

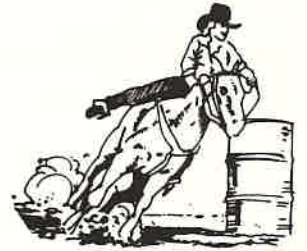

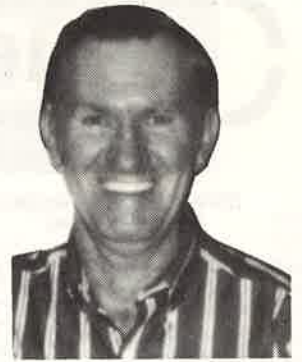

PRESIDENTS REPORT



The National Rodeo Council of Australia Ltd has been finally formed. The name is registered with the Government and directors appointed. One of the first ventures is to organise an interstate circuit series, between the N.R.A. (S.E.Q. and West Coast) A.B.C.R.A. and the C.R.C.A.

A judiciary has also been selected to hear any disputes. The judiciary comprises: Keith Button (ABCRA), Darryl Baulch (CRCA) Carl Piggott (AHPG) and myself (NRA). Should any member of any association be suspended or fined they will have thirty days in which they can appeal to the council. This is to take effect immediately. We will be advising of further development as they are put in place.

The N.R.A. Finals for 1992 will be conducted at Pine Lodge on Friday 20 November, 1992, Saturday 21 November, 1992 and Sunday 22 November, 1992. This is a new format and we hope a successful one.

I have a special notation for committees. You must forward your affiliation fee when your date is booked. Failure to comply could mean your date is not held. The N.R.A. is having increasing difficulties in finding enough dates to suit all parties, therefore we want to ensure all our committees receive days, and holding a date could cost a Rodeo.

To wind up this report I trust you will accept our new format with an executive director reporting on a bi-monthly basis. This hopefully will give members an insight into each area of management and a lot broader coverage of what the executive directors are achieving.

HISTORIC DAY FOR RODEO

Friday May 8, 1992, was a historic day for Australian Rodeo.

These leading Rodeo Associations signed a Contract to officially form the National Rodeo Council of Australia Limited.

Now that the Council has been formed, the three member Associations will benefit greatly through the combination of sponsorship, media exposure and promotional activities.

The Council's Board of Directors comprises Executive members of the National Rodeo Association, the Australian Bushmen's Campdraft and Rodeo Association, the Queensland Central Cowboys Association, and three businessmen who are committed to the future of Rodeo.

The idea to form a Council originated from the Hinterland Rodeo Classic which was held in 1991. Carl Piggott, Ron Bryant and George Brown, the businessmen referred to above, participated in the organising of this tremendously successful rodeo which attracted in excess of 5,000 people.

The National Rodeo Council of Australia Limited is the culmination of many months of discussion between the groups involved. These discussions have led to agreement of how rodeo should be staged to

benefit members, committees and involved Associations and to ensure that rodeo achieves its full potential as a spectator sport evolving from our national heritage.

Over the next few months, the Council will hold a Circuit Series Final, whereupon Associations involved will all compete in the Series to eventually qualify for a Grand Championship Event.

The policy of the Council lists sixteen points, a few of which are listed hereunder:

- To supplement prize monies offered by member Associations.
- To promote and foster Junior Competitions and to encourage Junior Competition Training Seminars and other activities.
- To introduce and administer a Master Insurance and Provident Fund policy to provide appropriate cover for all competitors.

To distribute profits of the Council to member Associations annually.
