Over the years Rodeo Associations have been working hard to improve the standards needed, to make sure we survive, such as; worked up arenas, codes of conduct, Animal Welfare Legislation, stock draws, to name a few. The effort put into these things is immeasurable and basically done at no cost to each individual Association.

Australia has four government recognised Rodeo Associations. All running affiliated rodeos Australia wide. All working under "insurance for riders" schemes, Animal welfare code of practices, and companies by limited guarantee etc.

In my mind, four associations Australia wide is more than adequate. But to a select few this does not seem to be the case. Out of the blue, we have a handful of people, who in my opinion think they know better. They think that these four

Just sign the paper to waive the insurance, we've saved two bucks. Don't worry that it's not a company by guarantee. They can't sue us. Wrong, very wrong. Litigation is a serious thing and we are definitely taking the wrong road by supporting these rodeos. Just ask the stock contractors. Funny thing, they haven't been paid yet.

I have had a number of enquiries regarding the running of the N.R.A. In 1991 at Stanthorpe, we had a special annual general meeting. From this meeting an executive board was put in place. This board was designed to take the workload off the President. The concept is brilliant and worked well, but alas, old habits die hard. Our poor Past President, we just slowly but surely wore him down. No one man can withstand the continual plague of phone calls, 6 nights a

week, 52 weeks a year, year after year, he's done his apprenticeship, 20 odd years of it.

Bill has resigned as President. This is an end of an era. Presidents have now been superseded by Chairmen of the Board. This will be outlined at a future special general meeting. No, this does not mean we are falling apart. Now you have to do what you should have been doing before. Ring or approach the relevant director or put it in writing and send it to head office, and it will be tabled at our monthly executive board meeting.

I would like to thank my two right hand ladies, Norma and Cathy, yes you are both doing a top job. Keep up the good work. I would like also to congratulate Joanne Beilenberg and Janene Ryan, on being crowned the new NRA Rodeo Queen & Charity Queen at Movie World earlier last Month. This new concept certainly is a big step in the right direction and will only get bigger and better.

above the fire place.

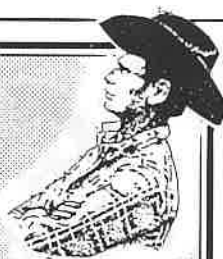
