

PUBLIC LIABILTY COVERAGE

When organising a public event like a Rodeo, the responsibility which the organising committee owes all spectators is a duty of care to ensure that the spectators do not injure themselves in any way whilst attending the event.

The duty of care extends to potential injury which a spectator sustains through own actions. These actions could appear, to the average person, to be reckless or without due caution for their own safety, however, the organising committee can still be held liable. It is the committee's responsibility to ensure they have adequate coverage. Don't believe it won't happen to you! There are many disturbing cases about those who do!

The other important issue is the paperwork required to ensure the event is covered to the satisfaction of the Insuring Company. Do not assume that your Rodeo is covered by the Public Liability Coverage of the "Show Society" or "Owner" of the property you are using. In most case you are not covered.




