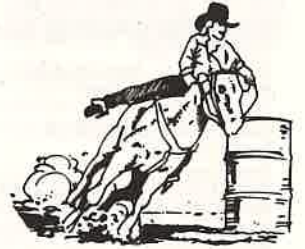

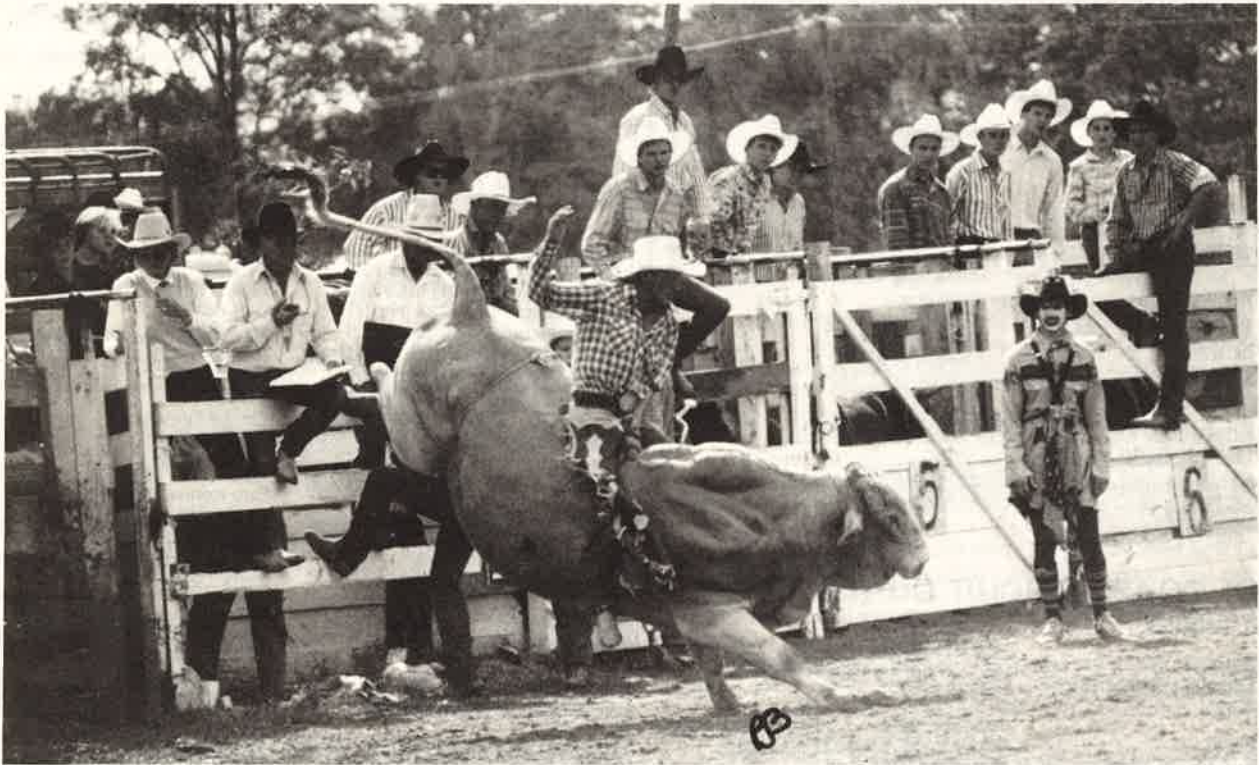

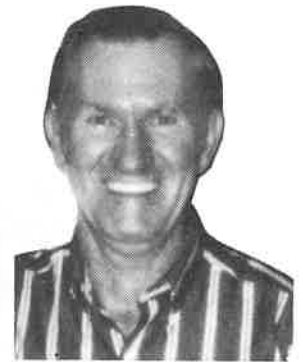

Profile

Graham Sidney De-Courcy-Browne



Graham is 27 years of age, originally coming from New South Wales in 1984 where he took up a trade in Queensland as a Decorative Plasterer. He is currently self-employed in this trade.


With the sport of Rodeo well etched in the family, it didn't take him long to track down the S.E.Q.R.R.A. and become a member. Graham's father, Arthur (Darcy Browne), was an active competitor in the sport of Rodeo for many years, in both the ARRA and ABCA, so family support has always been high since the days of Poddy Riding. With two brothers competing along side him in the past and present, it has helped him strive to achieve.

Since joining the (S.E.Q.R.R.A.) National Rodeo Association in 1984, Graham has competed in all Rough Stock Events successfully. He has

qualified for the finals five years running, in Bullock Riding, twice being runner-up champion and three times for Bronc Riding.

1990 saw Graham run fourth in the Bronc Riding Standings, which won him Novice Bronc Rider. In that year Graham drew "Honkey Tonk" on three different occasions. Kilcoy and Killarney saw him place on "Honkey", but going into the finals he had still not had a win in the Saddle Bronc Event. This all changed as Graham took "Honkey Tonk" in the first round at the finals. "Honkey" gave him his first win in a long and tough season and three out of three for him over "Honkey".

1991 has had its ups and downs (literally), but with high ambitions and plenty of support and help from fellow competitors, 1991 will see Graham in the race for the pay window and the spoils.

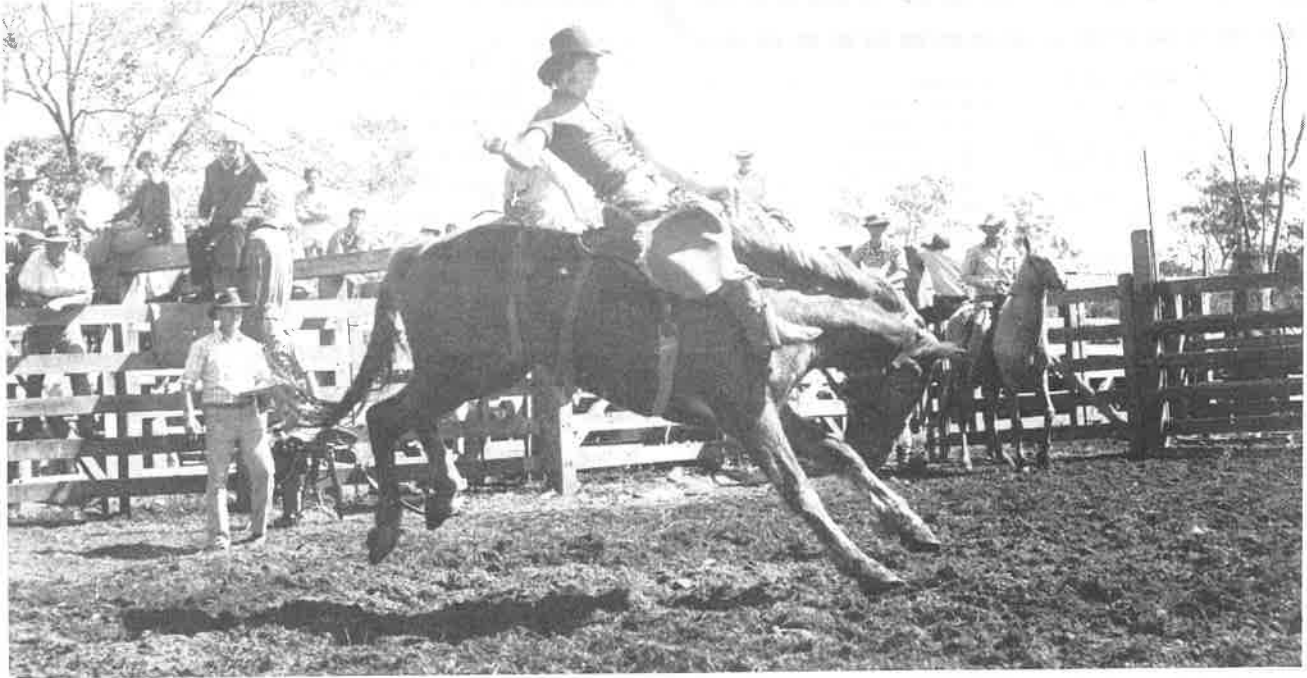
