

This board was designed to take the workload off the President. The concept is brilliant and worked well, but alas, old habits die hard. Our poor Past President, we just slowly but surely wore him down. No one man can withstand the continual plague of phone calls, 6 nights a

week, 52 weeks a year, year after year, he's done his apprenticeship, 20 odd years of it.

Bill has resigned as President. This is an end of an era. Presidents have now been superseded by Chairmen of the Board. This will be outlined at a future special general meeting. No, this does not mean we are falling apart. Now you have to do what you should have been doing before.
