

## **Executive Director Marketing**

This being my first report for 1993, I firstly would like to review last year. As far as marketing, the NRA highlight of the year was our Finals where we saw a few firsts for the NRA.

It was the first time the NRA had put together a am of people to market the finals to sponsors and the public. Through the dedication and hard work of these people, the NRA for the first time had a number of national companies sponsoring the finals and recognizing the benefits of being associated and endorsed by the NRA and sport of Rodeo. This very well could be the beginning of our recognition in the market place. The sponsorship gained enabled the NRA for the very first time to be able to use metropolitan commercial television in its advertising programme.

This television advertising not only lifted Rodeo's profile in the eyes of the public, but probably saved the finals from a financial loss when on a Saturday night we were hit with a power blackout and thunder storms and still managed in the dark to

get a good crowd.

Two of these major sponsors were introduced to the NRA via one of our members giving me a lead on them and assisting in the introduction. This member being Mike Ross and to him on behalf of the NRA I say thanks.

This year the NRA took on promoting

Rosewood Rodeo. From a marketing stand, this Rodeo carried more advertising and more sponsorship, I believe, than it has in many years and with the hard work by Terry McHugh and Paul Range on the day and lead up to it, I am sure you agree that it paid off with a very successful rodeo which returned to what it wend to be

turned to what it used to be.

Rodeo Committees. Later this year the NRA hopes to incorporate a six Rodeo series with a multiple of sponsors. For us to put this together and market it to sponsors we need six rodeos to be involved in it. MegaBULL Spectacular, will be held indoors at Pinelodge Equestrian Centre, Thomlands and it is hoped that this on-going rodeo interest in this area will enhance our finals. I personally would be appreciative for any help with this promotion.

In recent months I have been doing a fair amount of work associated with the National Rodeo Council of Australia. I have come to know these people and their ideals a lot closer and I believe them to be very dedicated to improving and lifting the profile of our sport to where it belongs. At the moment with the Australian economy the way it is and other influences, this is one hell of a tough job, but they are still going forward learning and stronger all the time, whereas, I am sure others would have spat the dummy long ago. Everybody in rodeo can assist for example, support and buy the magazine which represents us, "Rodeo in Australia". Consider advertising in this magazine, as it is a great medium. ## Wiangaree Rodeo postponed

Wiangaree Rodeo has been postponed until 24 April, 1993. Remember, if you have already entered you do not have to enter again. If you would like to enter and didn't before, you still can, as long as it is before the closing date. If you have entered and are not going now, you must phone the office and cancel your nominations.

## **Fines**

If you have presented N.R.A. a cheque and it has bounced the penalty will be \$30 to cover bank charges and a fine. If you have bounced 2 cheques, you will not be able to present N.R.A. another cheque. It must be a money order/cash/bank cheque.

## How Novice Works

Once you have reached the \$500 limit in novice money only, you are no longer eligible for novice. It does not matter if you were in the top ten standings in the finals the year before.

## **Credit Card explained**

Credit Card is no longer. This is called Central Entries as the \$50/\$15 bond you have paid into Central Entries is not to be used.

At each rodeo you must pay for your nominations for that day or your next nominations will not be accepted, regardless of the excuse you may have. If you have entered for the next rodeo and you do not have \$50/\$15 bond in Central Entries and you go the distance to travel to Rodeo and your name is not on the list, do not raise your voice to the secretary. It is

your own fault for not having your bond up-todate. If you are not sure give the office a ring and find out how much you have in Central Entries before you travel to the next rodeo.

All monies must be in hand at head office before we can accept your entries for the following rodeo. For example, you cannot phone up stating that you will update at the following rodeo to bring your bond back up-todate.
