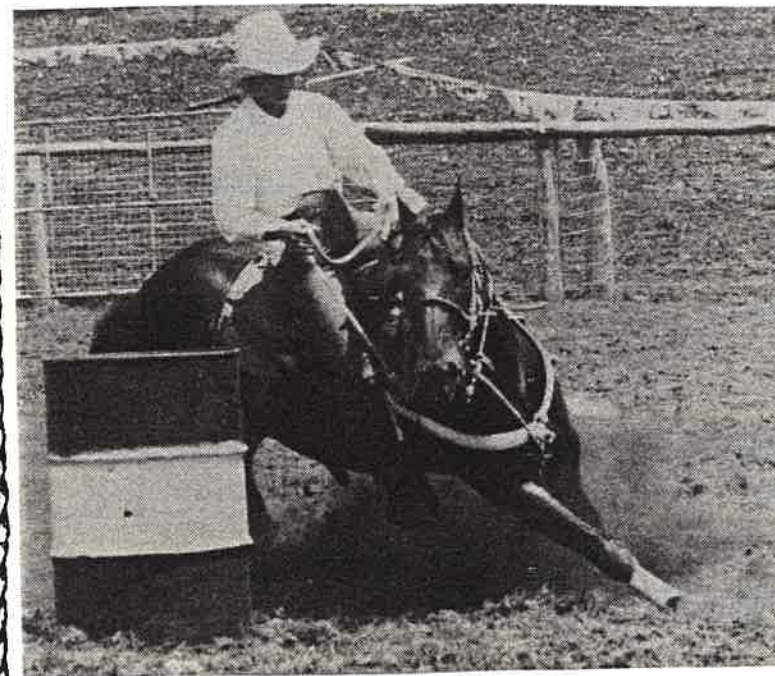

All competitors will be required to sign their prize money also they will be required to produce their membership card they are liable to a \$5 fine for not producing the card when called to by Secretary, Central Nominations, Director or Board Member.

RULE - THIS RULE WAS MADE ON 4/8/85

Ground split to be taken out, and split between qualifying contestants on a percentage.

THIS APPEARED IN FEBRUARY 1986 NEWSLETTER.

In the event of all competitors not qualifying in a rough stock event the prize money will be divided 50% each between stock contractor and committee. In time events with no qualifying times prize money will be divided 50% each between the S.E.Q.R.R.A. and committee.

S.E.Q.R.R.A. LADIES BREAKAWAY ROPING RULES

1 There shall be (2) or more Time Keepers, a Field Judge and a Barrier Judge.

2 Animals used for this event to be inspected by a Director of S.E.Q.R.R.A. or an official of the S.E.Q.R.R.A. and stock must be approx 100kg live weight minimum and be score (3) calves in condition. Larger cattle or calves maybe used subject to inspection and unsuitable stock i.e. unhealthy stock, to be rejected.

3 One (1) rope only will be permitted and, should contestant miss she must retire, and no time will be allowed. Roping calf without releasing loop from hand is not permitted.

4 Arena conditions determine length of barrier, which is set by Director prior to commencement of the event. Calf is accepted as sound and released on contestant's first call or signal.

5 Rope is to be tied to the saddle horn with heavy duty string. Bright ribbon must be attached to the rope which is attached to the saddle horn and such ribbons dimensions to be approximantely

6 Loop must pass over the calves nose and head, if steers are used for this event a horn catch is acceptable 8" horn.

7 The flag Judge will flag the contestant when the rope breaks away from the saddle horn.

8 Contestant shall receive no time should she break the rope from the saddle horn by hand or by touching rope or string after catch is completed.

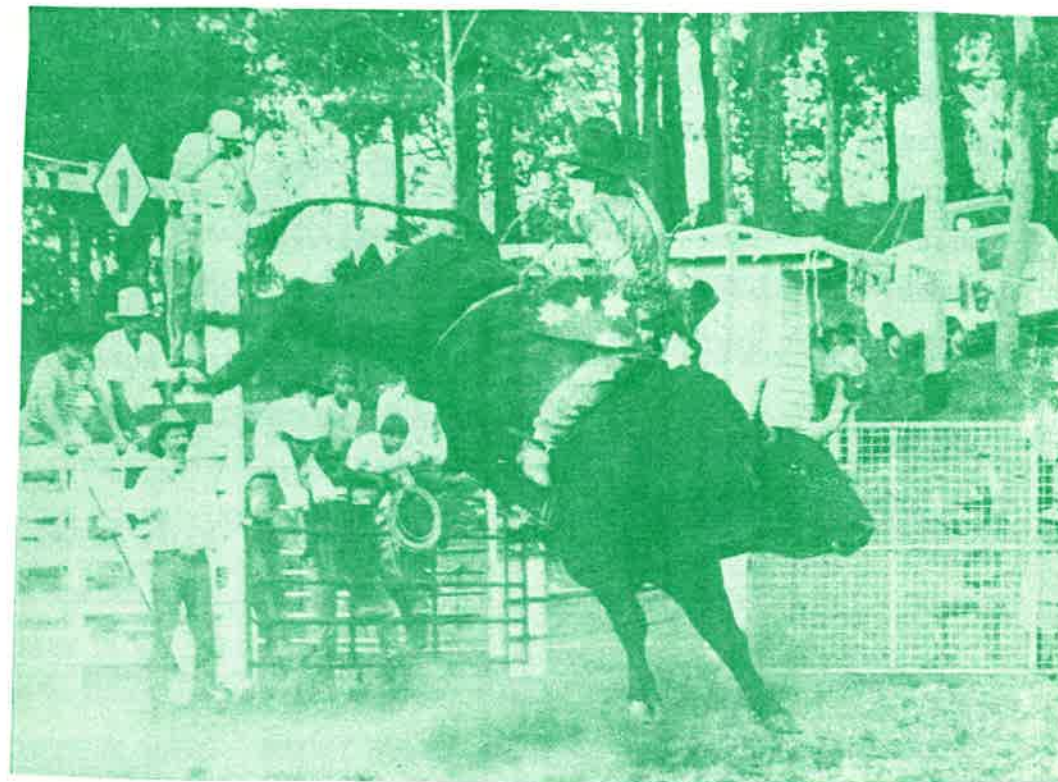
