Directors Report

Well first of all I would like to welcome event Directors onto the Board and I hope everyone will do their best to support them. Something that has not always happened in the past. Firstly all Directors are democratically voted onto the board in compliance with our memorandum of Articles and as such have a mandate from the membership to make and change rules and are the only ones who may do this. As in any form of controlling body if you are not happy vote in the other eligible person. There are usually none.

We are coming under increasing pressure in regard to animal treatment and safety and these will be looked into this year more so than ever. One article I would like to publish is an extract from the P.R.C.A. Rule book regarding the use of prods. After reading this you will realize this has obviously been a big problem over there.

Hopefully our Contractors will appreciate this thus taking the pressure off us to implement such harsh rules and penalties.

As for the fact of ownership of stock this is not in question.

As we all own our own vehicles we can do what we like with them at home but the minute they are on the road we must abide by the traffic act P.S. Next time you get pulled up for speeding tell the Policeman its your vehicle and you can do what you like with it "good luck".

Like I said safety and Animal Welfare are big issues. Let's work together and change with the times. We are in the process of introducing a new Rule book. It is not a simple job but should be completed early this year. Note our Rules regarding Central Entries as, as per the Central Entries Newsletter back page. Thanks very much to Dene, Bub, Brad and Patty and Good luck all new Directors.

EVENTS DIRECTOR MASON JARDINE

R11.1.11 In the riding events, use of prods and similar devices is prohibited. Exceptions would be a known chute stalling animal, only with contestants and contractors approval and to be administered only by a qualified PRCA card holder. In this instance, the prod shall not exceed 12 inches inlength. The fine for violations will be \$100 per infraction. Prod will not be used without contestant's knowledge and consent.


