

For committees aroung the West Moreton - Caboolture area a junior breakaway roping may be considered, as there are junior breakaway roping in these areas who are very active in





with a top Grand Entry in the middle of the day.


Oakey was the following week. We had a good grand entry which the spectators really seemed to enjoy.
