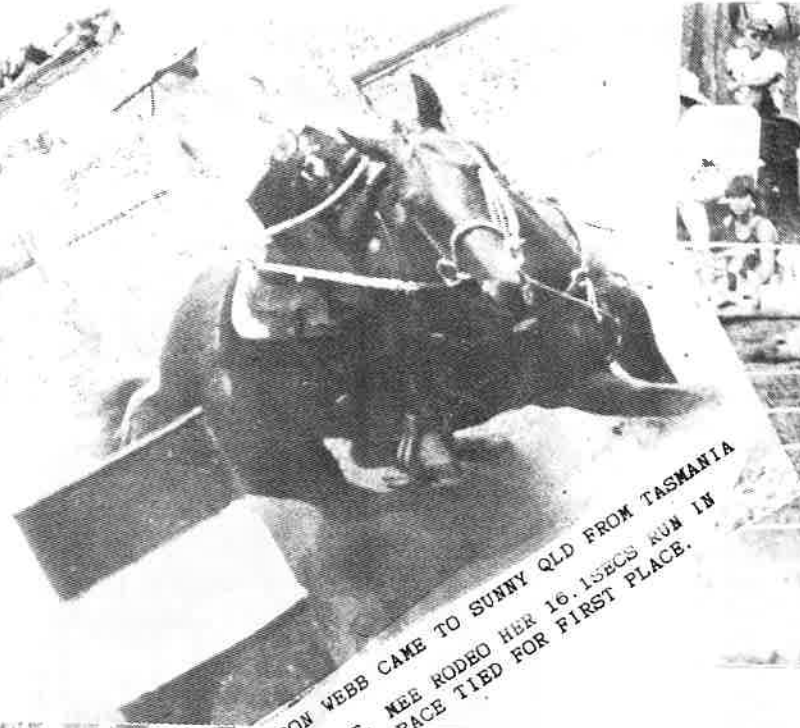

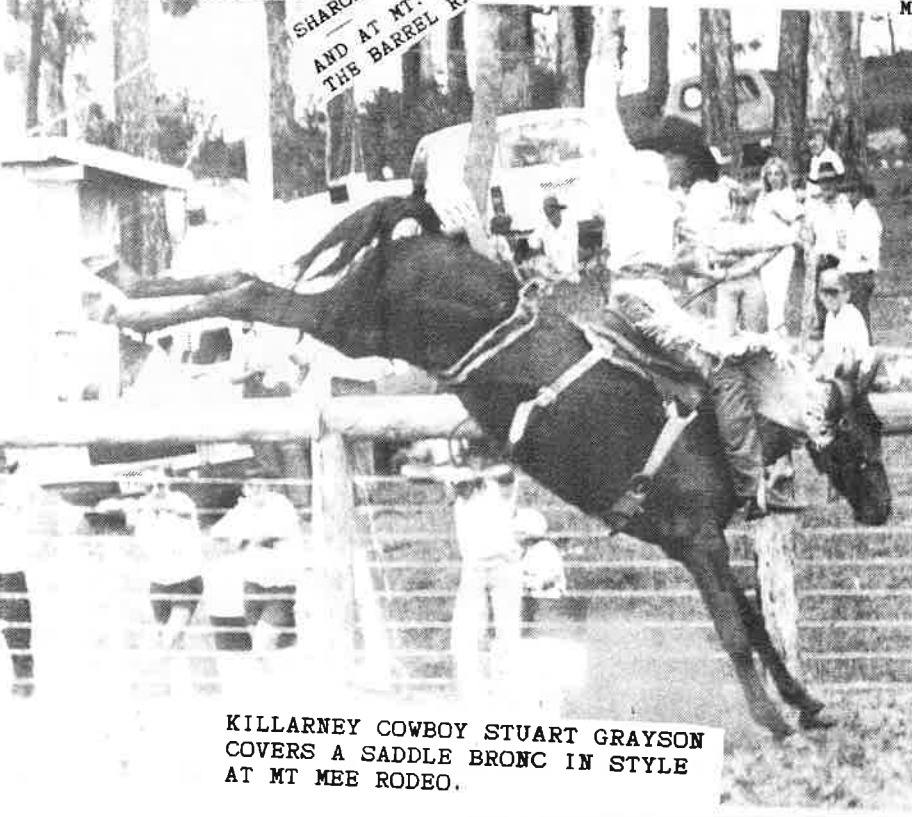

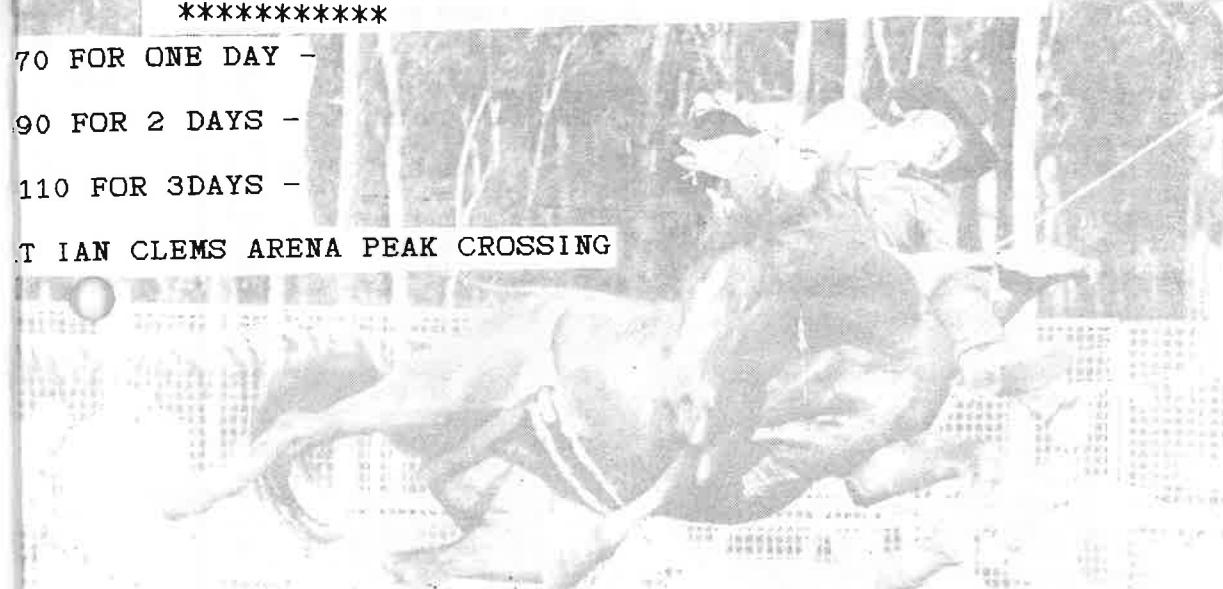
