Brett Townsend Interview

CG. "Hi Brett, thanks for taking the time to talk to me."

Q. How does it feel to leading the Bareback standings half way through the season?
A. "It's a good feeling to know I'm on top and I just hope that I can keep going."

Q. Do you think you will have a fair chance of staying ahead for the rest of the season?
A. "As long as I can keep drawing good stock and I can keep away from injuries and keep feeling fit - yes."

Q. What made you want to ride Bareback horses?
A. "It's just an event I wanted to do, it is a very hard event that is never quite perfected and takes quite a bit of skill, to be that little bit better than the others."

Q. How long have you been riding with the NRA for?
A. "Since 1989, I did ride a few bulls as well."

Q. Have you got any set plans for your Rodeo career?
A. "To win a World Title and to win more Titles than Frank Green."

Q. You drew 'Honky Tonk' 21 times, what was your success rate on him?
A. "I think it ended up 9/12 - to him."

Q. Would you rate him as the best horse you have ever been on?
A. "Yes."

Q. Why do you think 'Honkey Tonk' had something special about him that appealed to everyone?
A. "He always bucked, he always put 110% into it and he was good to watch."

Q. Who would be the hardest horse to ride that you have ever been on?
A. "'Bomba', or Gary McPhee's, I think it was in 1991 at Warwick."

Q. Why?
A. "He was just a big, awkward and powerful horse."

Q. Do you idolise anyone in the sport of Rodeo?
A. "In Australia, I guess Frank Green. I think he is the most consistent Bareback rider the country has ever seen."

Q. On to a more serious side of sport, give us your views on what has to happen to put the sport of Rodeo 'on the map' more in Australia?
A. "I think we have all got to work as one to make a few more dollars and get some much needed sponsorship."

Q. Do you think there is too much politics in the sport?
A. "At the moment, yes."

Q. Finally, what do you think you would be doing if you didn't have Rodeo's to look forward to most weekends? Seriously Brett!
A. "Umm...Probably I still would be racing motor bikes for fun."

DAY MEMBERS: Day members must enter as above to obtain a reference number. All entry money plus day membership (Mens - \$10; Ladies - \$7) must be sent to:

Rosewood, Q. 4340

This money must be received by 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in your entry being scratched.

On the day of the Rodeo, day members must present themselves to the office to check that their finances are in order and to sign the day membership form.

LATE ENTRIES Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. ALL late entries are automatically accompanied with a \$20 late fine. (If you object to the late fine, you do not have to enter). To submit a late entry, ring the Central Entries number (074) 64 2500 and leave your entry on the answering machine using the same format as above except to receive your reference number, please ring the Central Entry number during entry hours on the following Wednesday between 3.00pm -5.00pm.

REFERENCE NUMBER: Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations may be left on the answering machine at any time. Cancellations up until 12 noon Monday preceding the Rodeo - no penalty. Cancellations from 12 noon Monday preceding the Rodeo up until when the draws are done carry a payment of a committee levy. (With or without a vet/doctors certificate.) Cancellations after the draws are done incur payment of the full entry unless a vet/doctors certificate is presented and the payment of a committee levy is required.

LATE PAYMENT FINE: Any entries not paid by the end of the Rodeo (last stock run/bucked) will incur a late payment fine of \$25.00.

PLEASE NOTE RULE CHANGES AND ADDITIONS PAGE;

Page 8 Paragraph 10, *should read*

A broken barrier will constitute a ten second penalty. All barriers must have a ring attached to the pin, ring must fall within three (3) metre radius to be a broken barrier over three (3) metres and it is classed as a carried barrier and no penalty applies.

Page 6 Rule 10, *should read*

a competitor may after three (3) rerides ask for his money back and receive his full nomination (*add*) less the administration and insurance fee.

Page 12 Rule 5 (Rope & Tie), *should read*

If a competitor drags a calf two metres he will be disqualified. The drag mark will be measured from the rump of the calf to the start of the drag mark. The flag judge may ride behind the horse if the horse is dragging the calf. (*Add*) Any calf dragged at all after rider remounts will be disqualified.

General Rules Page 7 (*to be added to page*)

20. All Rodeos must have two (2) Pick-up Men and two (2) Bull Fighters in the Applicable events.
