

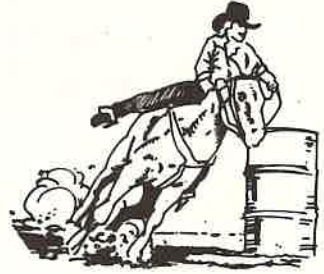

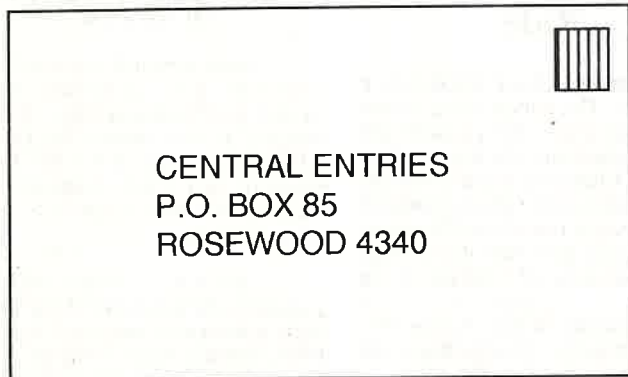

Profile

Charlie Forbes and Terry Johnson

Terry Johnson and Charlie Forbes are co-owners of that "Bad" herd of bucking bulls known as "Charlies Angels". It's been an event filled partnership since 1987 when Johnno bought out Richard Bailey's share of the herd. Terry presently calls 'Quairading' home while Charlie resides at 'Jandakot'. The glamor of being a rodeo stock contractor and the reality of it are worlds apart. The bulls home paddock is swamp country in 'Jandakot' with heaps of thicket and the odd tiger snake or two. Recently while getting the bulls in Johnno was heading up a tunnel in the thicket when a low rumbling noise caused him to look up only to see Yeeda (the man eater) heading down the same tunnel. Every rodeo fan in W.A. knows what a horrifying sight that would be! Fortunately for Johnno, Yeeda decided to put chase to his dog instead of him and pushed past Johnno who was blended as good as could be to the thicket wall.

Both Charlie and Johnno could tell a hundred such stories. Charlie originally put a string of bucking stock together back in 1974. Then he bought bulls just to practice on. Charlie once worked six events at rodeos but these days, due to old injuries (including a broken back) sticks to time events. Terry on the other hand at age thirty-two is the only cowboy in the West tough enough to ride all three rough stock events and he says, "I'll keep at it until the bones begin to break instead of bend".

One thing that really disappoints both of these seasoned hands is there isn't enough tough young talent around that want to be getting on rank bulls just for the thrill of it the way they both used to do.

Both Terry and Charlie's families are very involved with the bulls. Four month old Kaycee Forbes goes to feed them every night. While big sister 7 year old Melissa drives the land rover, dad throws bales of hay off the back. However two month old Joelle Johnson doesn't get to see as much of the family pets as she'd like to. Everyone has their favourites too, Terry says old 'Nullarbor' is his favourite, "He's honest, and quiet to handle and he is a good eliminator. Charlie contemplates, "I'm real fond of 'Yeeda', but at the moment I expect great things from 'Freckles Brown'."

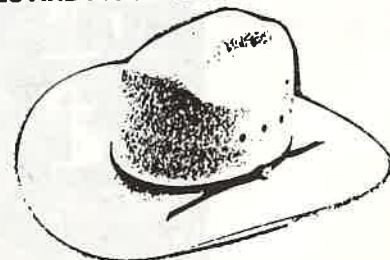

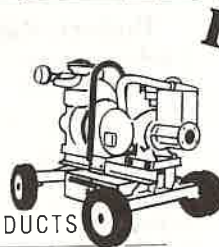
