
The girls are making a fight of it also with Wendy Eisentrager and Judy Gough being locked up on the same amount of points for the All

It's been an event filled partnership since 1987 when Johnno bought out Richard Bailey's share of the herd. Terry presently calls 'Quairading' home while Charlie resides at 'Jandakot'. The glamor of being a rodeo stock contractor and the reality of it are worlds apart. The bulls home paddock is swamp country in 'Jandakot' with heaps of thicket and the odd tiger snake or two. Recently while getting the bulls in Johnno was heading up a tunnel in the thicket when a low rumbling noise caused him to look up only to see Yeeda (the man eater) heading down the same tunnel. Every rodeo fan in W.A. knows what a horrifying sight that would be! Fortunately for Johnno, Yeeda decided to put chase to his dog instead of him and pushed past Johnno who was blended as good as could be to the thicket wall.

Both Charlie and Johnno could tell a hundred such stories. Charlie originally put a string of bucking stock together back in 1974. Then he bought bulls just to practice on. 
