# Rodeo Plan

**10,000-seat stadium mooted for Bundamba**

A BUNDAMBA site has been earmarked for a 10,000-seat rodeo and equestrian stadium.

Ipswich Events Corporation manager Ken Thackeray yesterday confirmed the National Rodeo Council of Australia had agreed to consider a site off the Warrego Highway as the preferred location for the mooted \$1 million complex.

The land is west of the Bognuda St. CSR wood panels plant and on the Ipswich side of the Warrego Hwy.

The rodeo council plans to make Ipswich its national headquarters because of its proximity to large population centres, rail links and main roads.

Mr. Thackeray said several locations had been studied since the project was announced in September. Preference had come down to the Bundamba site and land at Wulkuraka.

He stressed the project was still in its early stages and said the rodeo council would meet Ipswich City Council to talk about the finer details of the proposed stadium.

The site is likely to be leased back to the NRCA by council on a 10-year basis for nominal rent. No development schedule has been finalised. "But it is developing positively. Everyone is carefully weaving their way through this," Mr. Thackeray said.

While use of the complex will be centred on the rodeo circuit, Mr. Thackeray said the

stadium would adopt a multi-function purpose for year long use.

It has been estimated five people would be employed full-time in administration and an equal number to handle stock.

A further 30 to 40 will be employed part-time for weekly events.

# BUCK JUMPING HONKY TONK !

*The star Buckjumpers Honky Tonk,  
he's a gelding of renown.*

These lines were written in a song about this great horse some year back when Rupert Hatherall of Murgon Queensland had the big bay in his bucking string.

From the first time Rupert bucked Honky he knew he had something special. Local cowboys would come to the Hatherall Pen on their weekends to practice and it wasn't long before the great horse's reputation began to spread throughout the Rodeo fraternity.

Whilst Rupert has had some great bucking horses over the years, without a doubt Honky Tonk is the best ever run into a chute. In 1985 Honky won the first of his unprecedented five straight saddle bronc of the year titles. At the end of 1989 Rupert sold his bucking string to Stuart and Chris Grayson of Killarney, and although Rupert had received offers of considerable size from other contractors, the big horse found his way to the Grayson property with the rest of the string.

After two years as the king of the Grayson Saddle Broncs, they decided to try him in the Bareback Ride. A decision that proved to be the right one as he was only ridden a couple of times in the first six months of the year.

Honky Tonk's spectacular exits from the chutes and awesome 'High Kicking Action' would leave Australia Champions and rookies alike a short walk back to the chutes.

Whilst there have been some memorable rides done on this great equine athlete, the ride of North Queensland Champion, Norm Stagg at the N.R.A. Finals in 1989 that earned him 84 points in the Saddle Ride stands out as the best I've seen in that event. While champion central Queensland cowboy, Brendan Clarke's 86 at Beaudesert National Council and N.R.A. Champion, Mark Stephenson's fantastic hard spurring ride at Caloundra that earned him 85 points, stand out as the best I've seen in the Riggin Event.

These consistently high scores made on the great Honky Tonk are a tribute to the horse's big heart and undoubted ability. As are the 1992 N.R.A. Bareback horse of the year and 1992 N.R.C.A. bareback horse of the Australian titles he earned in his first year as a bareback horse even at 26 years of age you know that when you see No. 1 in the Grayson String drawn next to your name you're going to have to cowboy up.
