



These decisions will be effective as at the 9th March, 1996, and are listed as follows;

- 1. Mandate from Members for the NRA Board to seek legal advice to amend the memorandum of Articles, in respect of the restructure of;
- a) Memberships
- b) Board of Directors
- c) Disciplinary Procedures

PUBLIC LIABILITY

2 All Committees/Promoters conducting a Rodeo Promotion are to provide bonifide proof of <u>Public Liability</u> <u>Cover</u>, failure to comply with this rule, Affiliation will not be accepted and/or cancelled.

AFFILIATIONS

3. Affiliation Fee for Full point and minimum point Award Rodeo's to be increased from \$100.00 to \$200.00 Note; Maximum Point Rodeo's Affiliations to remain \$100.00

LIMIT ON NOVICE COMPETITOR'S

4. Limit on Novice competitors in Bull Ride only, Trial Basis.

Where committee runs an open and novice Bull ride, the committee has the option to nominate that the competitors may only compete in one or the other event (not both events)

RULE: FOUL BARRIER/ RERIDE

5. Foul barrier Rule:

In the event of a foul barrier or a malfunction of a barrier the decision for a rerun will he made by the barrier judge. This decision is final. (refer to old rule book page 75)

RERIDE RULE

6. Prior to the commencement of each round a minimum of (2) two numbers must be in the hands of the chuteboss. All scratched and turn out stock can he added to the reride pen. However, the original numbers cannot be withdrawn. Reride numbers to be displayed on stock draws.

Full Point -

Minimum total prizemoney \$1500.00, that is one event \$1500.00 or all standard mens events are a minimum of \$500.00 per event. All standard womens events a minimum of \$300.00 per event. No novice events can be run unless the corresponding open event is held.

Maximum points awarded to individual events only. No points added to All round.

full point Rodeo may at the Boards discretion be run at the same time as a maximum point Rodeo, provided the Full point Rodeo does not effect the maximum point event. Where the circumstances arises that a full point rodeo is run and, in the boards opinion, this promotion may effect the maximum point rodeo, then the full point rodeo's prizemoney may not exceed per event, that of a maximum point rodeo. Consequently, the full point promotion is relegated to a minimum point award event.

Minimum Point Award Rodeo's

All Standard open mens and womens events, minimum prizemoney is \$250.00 per event. No novice events can be run unless the corresponding open event is held.

A minimum point rodeo may be sanctioned at the boards discretion, only when either a maximum or Full point award rodeo can't be held.

Points are only (1/2) that of a maximum or full point award rodeo. Points to individual events only

On conclusion of the Special General Meeting, the Full board passed the following Amendments to the Associations rules.

1. BREAKAWAY ROPING LEGAL HEAD CATCHES

a Full head catch only, rope must draw up on neck of calf and then break off.

2. NON-POINT AWARD RODEO'S

-a non point award rodeo may be run at the boards discretion.
