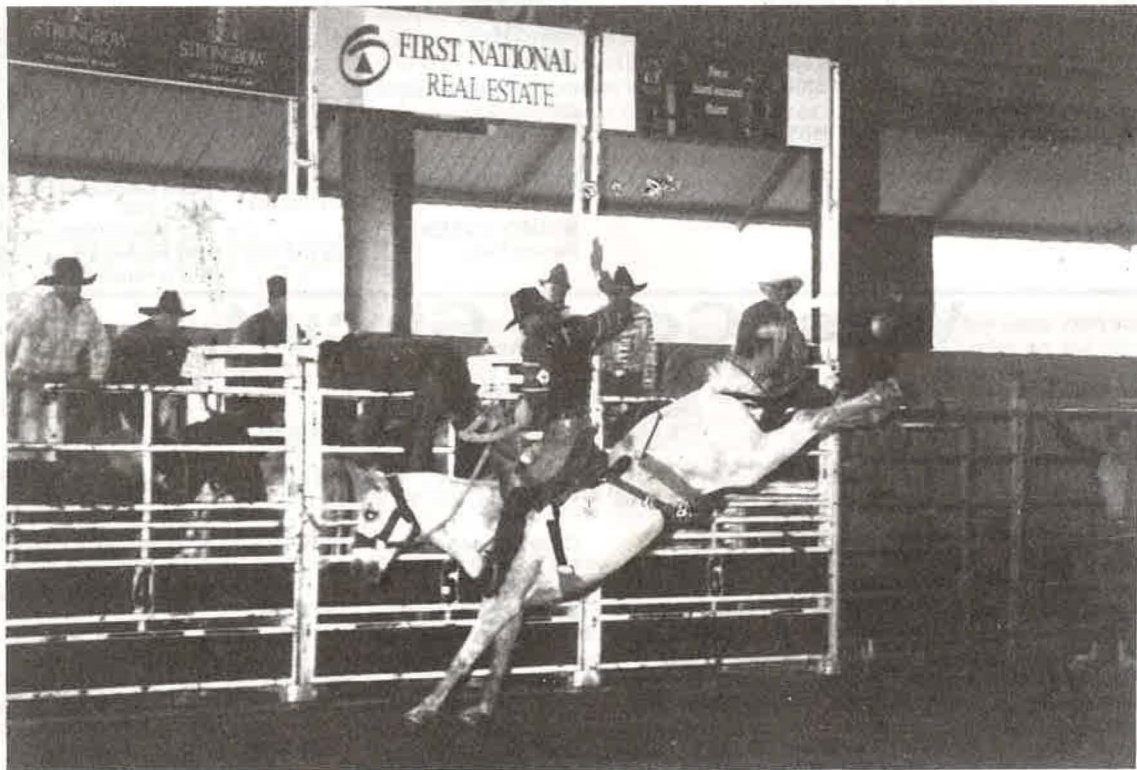

Directors Report

R11.1.11 In the riding events, use of prods and similar devices is prohibited. Exceptions would be a known chute stalling animal, only with contestants and contractors approval and to be administered only by a qualified PRCA card holder. In this instance, the prod shall not exceed 12 inches in length. The fine for violations will be \$100 per infraction. Prod will not be used without contestant's knowledge and consent.
