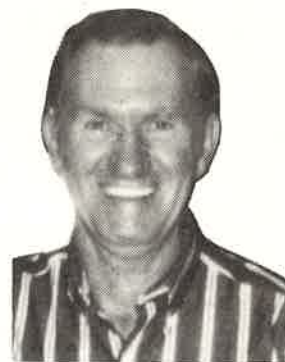

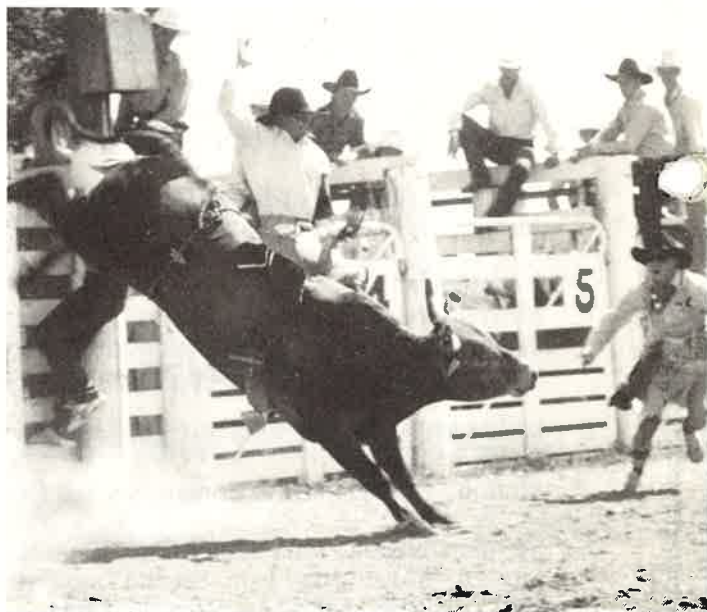

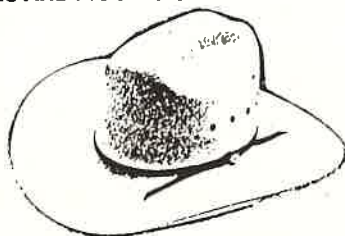

Profile

Bill Ornsby

Bill was born in Chelsea, Victoria. When he was only a little boy, if he wasn't teasing the kids from the local Catholic school, he was charging around on somebody's horse he may have seen in the paddock and decided it would be fun to ride without a saddle or bridle.

At the age of 14, he went to work in a blacksmith's shop for a hard old man by the name of Harry Larke. He worked for him for many years but in between getting the sack from Harry or quitting and being reinstated or asking for his job back he did various other jobs.

Having been a milkman with the old horse and cart and riding horses for other people, amongst other things, he was an amateur jockey, went hunting foxes and rode a few showjumpers.

I think his main love was rodeo which he travelled from one end of Australia to the other winning many titles along the way. His greatest achievement was holding seven consecutive titles in Western Australia, while his favourite event is the Bullride.

Then along came Marcia Fletcher, a publican's daughter. They met in Mareeba, North Queensland. Not long after, they were married and resided in Western Australia where they went to work on a thoroughbred stud in Northam. Here their first daughter, Debbie, was born. He then worked in the mines for a while in the Southern Cross where their second daughter, Kerrie, came along.

He couldn't stay away from the horses for too long, so he and Marcia, the two girls, a few kangaroo dogs and all the possessions in a car and trailer, moved to Armidale to work a stud, where their third daughter Robyn was born.

Bill started Northam Rodeo off by riding a bucking horse at the showgrounds. The chute consisted of the horse being tied to the side of a truck. The Northam Rodeo has been going ever since.

He had not competed for years but rode a saddle bronc horse at Shepparton Old Timers Rodeo twelve years ago. Bill is still very involved by judging at many rodeos and a few times has watched his wife, Marcia, go to the pay out window to pick up Steer Undecorating winnings. Also the three girls have been strong competitors in Barrel Racing and Steer Undecorating. It won't be long before the third generation will also be fronting up to the winners circle.

Bill Ornsby has helped a great deal of young people get started into Rodeo and I have often heard him say that Rodeo is one of the greatest sports there is.
