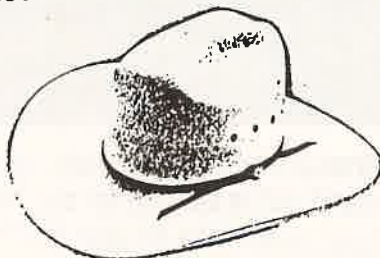

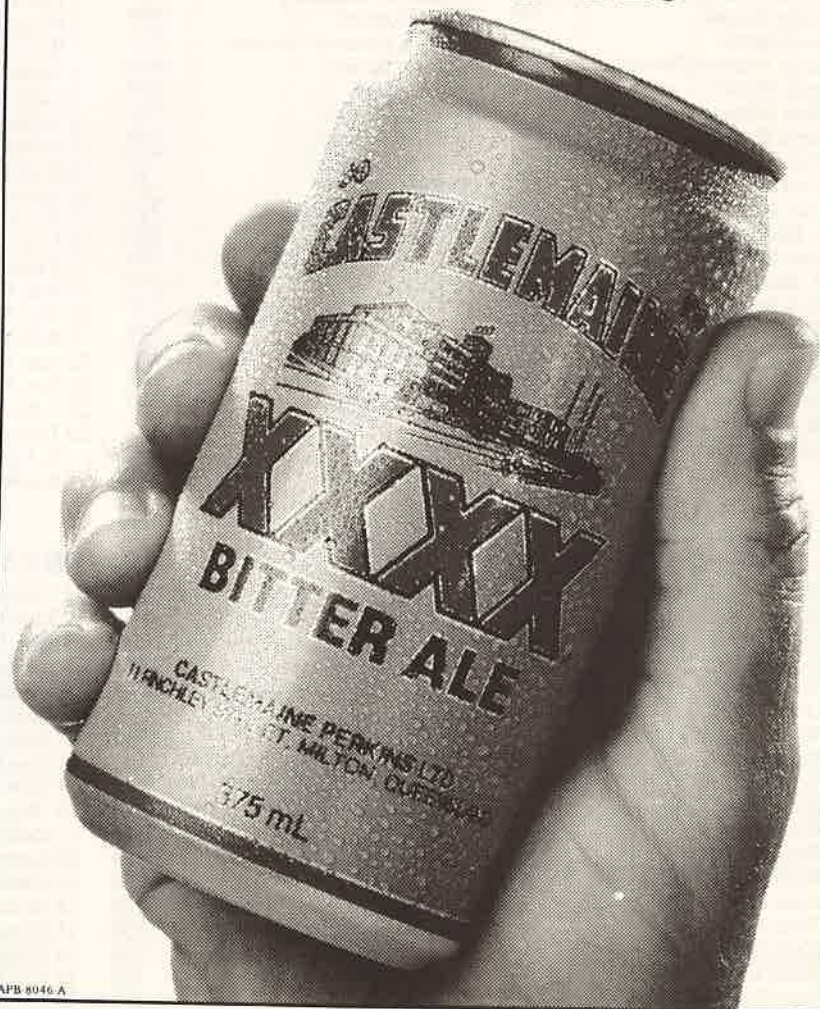

## Rules to take effect 1 month from publication of this Newsletter

### CENTRAL ENTRIES

Committees will contribute 50 cents to go with the 50 cents already paid by competitors to cover the cost of Central entries.

### TEAM ROPING

This rule will remain the same but entry fees will drop to \$30.

### RODEO PROGRAMMES

The Board has the right to limit the number of events over and above of what is necessary for a maximum of 10 events or committees can run optional events in a slack.

### ARENA GROUNDS

If the arena cannot be ploughed or top dressed, it is to be inspected by a minimum of three Event Directors, one month before scheduled date to run.

### OPTIONAL EVENTS

There will be no trophy saddles supplied by the Association for optional events.

### COMPETING IN OPTIONAL EVENTS AT THE FINALS

If a competitor does not wish to compete at the Finals in an Optional

Event, the next competitor moves up to take his place. If the next competitor in line cannot compete, the original competitor is responsible to find a replacement.

### RE-RIDE STOCK

The Contractor must submit two re-ride head of stock to draw from at all times, up to 30 competitors. Above 30 competitors, he must have three re-ride head available.

### TURN OUT STOCK

The first turn out head of stock to go back into the re-ride pen to be drawn for. The stock contractors then have the right to take one of the re-ride stock out.

### NO RIDES

Re-ride only in the event rough stock fails to buck. All other re-rides as now described in the rule book are to become no-rides.

### BROKEN GEAR

The rule that states broken gear constitutes a re-ride will be taken out of the rule book, page 45 - section 12 - kickers are not included.
