

#### **Executive Director of Marketing Report**

As we are now facing the final leg in our Rodeo season with the Finals fast approaching the Executive Board has had the difficult task of reviewing and subsequently making decisions to the feasibility of the Finals and the past financial losses in recent years. Some of the decisions recently made, I understand, will not prove popular with the membership, but I ask members to give their understanding that it is the Board's job to run the association as a successful business and encourage growth in all areas of the sport. To continually conduct the Finals as we have and suffer substantial financial losses of your money is hardly a wise business decision. So members, please bear with us and I am confident that the Finals will continue to be reviewed and other answers will be found to solve the current problems.

Obviously, if the association was to receive bulk sponsorship dollars the Finals would not pose a problem, but unfortunately, due to tough economic times and current profile of Rodeo in comparison with other sports it is unlikely that

sponsorship is the quick answer.

With this in mind steps are being taken to nprove this situation. The Executive Board would be very interested in hearing from anybody who could be considered to work in the role of Promotions Officer for the N.R.A.

A Promotions Officer's role would include

any way of improving the profile of the sport of Rodeo eg liaison with all forms of media and press releases, to construct and co-ordinate general promotions which put the sport of Rodeo in front of people who would not normally come in contact with it. The Board understands that a Promotions Officer's job is a thankless task and is giving consideration as to ways to provide remuneration.

Also you will notice in this months sports news an ad seeking people to assist in the Sponsorship Marketing of the finals. I have put together the Finals Proposals for Corporate Sponsorship and am seeking people who have business contacts or are prepared to establish contacts in which this proposal can be presented. If you can assist please give me a call.

In another attempt to raise the funds for the association and the improvement of the Finals the Executive Board is giving consideration to conducting an Art Union with a Horse Float as a prize. At this stage we are currently looking for a Horse Float manufacturer/retailer to become involved in the Promotion of this Art Union.

As you can see from what's proceeding, times are tough and getting tougher. I recently attended a National Rodeo Council of Australia Board meeting in Bill Urquhart's absence accompanied by Bob Armitage and at this meeting I was sad to learn that Ron Bryant, one of the two Directors of A.H.P.G. (Australian Heritage Promotion Group, the contracted marketing company for council) was retiring from this company due to other business commitments, (in other words a job with a real income to look after the mortgage, wife and rug rats) although he will still remain a share holder of the company. Ron has been a driving force within A.H.P.G. and the council has been responsible for many positive steps made in recent years e.g. C.U.B. Sponsorship, the best Insurance coverage in all aspects we have ever had, Pro-Masters Rodeo etc.

Although retiring from A.H.P.G. I am sure and hope that Ron will remain involved with the sport of Rodeo to some extent.

On the point of A.H.P.G. the promoters of the Pro-Masters, I'd like to congratulate all who were involved in the promotion of this top class production but I'm afraid to say that \$7,000 events attract competitors not spectators. Like our N.R.A. Finals the Pro-Masters is being reviewed and some changes will be forthcoming.

Okay, now for the good news. I have in recent times been having meetings with the Manager of Sponsorship and Trade Development for Queensland Breweries, although this is unofficial and yet to be finalised, we have agreed to conduct a Rodeo Championship Series sponsored by them, similar to the past Powers Series, only as now Powers beer and C.U.B. are one, Rodeo committees should not be faced with the dilemma of having to only stock Powers beer. It is hoped to be able to officially announce this and commence this Series at the beginning of the 1995 season.

Further good news, in December I will be having a meeting with the main Sponsorship Manager in Australia for L.J. Hooker Real Estate with the view of L.J. Hooker being involved over a number of Rodeos or perhaps a series.

Committees, please note, that I make myself available to assist Rodeos on an individual basis with their promotions and the goal of helping them get more bums on seats and better financial rewards. Please don't hesitate to enquire.

On another positive note, Grant Edwards and Ian Robertson of the N.R.A. West Coast Circuit have been successful in negotiating to run a Rodeo in Malaysia. We wish them and their team of Cowboys the very best for this project, although I can't help thinking that seeing as the N.R.A. now has a Rodeo overseas that perhaps we should change our name to International Rodeo Association otherwise known as the I.R.A. Being called the I.R.A. would surely get public attention.




