There are no rodeos on the night of presentation, so anyone who wants to come along please contact the Rodeo Council for details on what will be a big night.

The Beenleigh Rodeo held our last Queen Competition which was once again hotly contested. A BIG thank you to the judges Fiona Tranter and Debbie Herbst who did a great job in a limited time span! Jo Taplin decided to add an element of "Roughstock" to the Queen Competition with the help of my VERY naughty horse, Scoota. He decided the noise, lights and all the other action was too much to handle and I apologise to Jo - I honestly did NOT think he would do this in the Queen Competition! - and as for bronc contractors the highest bidder can have him! feeling nervous before the competition, try to relax with the usual trick of breathing deeply and concentrate on warming up your horse properly - to keep your mind focused - and as funny as this may sound, sing!! It's hard to be tense when you're singing along to Garth Brooks!! Also, remember: all you have to do is answer some questions about rodeo that anyone who reads the newsletter will know, have a chat to some friendly people, and do a workout that you would do any day at home! If you put in a bit of extra effort and turn your horse out as best as you can, keep your gear clean and wear your classiest western wear, the presentation part will be a breeze! Something that 1 found helpful was to make everything SLOW (totally opposite to Barrel Racing!!) If you take your time with your workout than it is going to look a lot neater and precise and you won't look slow, just confident and relaxed. If the judge asks for a flying change and your horse isn't capable of it, don't worry about explaining this to the judge, simply do the change that your horse is capable of doing neatly. As far as I'm concerned - as are most judges - a perfect simple change is a lot better than a messy flying change. Of course the number one thing to remember in any Rodeo Queen type situation, no matter what happens SMILE!!!! I'm sure mine has slipped on occasion but you'll find that smiling saves you most of the time, after all this is FUN!!!

Don't forget to come along to the Rodeo Reunion at Rosewood on the 6th of April. I have donated a basket of Nutri-Metics goodies, valued at \$200, which the Queen Quest entrants will be raffling on the night and the next day at the rodeo. 

ENTRY TIMES:

Regular entry times are Wednesday 3pm - 5pm and Thursday 5pm - 9pm. If there are more than two (2) Rodeos, an additional entry time may be added but it will be advertised if this occurs.

Please state the Rodeo, your name and membership number, wait for the reference number, and then state which events to be nominated.

DAY MEMBERS:

Day members must enter as above to obtain a reference number. All entry money plus day membership (Mens - \$10; Ladies - \$7) must be sent to:

N.R.A. Central Entries, P.O. Box 124, Rosewood, O. 4340

This money must be received by 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo-Failure to receive this money will result in your entry being scratched.

On the day of the Rodeo, day members must present themselves to the office to check that their finances are in order and to sign the day membership form.

LATE ENTRIES:

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. ALL late entries are automatically accompanied with a \$20 late fine. (If you object to the late fine, you do not have to enter). To submit a late entry, ring the Central Entries number (074) 64 2500 and leave your entry on the answering machine using the same format as above except to receive your reference number, please ring the Central Entry number during entry hours on the following Wednesday between 3.00pm -5.00pm.

REFERENCE NUMBER: Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

CANCELLATIONS:

Cancellations may be left on the answering machine at any time. Cancellations up until 12 noon Monday preceding the Rodeo - no penalty. Cancellations from 12 noon Monday preceding the Rodeo up until when the draws are done carry a payment of a committee levy. (With or without a vet/doctors certificate.) Cancellations after the draws are done incur payment of the full entry unless a vet/doctors certificate is presented and the payment of a committee levy is required.

LATE PAYMENT FINE: Any entries not paid by the end of the Rodeo (last stock run/bucked) will incur a late payment fine of \$25.00.

NFINANCIAL MEMBERS: must resign in writing and can not compete for 3 months and must obtain Day Membership!

PLEASE NOTE RULE CHANGES AND ADDITIONS PAGE;

Page 8 Paragraph 10, should read

A broken barrier will constitute a ten second penalty. All barriers must have a ring attached to the pin, ring must fall within three (3) metre radius to be a broken barrier over three (3) metres and it is classed as a carried barrier and no penalty applies.

Page 6 Rule 10, should read

a competitor may after three (3) rerides ask for his money back and receive his full nomination (add) less the administration and insurance fee.

Page 12 Rule 5 (Rope & Tie), should read

If a competitor drags a calf two metres he will be disqualified. The drag mark will be measured from the rump of the calf to the start of the drag mark.

The flag judge may ride behind the horse if the horse is dragging the calf. (Add) Any calf dragged at all after rider remounts will be disqualified.
