AGENDA: To be voted on by members, and committee's present.

1. Insurance for the cowboys, for \$50 per year, we have an insurance that will insure cowboys to the extent of, \$150 per week for 52 weeks in a year if you are hurt that long or fifteen thousand dollars for a loss of life.
2. Fighting on rodeo grounds.
3. The members will have to decide if they wish to increase their membership next year and continue to give trophy saddles or, perhaps give (i.e) thousand dollar buckles instead.
4. Breakaway Roping for Junior members, this would be an optional event for committee's if they wish to have something for the children, we find the spectators love watching the youngones perform. Would be run on the same rules as the girls and would be no extra trouble to run through with the breakaway ropers. Can only better and encourage the sport in the young.
5. Backyard workers, Judges, Pick-up Teams, Timers, Chute boss (when not competing) may wear short sleeves in the arena.
6. Chute fighting stock should be made free run and rowl out.
7. Increase in affiliation fee.
8. Contract stock for steer undecorating.
9. Refunds of gate money. This is of great interest to the committee's we would appreciate as many committee representatives as possible, so your feelings maybe felt on this matter.
10. Calf Roping, when a calf is dragged it will be at the judges discretion when they will be disqualified.
11. When a Judge is hurt, a rule to be made conserning weather a replacement judge should be used.

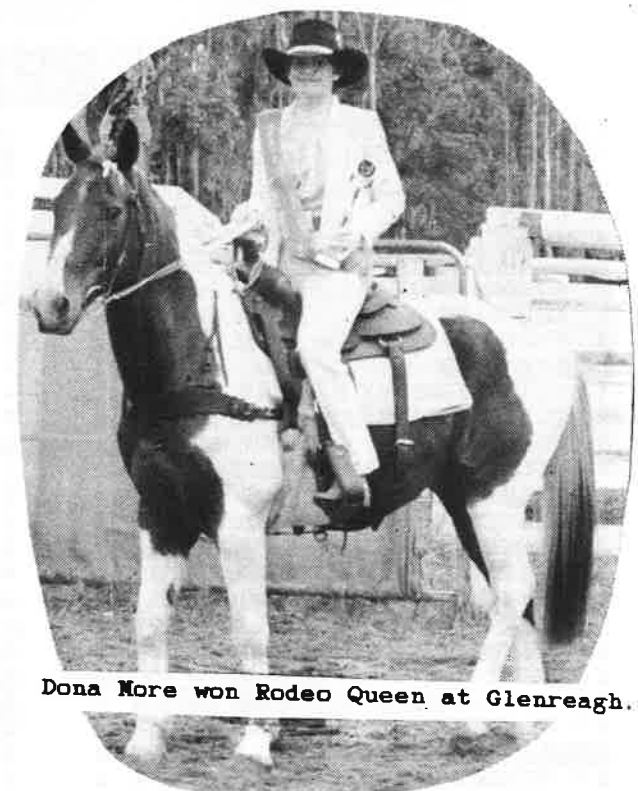




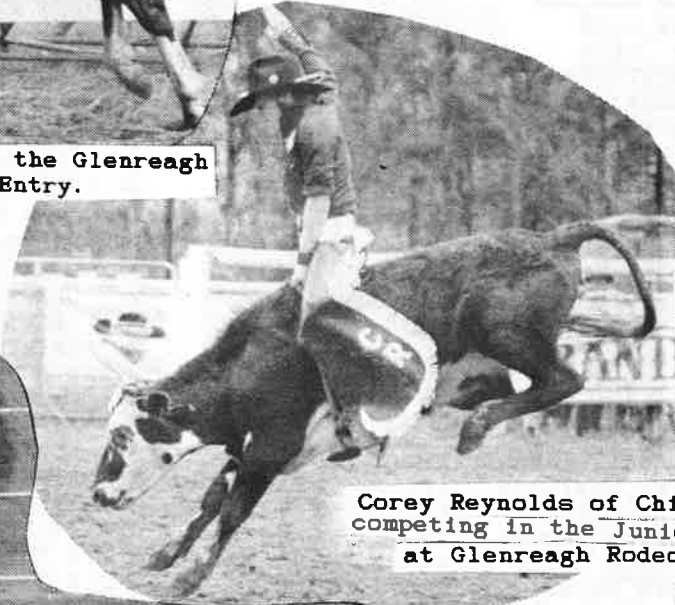

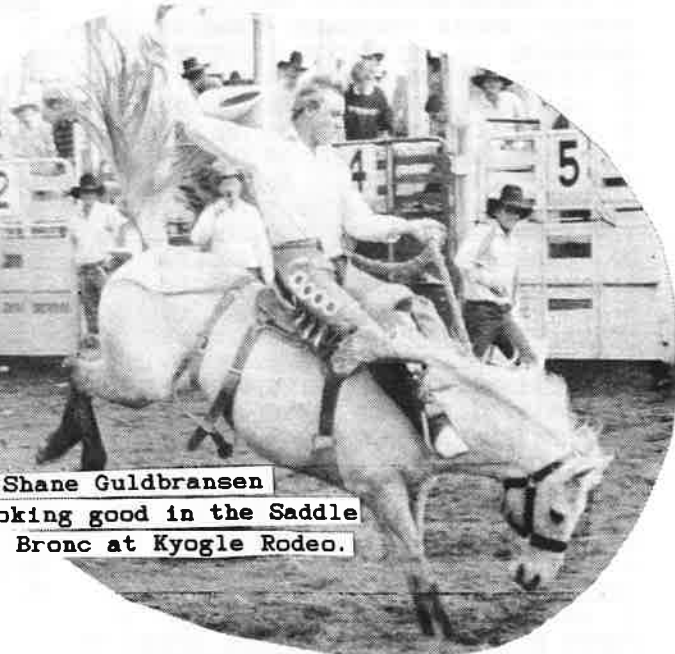
