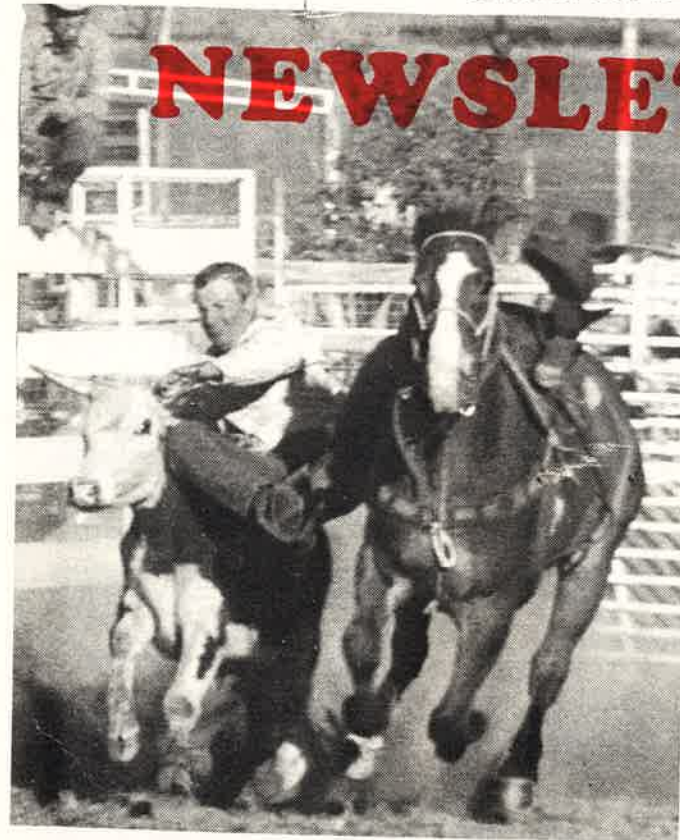

CREDIT CARD - The S.E.Q.R.R.A. Board decided that we would have a (3) three month trial with a credit card system. If you wish to have a credit card you are required to apply in writing to the S.E.Q.R.R.A. Secretary, P.O. BOX 69, ROSEWOOD 4340 by Friday 16th January 1987. Only (50) members will be allowed to hold a credit card and the Board will select from the applications who they will be given to. There will be a bond of \$100 required when your credit card is accepted.

RULE - ANY COMPETITOR MAY RIDE AT UNAFFILIATED RODEO'S UNTIL HE ACCUMULATES A THOUSAND POINTS IN TOTAL IN THE S.E.Q.R.R.A.

RULE - STOCK DRAWS TO BE DONE THE MORNING OF THE RODEO, IF DONE AT ANY OTHER TIME PRIOR TO STOCK NOT BEING ON THE GROUNDS SAID DRAWS TO BE CLOSED TO ONLY EVENT DIRECTOR, JUDGES, AND CENTRAL NOMINATIONS OFFICER.

RULE - RULE THAT STATES STOCK CAN ONLY BE RUN TWICE BE DELETED FROM THE RULE BOOK.

RULE - DELETE FROM THE RULE BOOK THE RULE STATING THAT A JUDGE MUST JUDGE ALL EVENTS AT THE FINALS.


