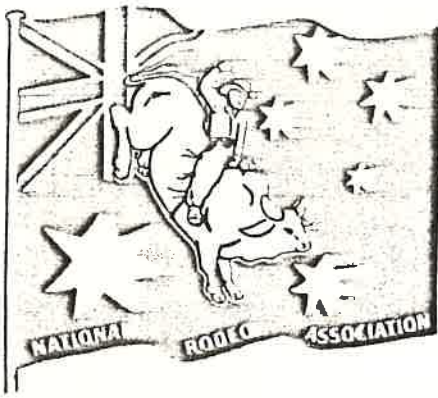

NEW RULES CHANGES AS OF THE S.G.M. 4TH DECEMBER, 1993.

1. BARREL RACE; NO BARRELS TO BE SET UP IN THE ARENA AFTER COURSE IS PEGGED.
2. BARREL RACE; MEASUREMENTS ARE TO BE WRITTEN DOWN ON THE JUDGES SHEET OF BARREL RACE COURSE WHEN THERE IS MORE THAN ONE ROUND, ALSO MUST HAVE COPY IN OFFICE AND THE DIRECTOR TO HAVE A COPY.
3. JUNIOR BARREL RACE; THE DRUMS FOR THE JUNIOR BARREL RACE MAY BE MOVED IF IT IS CONSIDERED SAFER.
