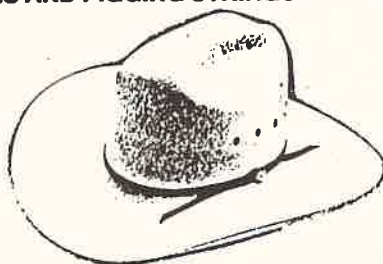

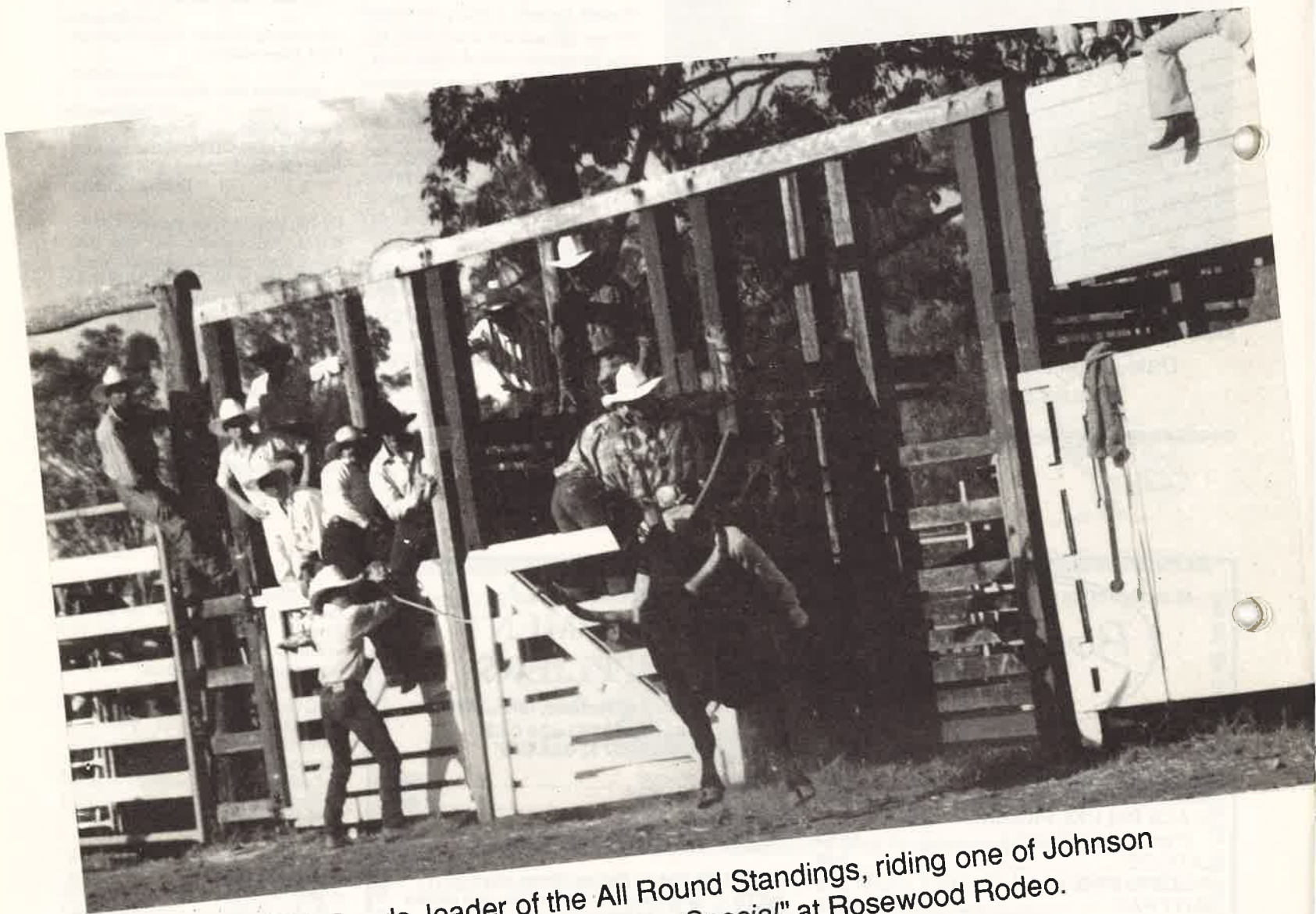

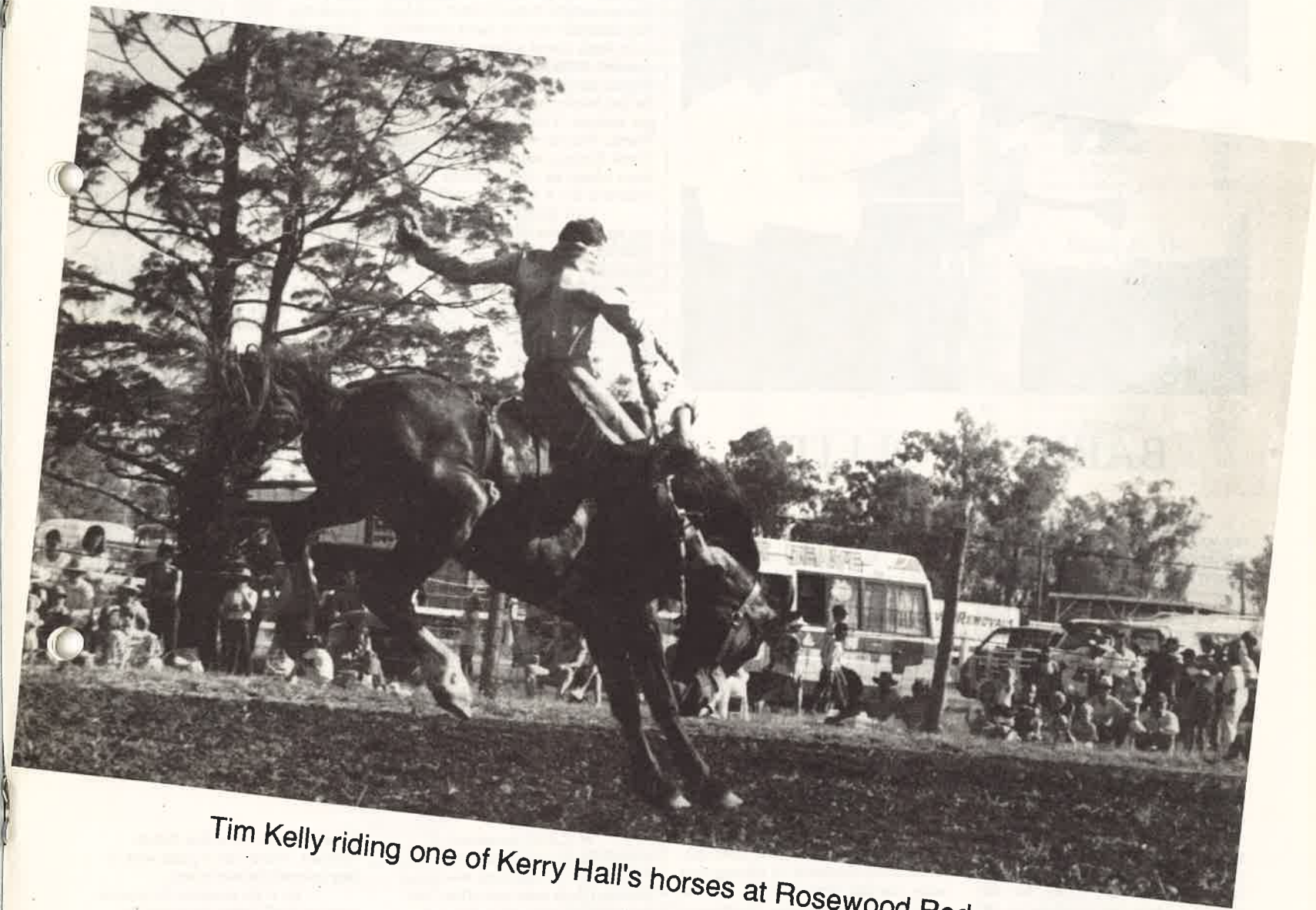

Profile



BARNEY POLLITT

It seems only fitting to start my series of personality profiles with a tribute to stock contractor and all round tough hand Barney Pollitt.

All who were present at the West Coast Circuit trophy night were deeply moved as Barney became the West Coast Circuit's first Honorary Life Member, announced his retirement and bade farewell to his best friends, those horses that "buck".

It's a long old rodeo road to look back on, as near as Barney can estimate some forty-five years. About twenty years involved as a stock contractor and the last eight years contracting on his own.

At the tender age of twelve years Barney earned his pennies trapping and breaking in brumbies and selling them for hacks. He also earned a name for breaking in and handling the tough ones other horse breakers couldn't handle.

Then one fine day Noel George and Buddy Williams brought their "Queensland Wild West Stampede" Tent Show Rodeo to town. Barney was hired on to give exhibition Saddle Bronc & Bareback. He stayed with the tent show while it toured up and down the State doing night rodeos and side show performances. Barney recalls one Perth Royal Show where he got on eighteen head of stock both Bareback and Saddle Bronc. In his understated drawl Barney said, "And

I knew it by gee, Next day my legs were marked up bad".

One story that amuses Barney is the tale of a little buckjumper mare named "Chain Lightning" who became quite a draw card for the tent show. After lots of exposure however, they needed a new gimmick. So the story goes that they dyed "Chain Lightning" with condy's crystals. She came out about the colour of a brindle cow, was renamed "Hello Angel" and hit the same circuit billed as the toughest buckjumper since the infamous "Chain Lightning".

Yes, Barney has indeed seen a lot happen in the rodeo arena in forty-five years. A lot of cowboys come and go and few good ones stay. Fortunately he feels all change has been for the better, with cleaner venues, portable arena complexes, professional stock contractors and tougher competition.

"The cowboys of today ride in style and pride and drees the same. At one time there were only one or two outstanding riders in the West, now there are at least nine or ten with a lot of good young talent coming on", he said.

Well Barney, you'll miss the arena and so too will the arena miss you. We all hope you will continue to support us as a spectator and advisor, and if you don't mind, give us a hand once in a while too, eh?

W.A. Steer Wrestling Record at Stampede

The highlight of Stampede arena on Saturday March 10th rodeo, was when Wayne Stanley broke the state Steer Wrestling record in the lightning fast time of 3.40 seconds.

This was achieved despite the fact Wayne drew a bad steer to sit up, but Darryl Mateljans mount "Rumble" can find top gear from a standstill. Wayne caught that old steer and had him thrown before he had a chance to even think about sitting up. Having wrestled steers half heartedly for years, Wayne has just got serious about it in the last twelve months and boy did he get serious. Visiting us from the far North, Wayne works on Christmas Creek Station, near Fitzroy Crossing, from where he tries to make it to all rodeos in the Kimberley region.

Calf Roping was also taken out by a Kimberley cowboy, Norm Bushell, with a time of 12.69 seconds, knocking Wayne Cannards early lead of 14.96 into second place.

With the Team Roping, we'd all like to welcome the great grandfather of rodeo back from the U.S.A., 76 year old Harold Adkins, who along with partner Kevin Treloar took 4th place in the team roping. Harold's great grandson, 4 year old Jay-D Adkins, was a contestant in the poddy ride. There probably isn't another professional sport in the world where four generations all compete. Jay-D's cousin Dale Mateljan took home first place in the Poddy Ride. Let's not forget the Team Roping winners, Jeff Larsen and Neil Boyd, with a time of 10.45 seconds.
