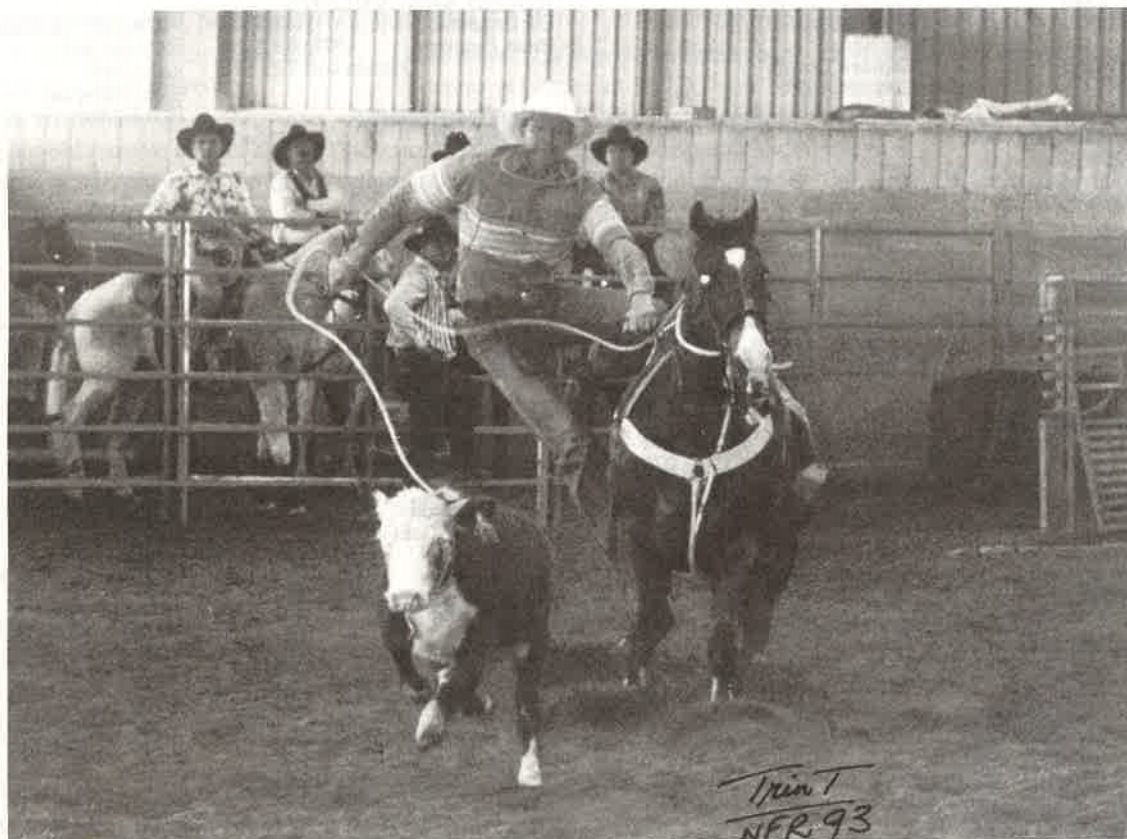

This month is looking great with a rodeo or two a weekend. Starting with Brookfield Rodeo on April 2, will have a Jackpot Steer Wrestling. We are then off to Redbank Plains on the 3rd.

Rosewood Rodeo & Junior the following weekend. Members please note that Glenmorgan Rodeo will be running on April 23. You must re-nominate as the entries will not be transferred over.

If you are in the top 5 at the Pro-Masters you should receive a letter about nominating and requirements as the Pro-Masters are running on June 3, 4 & 5, 1994.

The next couple of months are looking very busy with rodeos. The N.R.A. are looking better as far as rodeos are concerned. There are an extra thirteen new rodeos and more to come. Unfortunately, not many of these are maximum point award rodeos as most of the new committee members are wanting to start with

minimum points to see how their rodeo runs.

I would very much like to welcome on behalf of the N.R.A., all our new committee members — you know who you are, and wish you all a successful rodeo.

Beenleigh Rodeo will be running on May 7. Please remember to re-nominate for Beenleigh as the entries will not be transferable.

Unfortunately, if you haven't paid your membership yet an extra \$10.00 will be charged as a penalty. If you are not going to rejoin, you are better off resigning and getting your \$50/\$15 C/E Bond refunded. Wait for three months then compete on a day membership when you want. If you don't pay your membership and don't resign for that year, you still owe your membership for that year and cannot complete until you pay your dues. So make your mind up before its too late otherwise you will be owing more money than you expected.

If you have any queries about the points standing, do not ask me at the Rodeo as I

do not know everybody's points off the top of my head, they all must be put in writing and sent to head office. Thank you.

All novice competitors, do not forget to have a look at the standings and if you are 500 or over in the novice standing you have then broken Open and are no longer eligible for novice money, points and cannot compete in Novice events. If you do not know what Novice means, it means if you are a new competitor in an event and have not been in the top ten standing in a recognised body, you are then eligible for Novice.

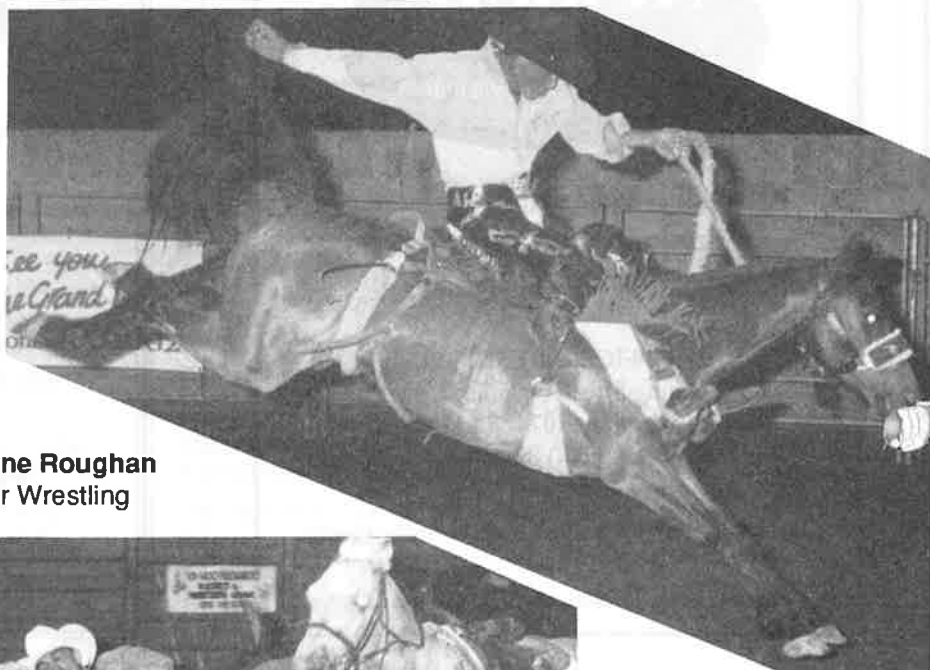

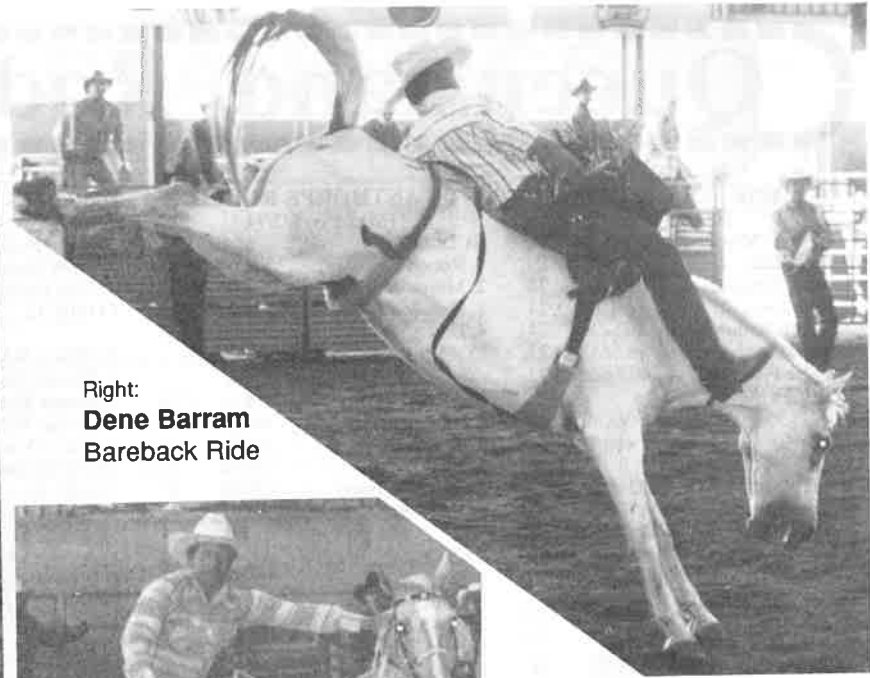

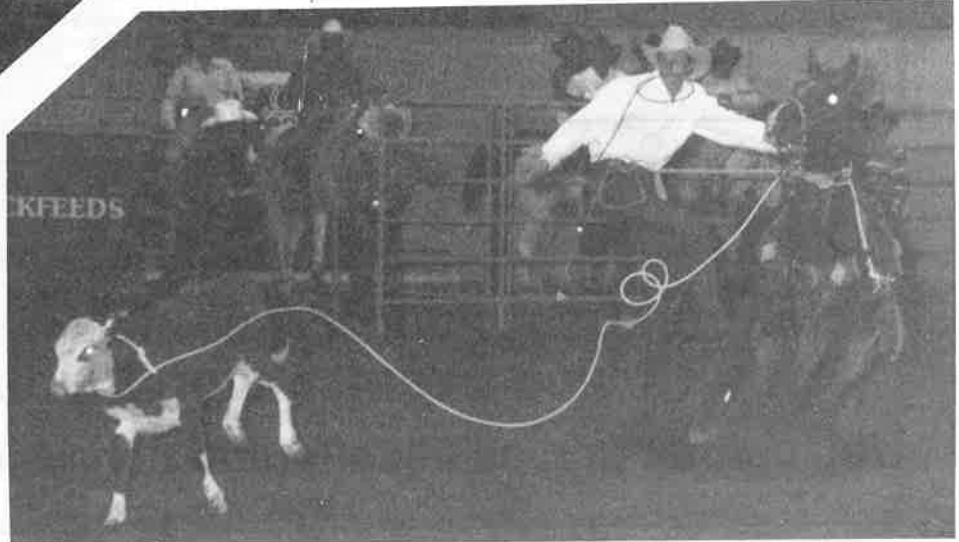
