(Please read this rule again, as in last months newsletter it was worded wrong in the last line. )

A.G.M. - Officiating Judges at a Rodeo - If the occasion should arise that a Officiating Judge is injured during the course of a rodeo and subsequently unable to continue to carry out his duties as Judge, a substitute Judge (who is a current member of the Judge's Panel) shall be appointed to continue the Judging of the rodeo, but said rodeo shall become a Minimum Points Rodeo for all events and NO POINTS FOR ALL ROUND.

GATE REFUNDS - At day rodeos they will be returned from the end of the traws to the end of lunch time. At night rodeos the time they will be efunded will be written on the top of the draws for all competitors to

#### RULE: -

The Time Event Barrier be set NO longer then 12ft. The barrier must l set before the draws are done, and prior to setting (2) Directors mus confer between themselves and the Stock Contractor's to determine the length of barrier appropriate to the size of the arena and time even! box being used.




