Committees, please note! Can you please make sure that you send your affiliation money in with your program at least 2 months before your rodeo. This way your rodeo can be well advertised and there is no last minute rushing.

This month I would like to welcome the Charters Towers Rodeo and Glenmorgan Rodeo. Charters Towers is only a \$2,000.00 bull ride and no other events. Glenmorgan Rodeo is a full maximum point Rodeo. It is great to see more committees joining the N.R.A. and I trust the members it

will show great respect for these committees. If we don't have committees, we don't have rodeos and were would we be today. Last month I received a letter from a spectator who went to a recent rodeo stating how professional the rodeo was run and it is a credit to all the competitors on a job well done.
