I would like to introduce you to Sue Gagno who is now doing Central Entries at the rodeos. In the past a couple of cowboys have given a hard time which only results in making it harder for Sue and longer for you to wait. When paying nominations, state your name until Sue gets to know you all. As for the Judges Sheets, Sue cannot do payout without them, so if you're around the judges when the event is completed, we would very much appreciate if you could pass them up to the office, as the longer we wait for the Judges Sheets, the longer the competitors wait for the payouts.

Committees, please remember that as of the 1st August, 1993, all affiliation forms and fees must be paid at least three months before your rodeo. Failure to do this will constitute another rodeo booking your date on paying their affiliation fee first. All bookings are requested to be in writing so there will be no confusion of wrong dates. Committees would now have received affiliation forms to be completed and returned three months prior to the rodeo. This makes it easier for Head Office and allows your rodeo ample time to be advertised in the Sports News newsletter. No rodeo will be advertised in the Sports News if the affiliation fee has not been paid.

Remember, all memberships are due soon so if you are paying for a membership, remember to state which year!

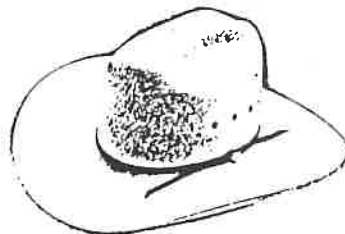

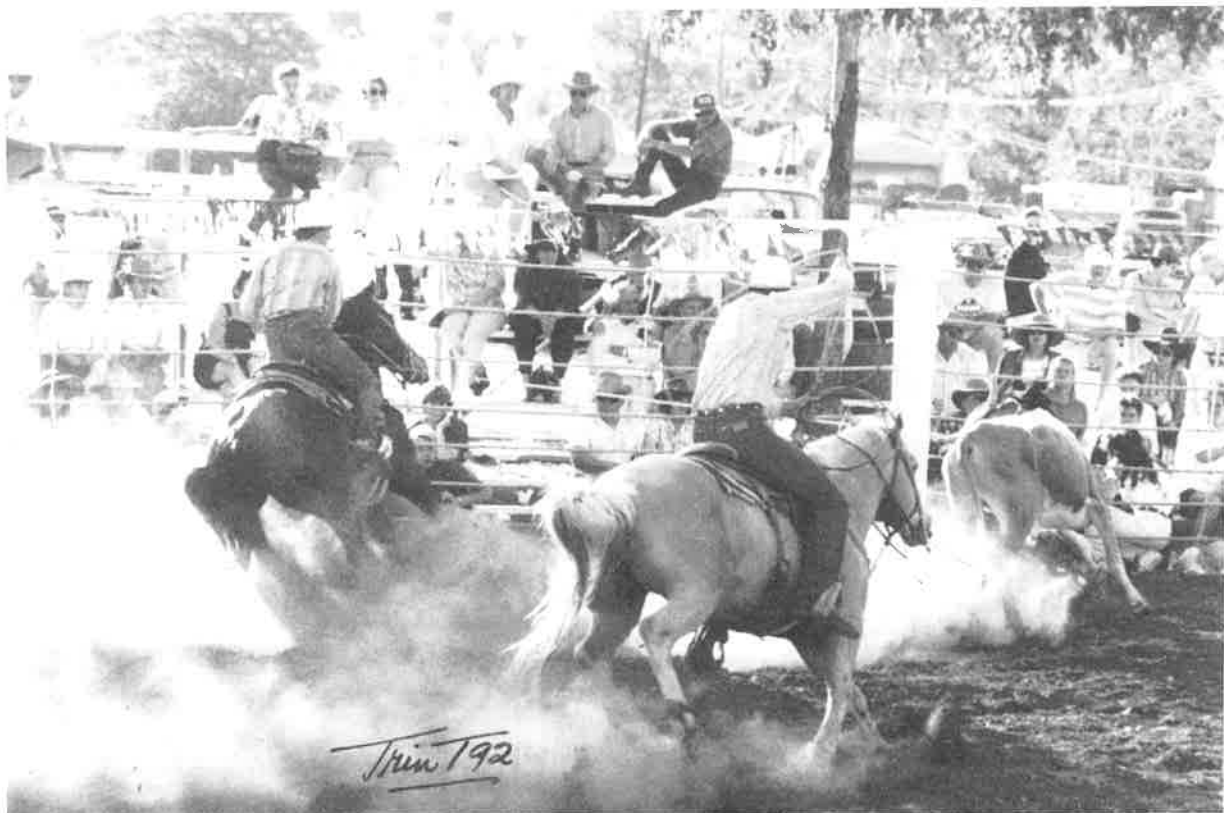

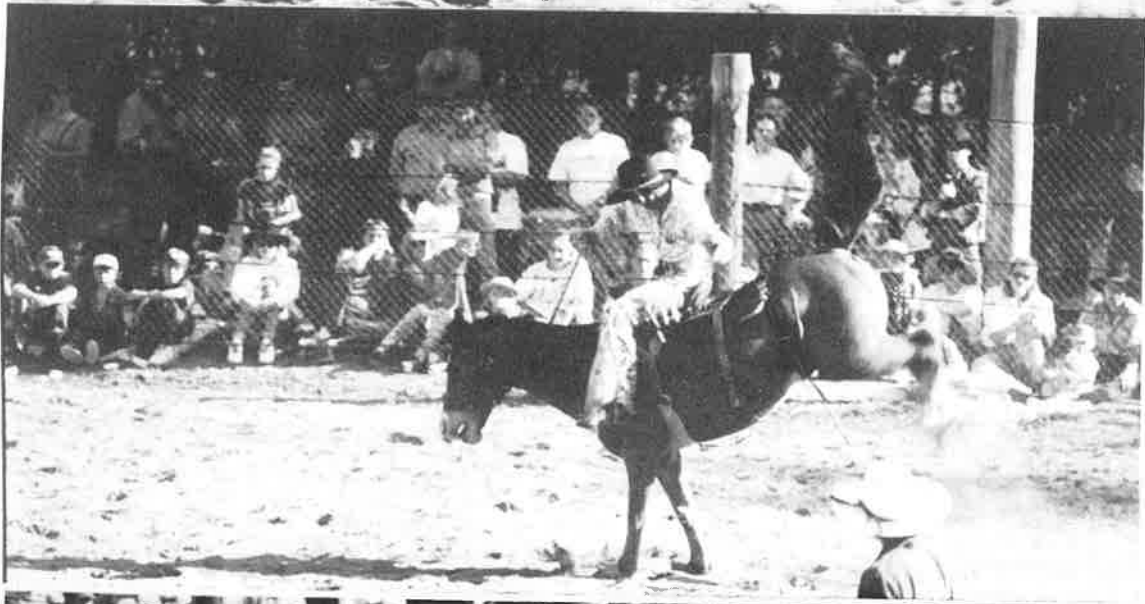
