Increase in prize money \$50.00 per standard event, i.e. Mens Events \$350.00 entry fee \$30.50. Girls events \$250.00 entry fee \$26.50.

There will be a second division and \$2.00 per entry will go to second division prize pool - more information on the second division in the next newsletter.

Where there is a slack - the top five into the performance and a wild card draw for the remainder.

Central Entries has the power to fine for late entries.

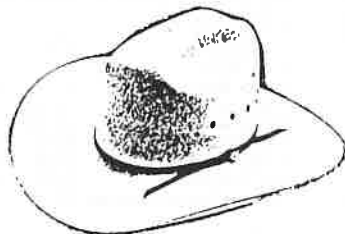

When steel merchant Ian Dicandillo chose two cowboys to sponsor in the sport of rodeo he definitely didn't go for the new kids on the block. Wayne Cannard originally from Victoria first got his pro rodeo card in 1972. He competed throughout Australia on Saddle Bronc and bullriding and made it to the National Finals in both events on several occasions. By the time he turned pro however he was already an old hand. His father Lofty Cannard ran a tent show rodeo throughout Australia and Wayne along with his brothers gave exhibition rides on a nightly basis. Wayne took the rodeo road to the West in 1979 and decided to stay. Since making W.A. home Wayne has been a consistent West Coast Rodeo Circuit title holder in bullriding, saddle bronc, team roping and a couple of times held All Round Champion Cowboy honors. For the year of 1985 Wayne competed successfully in the U.S.A. and Canada specialising in his number one vent Saddle Bronc. In 1988 Wayne once again qualified for the National Finals in the Saddle Bronc. He is so far leading the saddle bronc title for 1990 with Jeff Martin breathing right down his neck.

Grant Edwards hails from Gingin farming stock where he continues to hold the family tradition. Grant started his rodeo career in 1971. By 1973 he decided to venture up to the Kimberley's and rodeo with the tough men. Rodeo has a way of beckoning a young man and Grant was no exception. In '74 and '75 he made his way to the U.S.A. and competed in all three rough stock events. He had a big win in Capitan New Mexico on the 4th July rodeo which is a big celebration for Independence day in the U.S. Upon returning to W.A. Grant spent several years competing in 6 events at rodeos which fairly kept him hopping. By 1983 however Grant retired to three events and has consistently won titles in one or the other ever since. However just three events at a rodeo left Grant with a lot of time on his hands to kill at a rodeo, so he took to producing the show. Now along with partners Grant runs the Brigadoon Winter Series of bull rides, Bullsbrook Summer rodeo, has a portable arena complex, time event stock & broncs, which ensures he never has bored a moment. Cowboys like Wayne and Grant that just get tougher instead of older are hard to find. They certainly appreciate the support of Dicandillo's & Sons and urge all rodeo fans to likewise support Dicandillo for any steel needs. You'll find them situated at Guildford Road, Bayswater.
