 1988 TROPHY SADDLE AND TROPHY BUCKLES TENDERS - are also being called by the S.E.Q.R.R.A. Board, for further information contact the Secretary or President. Phone numbers are in the front of the newsletter.

COMMITTEE'S - Please book your time keepers, the same time you book your Judge's. So they will know they are required.

RULE -  
 Any member presentating a dishonoured cheque will be fined the sum of \$20.00 to cover charges and cost of cheque, member who passes a dishonoured cheque a second time will go before the Board.

RULE -  
 Any unfinancial member that competes at a rodeo will be disqualified and fined the sum of \$50.00.

MEMBERSHIP - Please forward your membership to the SECRETARY, CATHY KEPPEL - P.O. BOX 69, ROSEWOOD 4340 - NOT TO CENTRAL RODEO NOMS. Don't include your membership in with entries, they are two different things altogether.

MEMBERSHIP - has to be paid prior to the 1st January, 88.  
MENS FULL \$65 - GIRLS FULL \$45 - ASSOCIATE \$20 - JUNIOR \$20 -

(Please read this rule again, as in last months newsletter it was worded wrong in the last line.)

A.G.M. - Officiating Judges at a Rodeo - If the occasion should arise that a Officiating Judge is injured during the course of a rodeo and subsequently unable to continue to carry out his duties as Judge, a substitute Judge (who is a current member of the Judge's Panel) shall be appointed to continue the Judging of the rodeo, but said rodeo shall become a Minimum Points Rodeo for all events and NO POINTS FOR ALL ROUND.

GATE REFUNDS - At day rodeos they will be returned from the end of the draws to the end of lunch time. At night rodeos the time they will be refunded will be written on the top of the draws for all competitors to see.

RULE: -  
 The Time Event Barrier be set NO longer then 12ft. The barrier must l set before the draws are done, and prior to setting (2) Directors mus confer between themselves and the Stock Contractor's to determine the length of barrier appropriate to the size of the arena and time event box being used.

RULE: -  
 That a FLAG be set in the middle of the barrier and the times are to be taken off the flag, when it starts to withdraw.

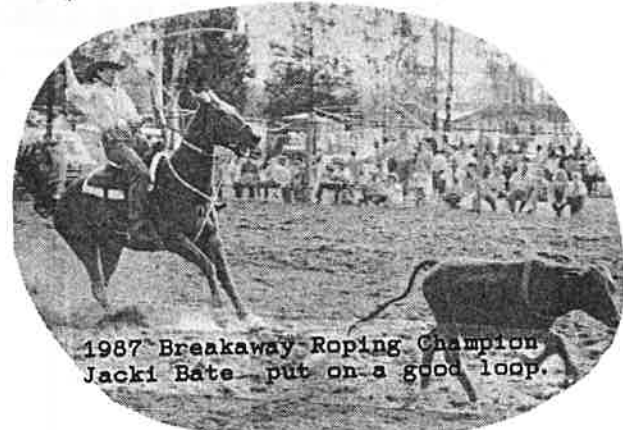

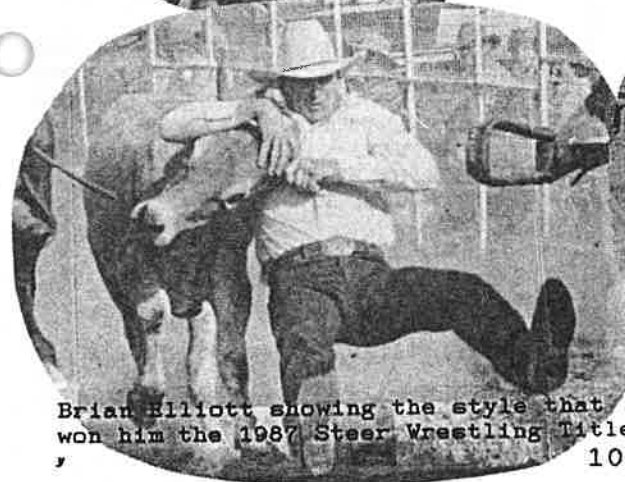
