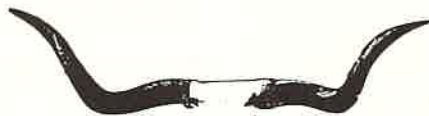

Jack Freeman is one of the most easily recognised men in our rodeo circuit. Jack & his wife Jenny live in Midland W.A. He has two daughters and two grandchildren. A fulltime working stockman and horse trader.

Originally from Queensland Jack tasted the sport in the tent riding as a schoolboy for the great, and late Tex Morton. Jack quit riding rough stock at the age of 45. A past calf roper who still enjoys team roping with his partners Norm & Crystal Pascoe he hopes to be roping with their twin boys in the future.

In 1973 at Northam W.A. Jack & Gayle Taylor won the first official team roping in W.A. As a judge and announcer he knows most of us better than we know him, always

doing a great job.

Jacks experience in the equine world is insurmountable ranging from rodeo showjumpers trotters cutting horses with a string of top horses along the way. Rex, Goucho, Bowie (Quarter Ben Meda), Pilot a top roping horse in W.A. & was also W.A. top cutting horse, and of course Blue Jacks present mount a grey QH throughbred X gelding always immaculately turned out.

Noted for his leather craftsmanship and knowledge of saddlery.

Greg Horsham won the first round on McKinnon with 76 points. However Steve Chasty took out the average in a big way. Steve has 65 points on Nullarbor for second place in the first round.

Then came the final and Steve rode Paleface for a whopping great 84 points. George Baker was third in the first round and second in the average. Shelley Spouge won the barrell race in a slick 13.63 seconds. Eva Withnell was a close second with 13.77. Up and coming tough contenders Peta Markham and Lisa Angel were 3rd and 4th. Meanwhile 11 year old Danielle Mateljan put up such a good ride and thrilled the crowd so much in her first open barrell race she gained herself a sponsor in Bob East from the Heme Hill Stockfeeders.

Lindsay George won the Steer Wrestling in 4.05, Grant Edwards was second in 4.16 and Cody Lambert was third in 4.35, which made for fast and furious action in the dogging.

Well excitement is certainly mounting as we go to the final on August 25th and the end of the winter series.

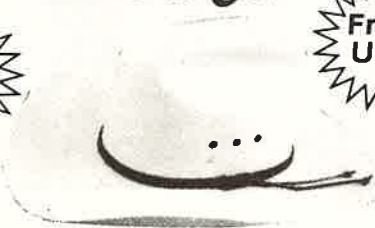

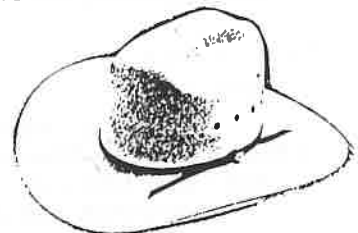

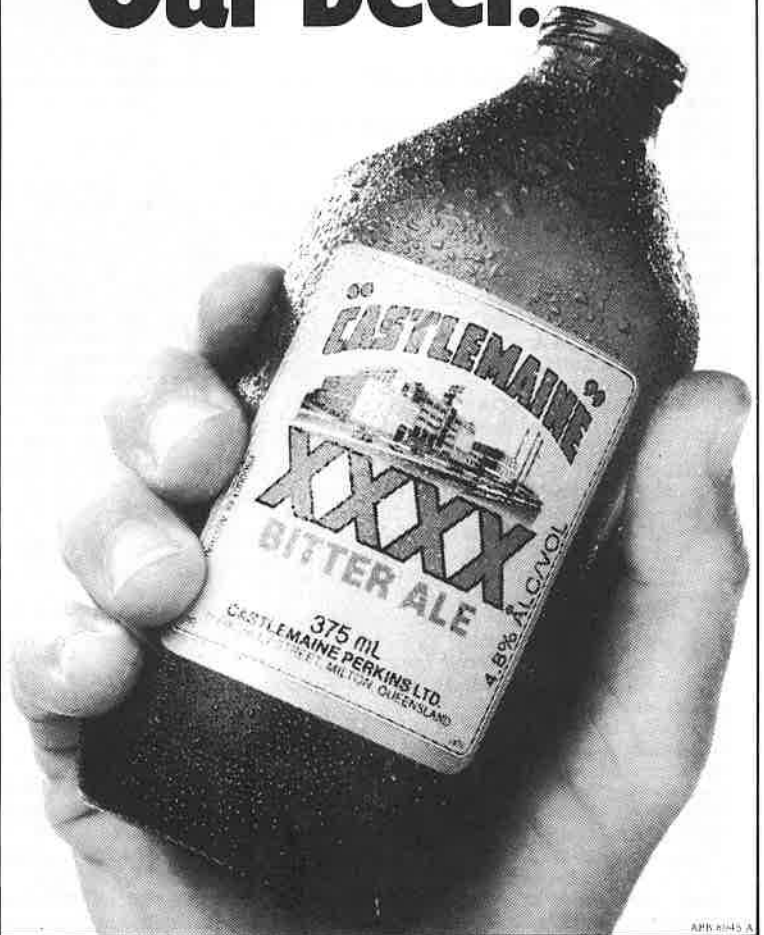
