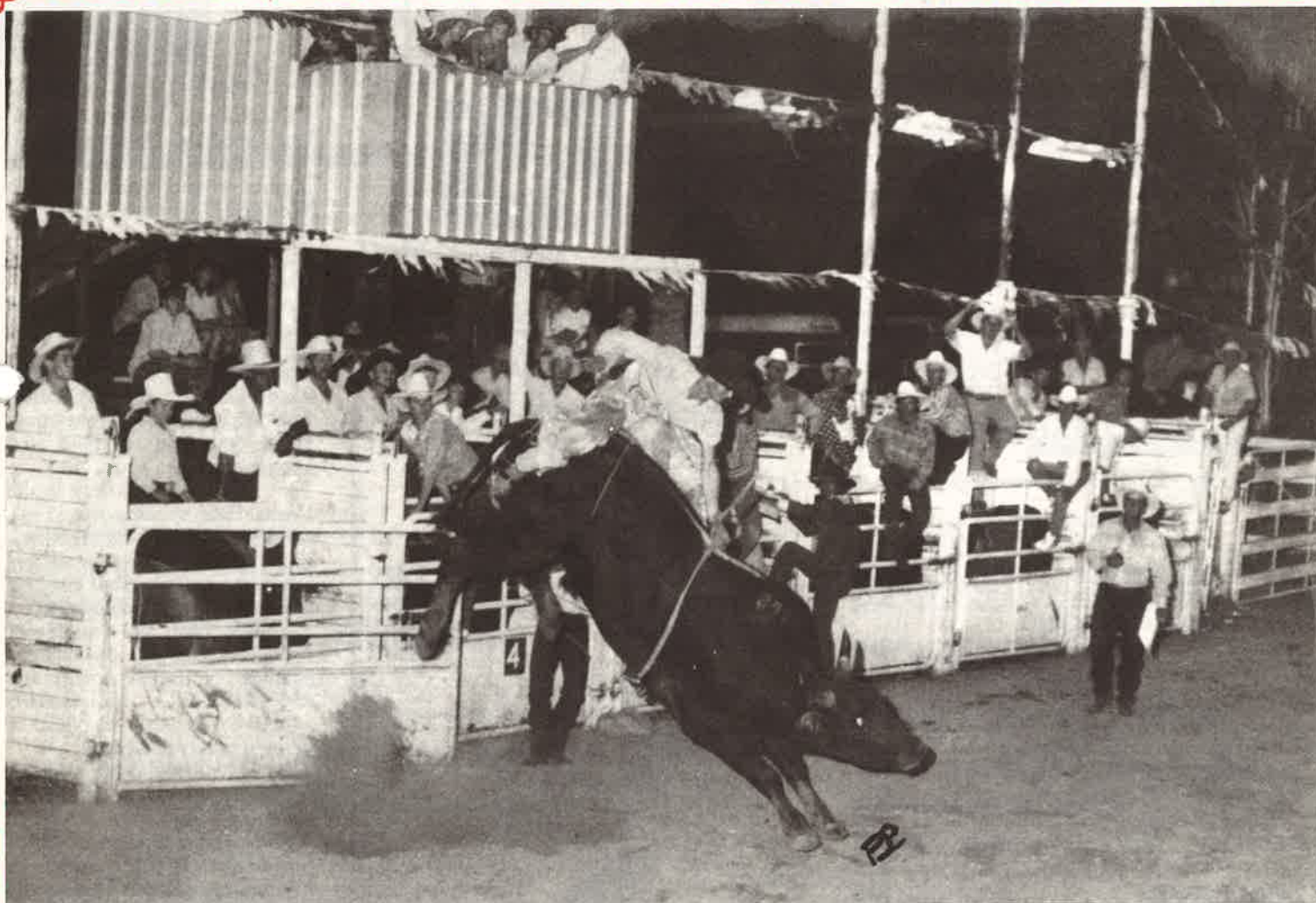

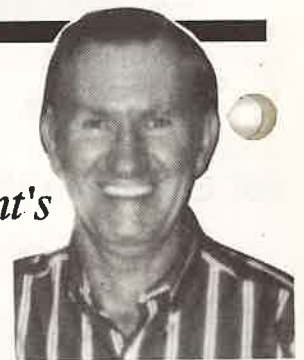

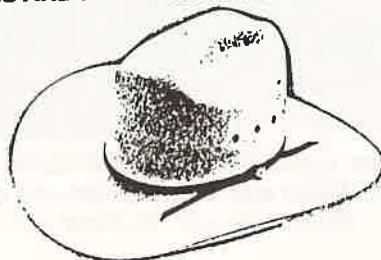

Junior Time Events

The National Rodeo Association is committed to the encouragement of Junior competitors in rodeo as a part of its concept of running professional presentations for the public.

The Juniors have been readily accepted by the spectators of rodeo where their events have been run. Recent time event junior competitions of barrel racing and breakaway roping have been successfully run by our association and your help is required in developing junior time event competitors. The association asks each committee to consider their individual circumstances to see if it is practical to run a junior time event. In some cases where there is a local pony club, the barrel race may be a logical alternative. For committees around the West Moreton - Caboolture area a junior breakaway roping may be considered, as there are junior breakaway roping in these areas who are very active in this event.

Please give the above your consideration when deciding the events to be run at your next rodeo. There are plenty of rodeo competitors who are willing to help in the running of these events at your request.

Oakey Rodeo

With very wet weather right up to the day of Oakey Rodeo we were all in doubt if it would run. Sunday morning gave us beautiful blue skies and the grounds just wet enough to have no dust flying.

The Bull Ride was won by 1988 Champion, Darren Jenkins of Gungalda. Darren did a great ride on one of Frank Bibble's top bucking bulls. Second place went to Mick Johnson of Boonah. Mick is one of the Johnson Brothers that own Bucking Bull of the Year "Deep Springs". Saddle Ride went to 1987 Champion, Stuart Grayson of Killarney followed by Mt Isa cowboy Jason Mendez.

The Bareback was won by Ipswich competitor, Maurice Morton with a top score of 71 points, second place went to Gympie cowboy, Col Clem.

Rope & Tie competitor, Allan Drinnen of Ipswich won his event to place Dick Howard of Warwick in second place, Jamie Knox of Chinchilla third and Jeff Keppel of Rosewood fourth.

Steer Wrestling event went to Warwick cowboy, Allan Flood followed by Ipswich competitor, Col Inman in second place and 1989 Champion, Mike McPhee went into third place.

The girls had a great day with Wendy Vitali taking out the Barrel Race. Wendy was a novice competitor until Sunday, now she is placed in the open competition. Another girl having a hot run is Glamorganvale cowgirl, Glenys Bate. Glenys placed second in the Barrel Race and I can't remember a rodeo where Glenys has not placed in this season. She is running hot and will be the girl to watch for the Barrel Race Title for 1990.

The other two Ladies events were won by the same girl. Sam Payne comes from Ipswich and is a lovely lady as well as a great competitor. It was nice to see Sam win the Steer Undecorating and the Breakaway Roping.

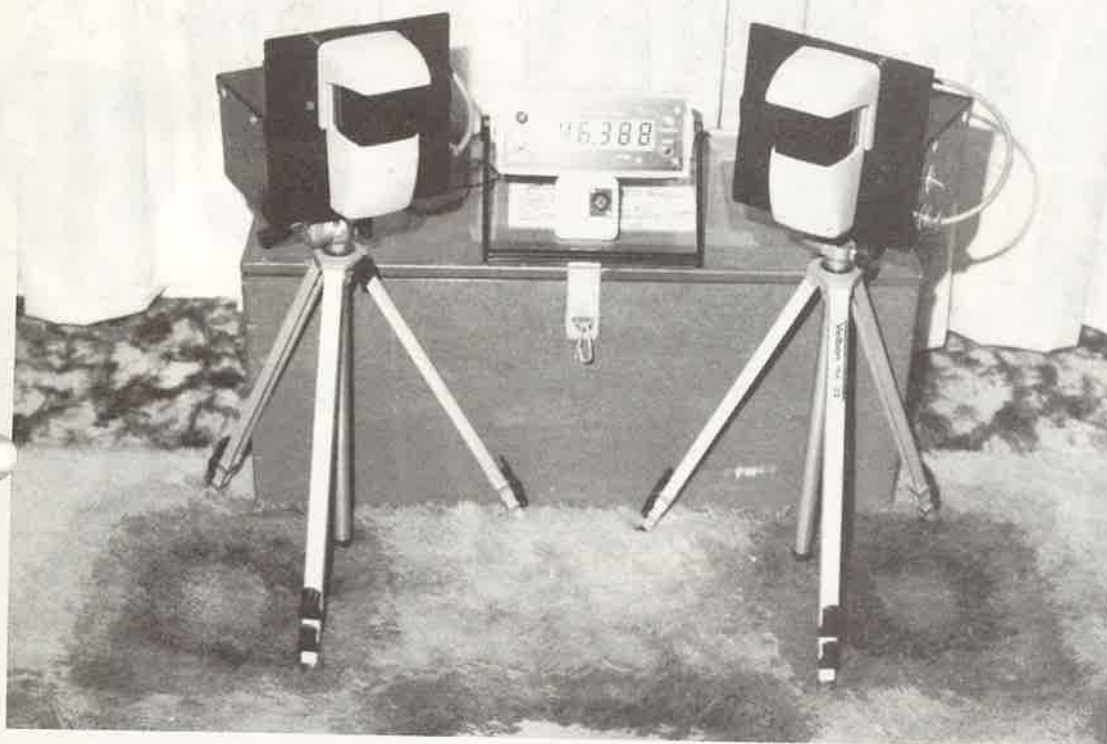

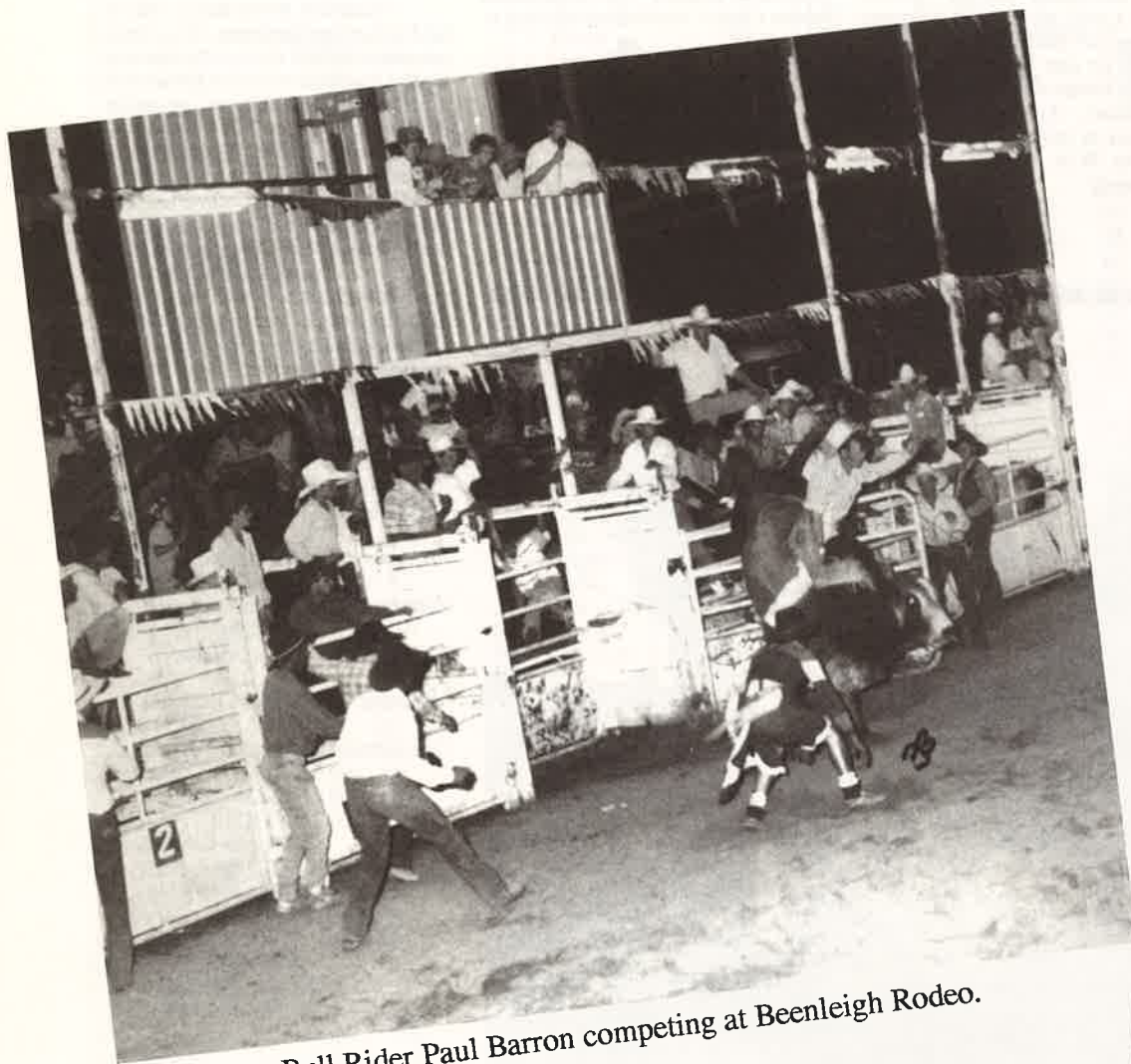

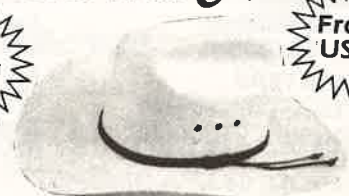
