Jo showed consistency played off by being consistent in the Breakaway Roping and Barrel Race. Allan Flood and Kevin Kasper showed their positive

style by roping three steers to win the Team Roping Title. Our own super stuff Tony McIntyre put down three good steers to win the Steer Westling Title, with Doc Cavanagh storming in on the last round to place second behind our winner. The Rope and Tie and All Round Cowboy was well within Tony and Kevin Kaspers reach with only a few points between them.

Last but not least, Brooke Frahm just blitzed the Junior Barrel Race making three excellent runs.

All our Cowboys and Cowgirls showed we are true athletes and top competitors in our chosen sport.

The concept of using three Announcers, one from each Association was a tremendous success. They got the competitors and the crowd on an unbelievable high. Between them they kept up a non stop information service, letting the crowd know where each competitor came from and a broad look at what each person did for a living. All this was filled in with music by none else than Peter Hefferman. The city of Rockhampton has done Rodeo proud and with the support, the Mayor, Sponsors, and local business put towards this Promotion believe me next year these finals will be bigger than Ben Hurr.

From the West Coast Rodeo Circuit

Over the last seven years or so the West Coast Rodeo Circuit (Western Australia) has been affiliated with the National Rodeo Association. Prior to this the Circuit came under the coverage of the then ARRA and the later APRA. The West Coast has since the late fifties, had a strong rodeo following in W.A., with country towns like Northam and Boddington holding their annual rodeos as a main feature in the regions event calendar. However like many country towns, rodeo has seen a decline over the last few years, much of which was linked to the rural population moving to the city. In 1994 Rodeos in W.A. had dropped from almost a dozen to just five. In 1995 this has turned around with the projected numbers of rodeos in this year being eight full point and two minimum point rodeos.

Much of this increase is due to the aggressive push by the West Coast Rodeo Circuit

Committee to promote and in some cases become financially involved in the production of shows. In particular the Circuit entered into a joint venture with promoters "Stampede Arena" and the State Equestrian Centre to run three full point indoor rodeos. At this time two shows have been completed and were a complete success. With the Equestrian Centre being filled to capacity, the crowd, mostly people with little or no knowledge of our sport, clapped and cheered constantly throughout the rodeo. On the first night we were competing with the Western Reds at the WACA, the Wildcats NBL at the Superdome and the worst winter night in a long time.

Notwithstanding this success the Circuit is still pursuing the aim of resurrecting the many country rodeos, in towns like Albany in the far South, Carnarvon in the North West and

Kalgoorlie in the east. This is in addition to the assistance the Circuit intends to provide our current country rodeos.

The Circuit in WA has a strong competitor following, in particular a large number of time event competitors. This has enabled us to have six mens events (addition of Teamroping) unlike the five in the east. There are also a number of our members who are currently in the East competing at Mount Isa, Concurry and Rockhampton Pro Masters.

1996 will certainly be a busy year for our circuit as the number of jull point rodeos for our 120 or so riders should grow to twelve, not counting the APRA Scarborough Rodeo in April 1996.

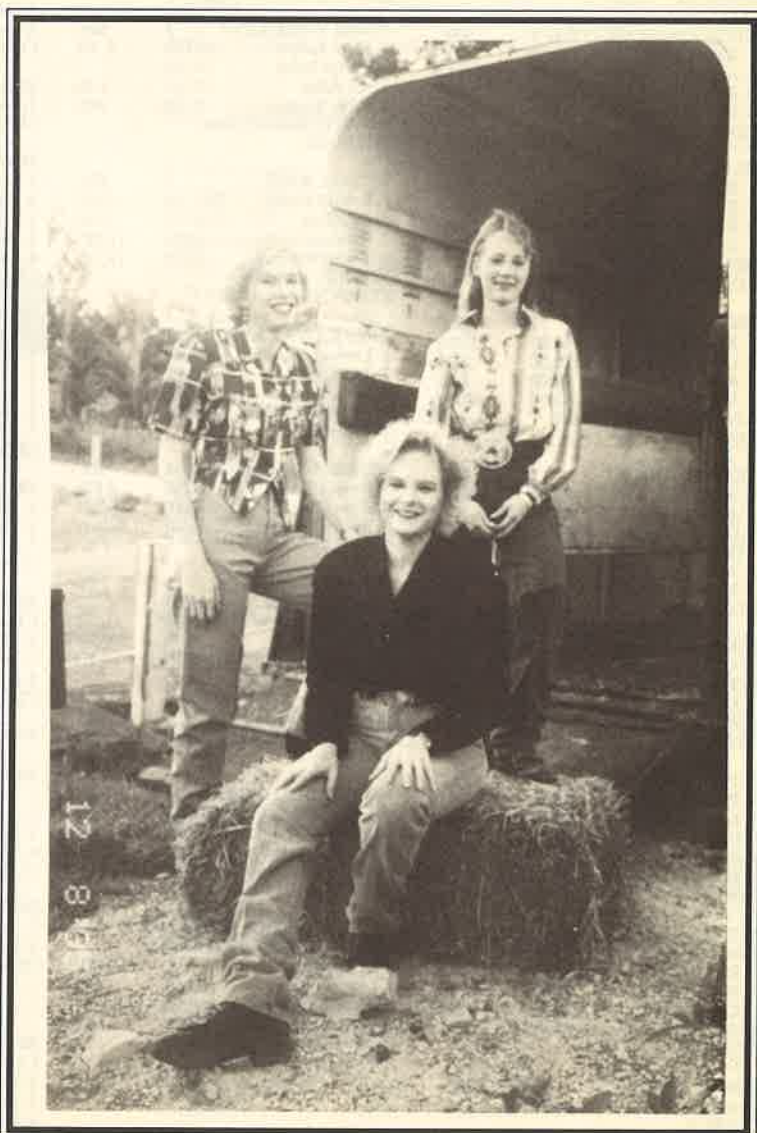

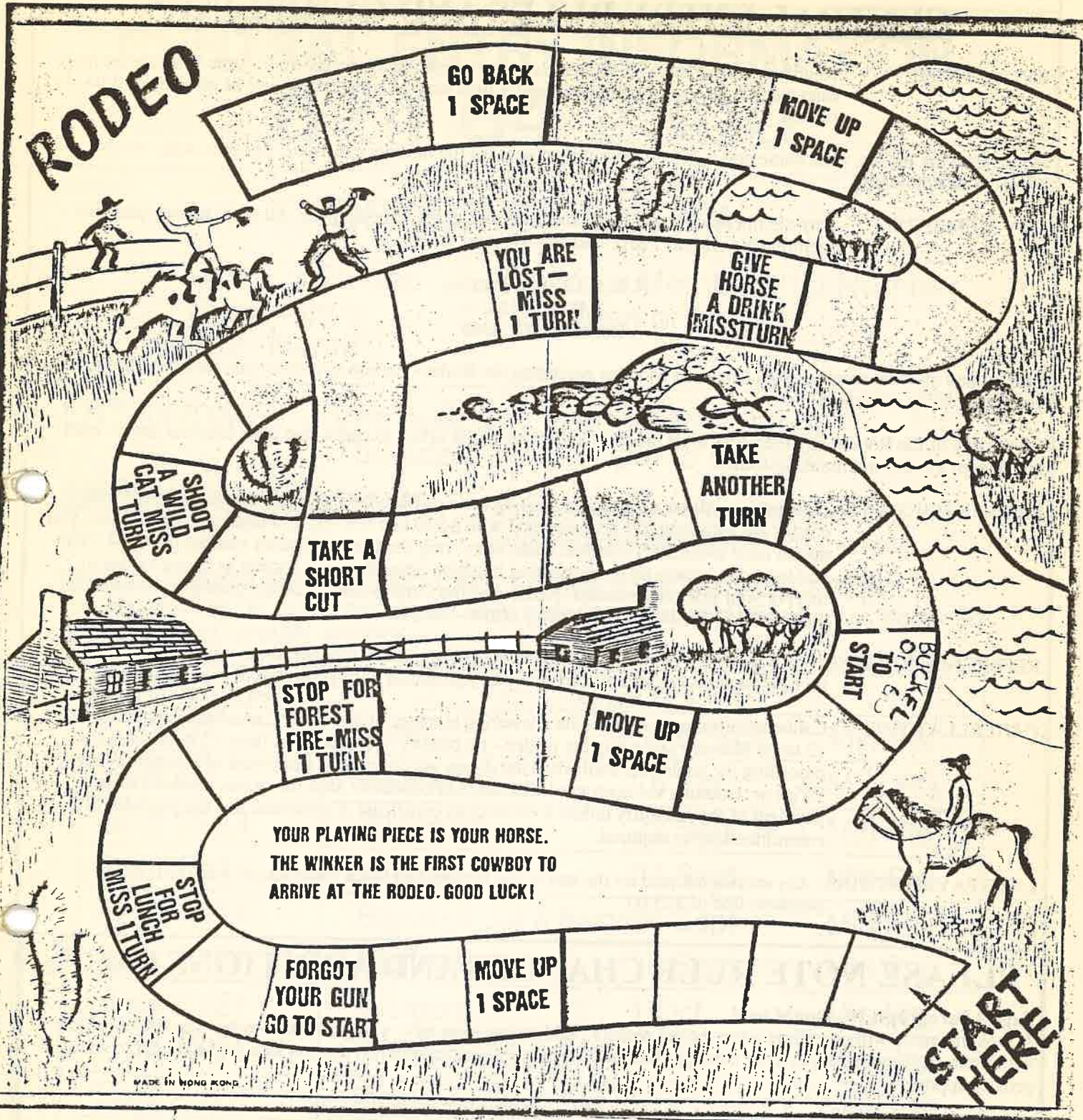

DAY MEMBERS: Day members must enter as above to obtain a reference number. All entry money plus day membership (Mens - \$10; Ladies - \$7) must be sent to:

P.O. Box 124,
Rosewood, Q. 4340**

This money must be received by 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo- Failure to receive this money will result in your entry being scratched.

On the day of the Rodeo, day members must present themselves to the office to check that their finances are in order and to sign the day membership form.

LATE ENTRIES: Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. ALL late entries are automatically accompanied with a \$20 late fine. (If you object to the late fine, you do not have to enter). To submit a late entry, ring the Central Entries number (074) 64 2500 and leave your entry on the answering machine using the same format as above except to receive your reference number, please ring the Central Entry number during entry hours on the following Wednesday between 3.00pm -5.00pm.

REFERENCE NUMBER: Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations may be left on the answering machine at any time. Cancellations up until 12 noon Monday preceding the Rodeo - no penalty. Cancellations from 12 noon Monday preceding the Rodeo up until when the draws are done carry a payment of a committee levy. (With or without a vet/doctors certificate.) Cancellations after the draws are done incur payment of the full entry unless a vet/doctors certificate is presented and the payment of a committee levy is required.

LATE PAYMENT FINE: Any entries not paid by the end of the Rodeo (last stock run/bucked) will incur a late payment fine of \$25.00.

A broken barrier will constitute a ten second penalty. All barriers must have a ring attached to the pin, ring must fall within three (3) metre radius to be a broken barrier over three (3) metres and it is classed as a carried barrier and no penalty applies.

Page 6 Rule 10, should read

a competitor may after three (3) rerides ask for his money back and receive his full nomination (*add*) less the administration and insurance fee.

Page 12 Rule 5 (Rope & Tie), should read

If a competitor drags a calf two metres he will be disqualified. The drag mark will be measured from the rump of the calf to the start of the drag mark.

The flag judge may ride behind the horse if the horse is dragging the calf. (*Add*) Any calf dragged at all after rider remounts will be disqualified.
