

TERRY DAVIES: Terry grew up on a cattle station in the North West and has always enjoyed horse related sports. The first rodeo he ran was Busselton Festival Rodeo in 1969. Terry founded W.A. Rodeo Promotions now known as West Coast Rodeo Circuit and is just serving his first year on the committee under the name of W.C.R.C.

SKIP GORMAN: Skip is currently overseas so I have been asking his friends for details about him so let's hope we are accurate. Skip is about 46 years old, contests calf roping, team roping and has been involved as near as we can recollect for about 18 years, but it could have been longer. Skip 's served on the committee for 4 ears. In contrast to his rodeo Skip's day job is as a social worker with the mentally handicapped.

JENNY TRELOAR: Originally from New Zealand. Jenny has rodeoed for nine years. Currently holds the titles of All Round Cowgirl, Steer Undecorating and Breakaway Roping. She has served on the committee for 3 years and is a very strong contestant in the girls events and mixed team roping.

DEBBIE EDWARDS: Debbie is the daughter of Terry Davies, hence the start of her interest in rodeo. She spent two years as secretary of W.A. Rodeo Promotions before she married husband Grant 15 years ago. Debbie did compete in barrel racing for a few years. This is Debbie's first official year on the committe and she has been the travelling rodeo secretary for the past 2 years. She is also holding down the job of treasurer, which often sees her burning the midnight oil after the rodeo while everyone is enjoying the party.

BRETT EDWARDS: President of the W.C.R.C. Brett is one of the most successful contestants ever. He was 1983 Bareback National Champion. He went to the N.F.R. in 1988 and won the average. Brett spent several years competing successfully in Canada and the U.S.A.

DIANNE LAMBERT: Dianne is serving her first year on the W.C.R.C. committee. She became involved in rodeo when she first met husband Cody 13 years ago. Dianne competes on her mare Rumble Gold in Barrel Racing and Steer Undecorating.

MINT CROTHERS: Mint is serving his fifth year on the committee. Mint owns a string of bucking brones and competes in Saddle Brone, Calf Roping and Team Roping.

HANS OORSCHOT Hans is a relative newcomer to rodeo. He became involved two years ago when he took his horse Whitey to Cody Lambert for help. Since then Hans has thrown himself into the sport. He replaced another committee member midway through 1989 and was voted back in this year. Hans is the oldest contestant in the Steer Wrestling and the only grandfather to contest this event. Hans also Calf Ropes and Team Ropes.

DON RODGERS: Don and family moved west from Victoria about 6 years ago. Don has rodeoed for 20 years and has been on the W.C.R.C. committee for about 3 years. He is a strong contestant in Calf Roping, Steer Wrestling and Team Roping. Don puts in hours of practice at his Lower Chittering property where he is fortunate enough to have his own arena.

BRIAN HAMLIN: Brian originally hails from England and has been involved in rodeo for 3 years. He Team Ropes on his buckskin quarter horse Rumble Fonda. Brian has served on the committee since he first became involved.

GRANT EDWARDS: Rumour has it "It's illegal to run a rodeo in the west without Grant". He has been involved for 20 years, served on the committee for 13 years. Former rough stock rider Grant now sticks to the three time events. Grant and partners are heavily involved in rodeo production, running Stampede Arena and Brigadoon Bull Riding Spectaculars, stock contracting, time event, stock and broncs.

#### W.A. JUNIOR RODEO

22nd April, 1990

W.A.'s first junior rodeo was indeed a great success with a total of 119 competitors. Enthusiasm was not dampened at all despite the rain and gusty conditions. There were 19 entrants in the 12 years and under poddy ride but there were no times, somebody should have had a video camera. Stampede Arena was very muddy and we could have taken 1st prize in Graham Kennedy's home video show.

12 years and under bending race had 18 entrants, the final run off being between Danielle Mateljan and Cindy Parks with Danielle the victor for a purse of \$12. Danielle also had the big barrel racers looking worried when she took out the 12 years and under barrel race. She's a tough little rider and will be one of our top girls in the near future. Second to Danielle was younger brother, Dale, on his pony he broke himself. With third and fourth going to brothers Michael and Nathan Taylor.

Moving into 16 years and under we see some girls who are already seasoned veterans on the rodeo circuit. As was the case in breakaway roping. There were 6 entrants, 1st going to Megan Foley, 2nd Jessica Withnell and 3rd Raylene Wright. None of these three are strangers to the arena. In the bending race 1st was Joanne Sharpe and 2nd was Lynette Sanders, two new faces while two old hands took out 3rd and 4th, Sylvia Taylor and Megan Foley. The junior steer ride had 4 entrants with Jamie Reynolds being the time to take the total purse of \$30. Meanwhile there were 14 entrants in the 16 and under barrel race. 1st Peta Markham with 17.19, 2nd Pippit Withnell with 17.43, 3rd Jodie Gallagher with 18.25 and 4th Sandra Pollitt with 18.27. I guess if you are under 16 you are under 18 too and most of the girls entered both sections of barrel racing and improved their times dramatically into the bargain. 1st again was Peta Markham with 16.95, 2nd Sandra Pollitt with 17.25, 3rd Lisa Smith with 17.86 and 4th Jodie Gallagher with 18.04. Chute dogging for 18 years and under was another event where we really needed a video camera. It was a case of another one bites the mud. Reynolds brothers took nearly all the money home 1st Jamie in 1.36, 2nd Brett in 2.29, 3rd Kevin Jnr. in 2.66, with Steve Chasty getting 4th in 3.65. I hear Val Reynolds (their mum) had a busy wash day the next day. Bareback had 4 entrants, Steve Chasty was 1st with 53 points and Brett Reynolds was 2nd with 46 points. Likewise Saddlebrone had 4 entrants. Jason Atkinson being the only one to qualify with 50 points. There was also 4 entrants in the calf roping but no

2 A meeting of the current NRA judges is to be held on the 18th May 1990 to set up a judges panel in WA and organize a judges seminar and rodeo school.

3 The following is a NRA report prepared by Brian Hamlin in regard to the transportation of WA members to the NRA Finals.

BUS CHARTER — 46 seater would cost \$14,400 to hire which works our at \$313 per head. Travelling time vould take 4 days, 3 nights, 1 way.

AIR FARE — Group Booking 15 people in a group booking get 15% off which works out to \$1,010 per head.

ADVANCED AIR FARE — Seats must be booked 30 days in advance, penalties for concellations. Payment of \$772 must be paid 14 days before departure. You must stay for one

week. CHILD'S AIR FARE — \$594, if 10 children's air fares booked, 1 adult fare is reduced from \$772 to \$594.



I carried the Australian flag in the Grand Entry with Gail Bernardthe Queensland flag who is this year's runner up N.R.A. Rodeo Queen and is also the Charity Queen this year. I would like to thank everyone who competed in the Grand Entry. The next day we arrived at Widgee Rodeo, I would like to commend the committee on the hard work they put in to maintain the excellent arena conditions. We had another good Grand Entry which was well received by the spectators. The entries were very good this year with the stock in good condition. Unfortunately there was only one extrant in the Rodeo Queen Quest which was my sister Shellie Eisentrager who did a fantastic job selling tickets for the Widgee Rodeo Committee on the day. Congratulations Shellie! It would be nice to see a few more girls compete in the Rodeo Queen Contest as the committees put a lot of effort and support behind the Quest.

Rules for the Rodeo and Charity Queen Quest

Competitors aged 17 years and over

A one horse, one rider event with three judges, judging dress, personality, grooming and horse-

DRESS: Gloves riding only; Hat western felt or straw good quality; Belt western with buckle stamped, carved or buck stitch; Suit yoke western jacket or vest. Slacks must have belt loops and may have design on back and legs. Jacket may be yoked back or back and front and must be long sleeved with a blouse under.

BOOTS: Western top boots; Neck Tie and spurs optional.

The only time the dress rule may be lapsed is in the event of someone competing for the first time or a local competitor.

#### TOTAL OF 10 POINTS FOR:

GROOMING Presentation of horse, western saddlery may be carved or plain; western saddle blanket; western breast plate; western bridle and bit tiedowns may be used but do not obtain additional points.

#### HORSEWOMANSHIP: **TOTAL OF 10 POINTS**

The judge may choose his own pattern and then judge by the following method.

An experienced horseperson should be picked to judge this section and it must be remembered that it is actually the rider and not the horse to be judged. If the rider cannot put the horse through the required paces, then points are lost. All changes should be flying and done smoothly

Horse should be worked on a light rein. Halts are not to be sliding as in a reining event, but smooth, and the horse should not break into a trot. Seat and hands of rider are very important. The position of the riders hands should not change on the reins during the entire workout. Reins should be held while the other hand holds the loose part of the reins.

JUDGES are requested to judge by subtracting points for faults, commencing with thirty 30 points.

#### **TOTAL JUDGING POINTS 50**


Competitors don't need to be a member of the Association to compete in a single competition, but must be a member of the National Rodeo Association to compete in the end of the year competition.
