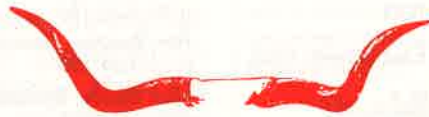

Credit Card Members, please note that entries will not be accepted on any other number other than the Cred Card Number which is (074) 95 8696.

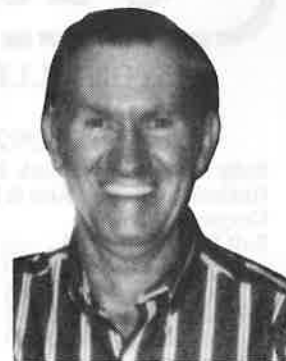

PRESIDENTS REPORT

Three of the major Rodeo associations in Australia have formed a National Rodeo Council the notable absentee being the APRA which declined an offer to join. The Council will become the governing body for Rodeo in this country. The Council will conduct a register of all Association members, committees, contractors etc. It will represent all parties in the area of Animal Welfare, Marketing and Promoting. The associations will have two representatives on the board of this newly formed council.



The Australian Heritage Promotion Group will on behalf of the Council be responsible for all marketing, sponsorship and special promotions. This group will work in conjunction with the council and funds collected will be distributed as agreed at Council level. The AHPG are not being paid a retainer but will collect a percentage of the income that may be derived by their efforts.

The National Rodeo Association retains the rights to market itself and seek sponsorship therefore not everything has changed. Brad Ison will remain in control of Marketing the N.R.A. and its affiliated committees. However anything forthcoming from the AHPG will put the icing on the cake.

We as a sport are about to begin a new phase of marketing. To do this successfully, everyone must co-operate. It is the intention of all to increase prizemoney as a matter of urgency. Therefore your presentation, i.e. dress, manner, may have a bearing on prospective sponsors. The ball is now in your court. Don't let the team down.
