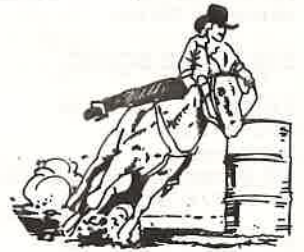

Written confirmation should have a cheque for affiliation fees included. A program should be submitted three months prior to the rodeo date, enabling it to be advertised in the two newsletters. Failure to comply could result in your rodeo date being given to another

committee. Don't take for granted a phone call is all that is required.

All Event Directors have been issued with National Rodeo Council of Australia Raffle Tickets. We require these to be sold as a matter of urgency, a percentage of all proceeds go to the National Rodeo Association and your event. With a team effort, let's make short work of disposing of these tickets.

Persons wishing to contract, promote, clown, judge, pick up, chute boss, announcing, time keep at National Rodeo Association Rodeos to have your name

listed in the newsletter. You must be a member. Non paid memberships will result in your name being removed from the contract listings.

The National Rodeo Association has investigated a number of bounced cheques. The end result being any member that has two dishonoured cheques will be put on cash only, plus having a fine levy for costs incurred.

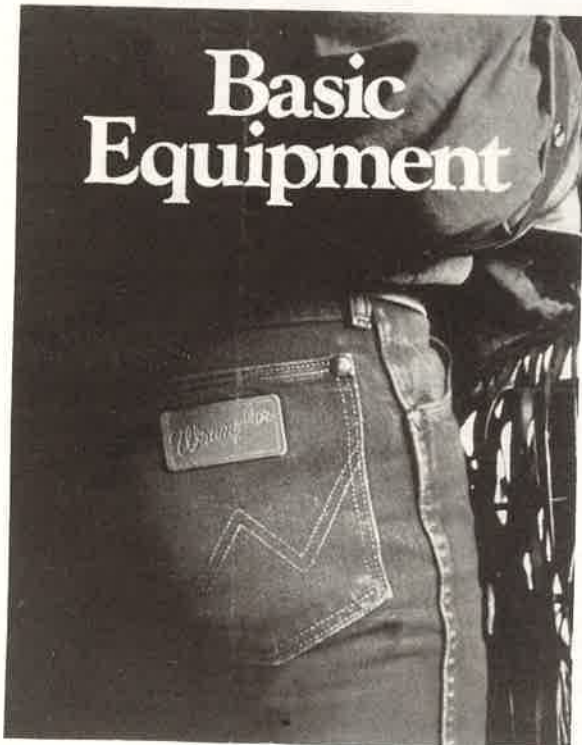

DID YOU KNOW????



Did you know that garlic is good for horses with respiratory problems and dust allergies?

Garlic contains vitamins A, B1, B2, B3 and C, minerals and essential oils which contain sulphur and a substance called called Crontonaldehyde. Garlic helps to clear the mucus

from the back of the throat and nose that causes coughing and also clears cholesterol from the blood.

This powerful herb can also help with laminitis, rheumatism and has even been known to prevent sweet-itch, although it is suspected that the smell of the garlic fed horse helps to repel the flies that cause the itching!

To feed garlic to your horse, just add a couple of crushed cloves to the daily feed.

Bots, Your Horse's Biggest Nuisance

If there's one problem with this time of year it's the female Bot Fly laying her eggs all over your horse, particularly on the inside of his front legs, mane, neck and even on the quarters. You do have to be extra careful when handling horses around Bot Fly season because horses will often become very jumpy and can kick out or strike to rid themselves of the stinging Bot Fly. Make sure you don't accidentally cop a kick in the middle of all this!

The larvae can burrow into your horse's mouth and work their way to the throat where they are swallowed. Once in the stomach, the larvae attach themselves to the stomach lining where they stay for around six months, becoming a considerable size before they release their grip and pass out of the stomach with the dung.

If no preventative action, such as regular worming, is taken during these Autumn months, you may risk your horse's health as the larvae can easily cause

gastric irritation resulting in colic, even causing stomach ulcers. Apart from worming regularly with a wormer containing a Boticide, you can also help reduce the risk of infection by removing the eggs. This can be a laborious task.

There are a couple of remedies for removing Bot eggs. You can wash your horse down with warm water, this will stimulate the eggs to hatch and consequently the larvae will die. Alternatively, you can buy a specially designed Bot knife from your local saddle store or a disposable razor will do the job just as well. Be warned not to use your father's razor as he'll most likely object to having his razor used on your horse!! All you need to do is carefully run the knife or razor over the eggs, taking care not to cut into your horse. If your horse fidgets, get someone to hold him whilst you are doing this. For the best on-going results, it's always wise to remove any eggs every time you groom.

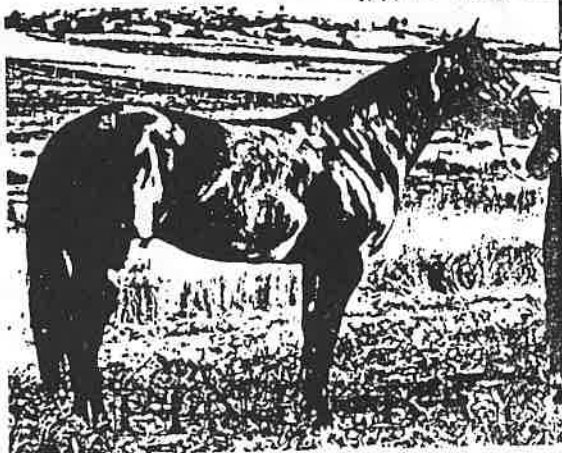
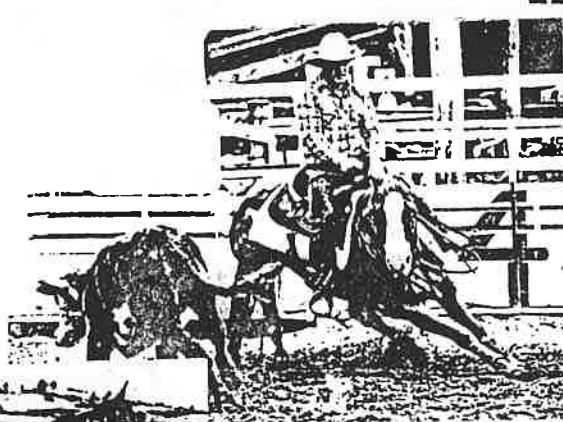
