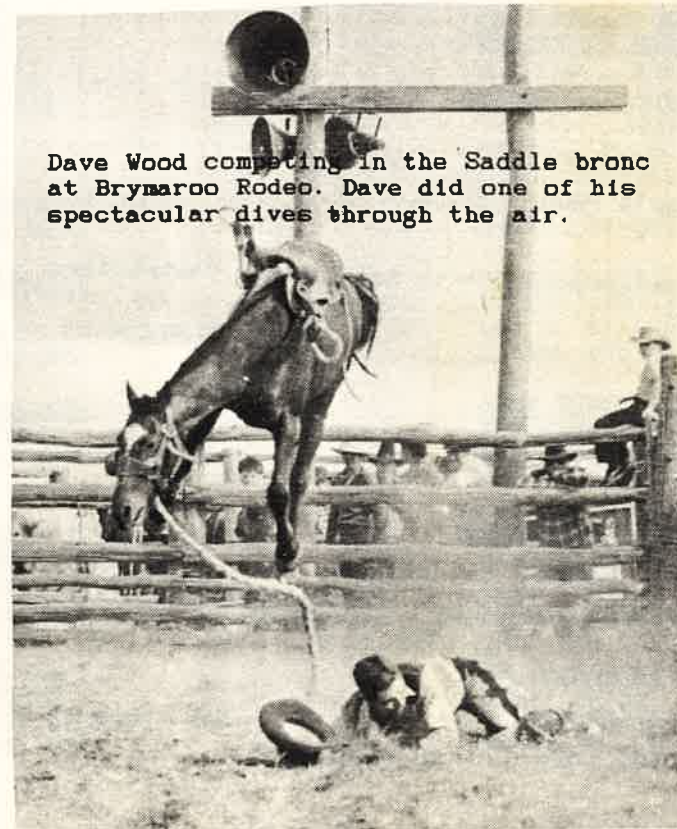

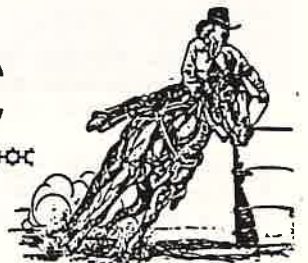

# S.E.Q.R.R.A. RODEO NEWS

\*\*\*\*\*

**RULE:-** Horses are not allowed in the arena to be warmed up prior to an event.

**RULE:-** Entries CLOSE TUESDAY prior to the rodeo, late entries are decided by the post mark on the envelope, which are all dated.

**RULE:-** Associate membership will entitle the member to be on the stock contractors listing, judge and be on the mailing list to receive a newsletter each month, associate members have NO voting rights and CAN NOT hold any official capacity on the board of directors and officials.

**RULE:-** All new members to the "Nation Rodeo Association" must hold a permit card for (1) FULL rodeo year, (JANUARY 1ST TO DECEMBER 31ST) before he/she will be able to purchase a full membership from the association. A permit member is entitled to win money and gain points toward performing at the end of year finals, winning trophies and end of year titles. Permit members have NO voting rights and are not entitled to hold any official capacity on the board of directors and officials.

# S.E.Q.R.R.A. RODEO NEWS

\*\*\*\*\*

Team Roping, all entrants must pay \$50 entry fee, it is up to them if they take one run or two, but no one can pay for half a run, to Central Entries. When competitors nominate for the Team Roping they must name their partners.

Stock Contractors are required to have their stock on the grounds of a rodeo (1) ONE HOUR prior to the advertised commencement time of the rodeo. A maximum \$200.00 fine will be imposed upon any stock contractor failing to comply with this rule.

The S.E.Q.R.R.A. Board voted to send (2) delegats to represent our association with the Australian Council of Rodeo. The A.B.C.R.A. has also agreed to continue with the making of the Council in Australia as yet we are to hear back from the A.R.R.A.

1 stock contractors must be a member of the association, need only be an associate membership, which cost \$20.00

At the end of 1988 there will be ribbons for the champion and the runner-up of each title. The juniors will still receive ribbons down to the placings.

A Committee need only (21) days notification of their rodeo being banned.

Prize money will be split 45% - 33% - 22% - when there is a three way split. With only 3 qualifying contestants.

Competitors who compete at unaffiliated rodeos will be libel to a monetary fine, that must not exceed the current membership fee. They may compete at A.R.R.A. & A.B.C.R.A. and S.E.Q.R.R.A. Rodeos, but under no circumstances at any rodeo not affiliated with the above named bodies.

The draws, stock and position will be done on the day of the rodeo, the Time Events Directors may write what length of barrier they will set for the day on the draws, they may proceed to do the draws, then set the barrier after the draws have been done.

A rodeo information must be in writing and at head office (2) months prior to the rodeo being held. A form will be forwarded to all committee's to help make this work. Sorry no more information will be able to be taken as confirmed over the phone. I may at some time have to ring to work out some details.

Any person must be a FULL MEMBER of the S.E.Q.R.R.A. for (2) years prior to becoming a board member.

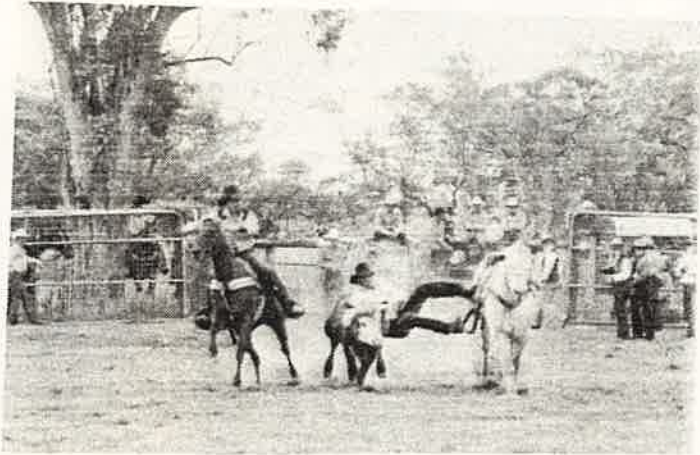

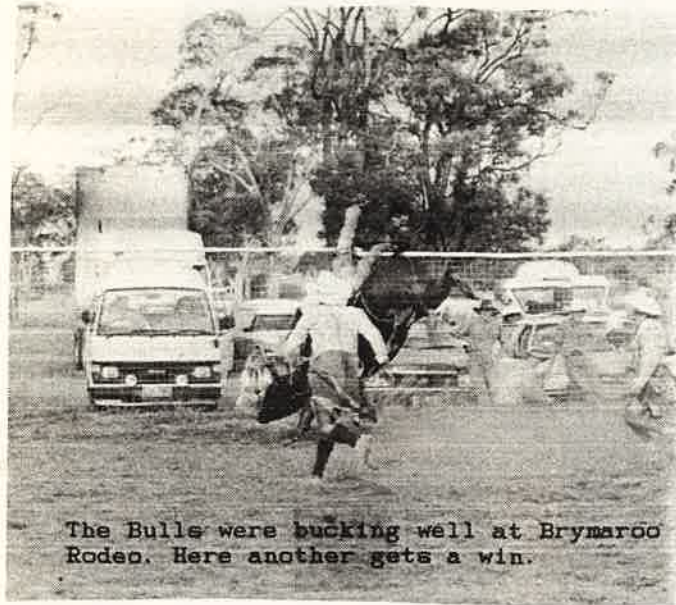

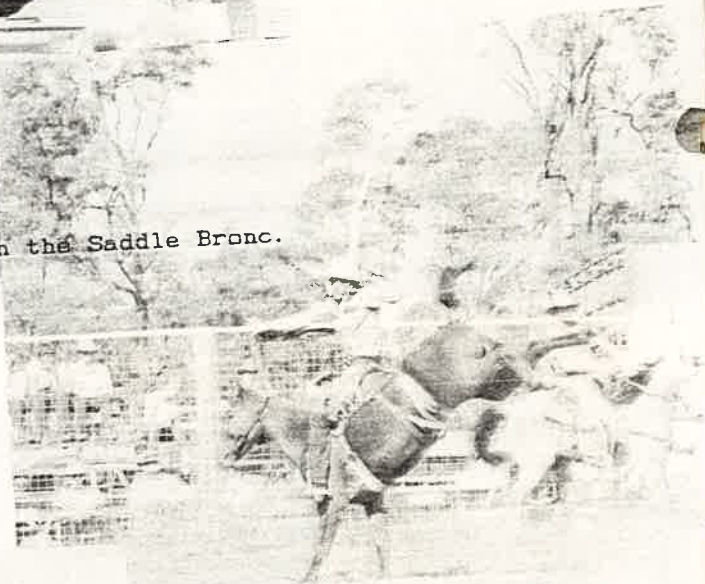

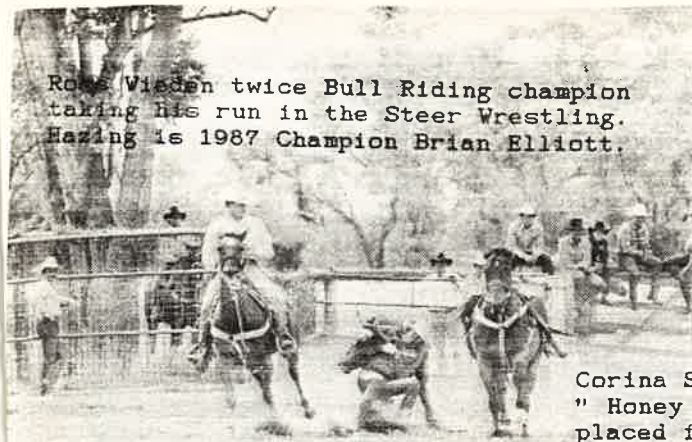

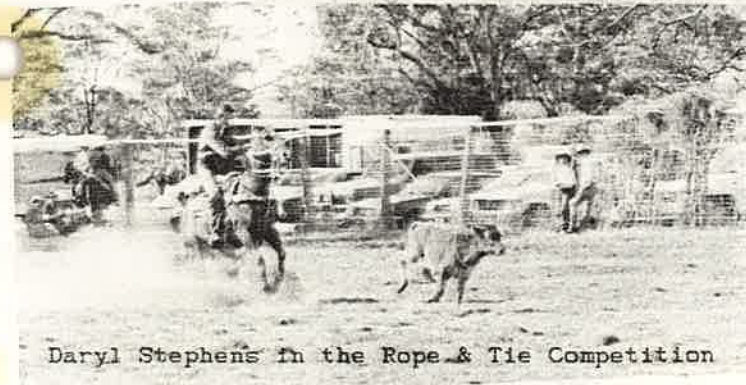
