The Bull Riding Title holder for '87 and '88, George has successfully competed in Canada and of course his homeland of New Zealand.

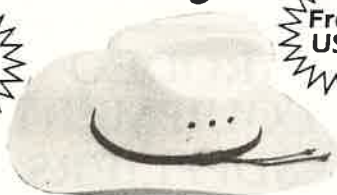
With regard to Rodeo ambition, George would like to see a lot more of them and a lot more money involved and a much more professional standard of producing the show itself.

The Carnarvon Tropical Festival Committee held a Rodeo on 8 July, 1990 at Carnarvon, the first for eight years. The post and rail arena has certainly stood the test of time and was in excellent condition. Carnarvon, is a 12 hour drive from Perth, so it was quite an expedition that took off from down south. Charlie Forbes and Terry Johnson carted the bucking bulls, time event stock and hay on their semi, while Barney and Gary Pollitt filled their semi with bucking horses and Grant Edwards carted up the time event horses and hay and grain.

The Rodeo itself was enjoyed by thousands of spectators who flock to Carnarvon each year to enjoy the many events put on for them over the weekend.

The long trip certainly didn't effect Charlie and Terry's bulls in any way, as no cowboy made it to the buzzer. All the old favourites were there including 'Yeeda' who was drawn twice, once by Terry Johnson and secondly by the All Round Kimberley Champion, Colin Fuller. Other Kimberley Cowboys who drove the two days to reach Carnarvon included Norm Bushell, Wayne Stanley and Adrian Cordey.

The two local competitors were Raleigh Jordon and Guy Treed, who to the delight of the crowd placed 4th in the Bareback with a 55 point ride on the old champ 'Duffy'

June 16 Bull Ride saw all time great George Baker back on top with a vengeance. He spurred Cold Shot for 73 points in the first go round. Then went one point better for a score of 74 points in the final, as he drove it to that man eater 'Yeeda'. Gary Bishop, Greg Horsham and Glen Chaisty were 2nd, 3rd and 4th respectively in the 1st go round. While in the final, second went to Steve Chaisty and Greg Horsham.

Mint Crothers won the Bronc Ride on 'Miss Many Peaks' with 71 points, Norm Pascoe was 2nd with 70 points, with Victor Cant 3rd and Wayne Cannard 4th.

Harry George won the Steer Wrestling in 4.96 seconds, Kevin Reynolds Jr. was 2nd and George Baker was there to pick up more money in 3rd place.

George Baker may have been the hero of the night but big sister Jenny Treloar held up the family honour when she smoked 'em in the Barrel Race in 13.76 seconds. Followed real close by Eva Withnell in 13.94 seconds, while Crystal Pascoe was 3rd and Jeanie Heague was back for 4th place.

This seems necessary as there are no W.C.R.C. trophies for Novice Girl Competitors in the individual events.
