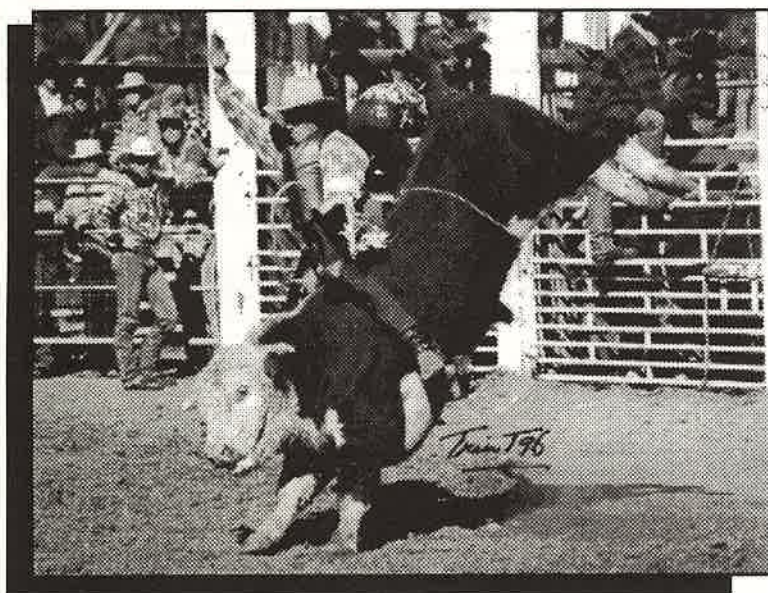

Hi, everyone! Finals are fast approaching and what a great lead up it has been with some very exciting and action-packed rodeos. Maryborough Rodeo was certainly all of that and more. My Queen duties took me to Maryborough on the Wednesday prior to the rodeo and what a fantastic yet hectic couple of days.

With the help of Brad and his incredible bull Mega, we certainly let the towns of Maryborough and Harvery Bay know that a NRA rodeo was in town. Promotions included a television interview which was broadcast on 7 New, Radio, newspaper articles, dinner functions with sponsors, and (one that was close to my heart) a visit to the local Endeavour Foundation. Thanks to Dan Keliher and Mark Stephenson for taking the time to be involved with promotions.

I take my hat off to the Endeavour Foundation, the Heritage City Rodeo Committee and of course Ann-Maree "hasslefree" Hasselbach for organising such a full, yet thoroughly enjoyable itinerary for myself, Brad and Mega. It is great to see our sport of Rodeo receive such media attention as this rodeo did. ## Stock Contractors Representatives Report

The 1996 rodeo year is rapidly drawing to a close and the finals series will soon be upon us. As most of you are aware the finals this year will be run by private promoters and held over four rounds at four different locations. By allowing private promoters to run the finals it has enabled more rounds to be run than would be possible if the NRA were to run them themselves, as in the past, which is definitely a benefit to the competitors and the sport. However, one of the disadvantages to this format is that the best stock available are no longer chosen to perform at the finals which is really what it's all about. There is no easy solution to this problem but one must be found as I believe that the best competitors and stock should be on show at our finals rodeos.

The performance of our contract stock throughout this year has been exceptional and credit must be given to the NRA-stock contractors for providing such quality stock each week. Although the nominations for Bucking Stock of the Year were not available at the time of me writing this report I have given a summary of what I believe are the leading contenders in each event.

It is a time when all those early mornings, late nights, travelling through stormy, hot sticky days, ringing through your late entries, all seems worthwhile for some!!! I wish to encourage all Rodeo Queens to be proud of their achievement and to take the time to participate in the rodeo, whether it be liaizing with sponsors of that rodeo or helping with the grand entry. It certainly pleases the committees, who put up wonderful prizes for you all to win.

I must also commend those competitors who have been proud of their wins and taken the time to jump on a horse and do a lap of honour around the arena. The crowd certainly does appreciate this. Thankyou to the pick-up men, and anyone else who has kindly supplied a horse for our roughstock competitors to ride. And while on the subject, I certainly can't miss this opportunity to encourage the saddle-bronc competitor (who did such a wonderful job at Maryborough of leading the present Queen around the arena) to run for the position of Queen next year. There are a few who would like to see him crowned. What do you think 'Shane'?

### Bucking Bull of the Year

The competition for the 1996 Bucking Bull of the Year is one of the most open in many years with some contractors having a number of bulls worthy of nomination. The Johnson Brothers have the biggest headache in trying to decide who to nominate with defending champion "The Stud" "Paleface", "Dr Feelgood" and "Cotton Eye Joe" all being outstanding bucking bulls. Campbell Frame also has a number of possible nominations with "High as a Kite", "Rodeo Active", and the massive "Indian Outlaw". "Suck Back Buck" from the Laurie Howard string is as good as there is and "Three Chain Road" from Stuart Timms is an outside change.

### Bucking Bareback Horse of the Year

"Blue Flame" from the Brian Kofoed string has burst onto the rodeo scene in spectacular fashion this year to be one of the main contenders with 1995 co-champion "Wild Child" from Ace High Rodeo Co. looking to defend the title "Crystal" from the Kerry Hail string is always a consistent performer along with "Cobble Creek", 3 from the Stuart Grayson pen.

Thank you to Darren Milburn & 'Flappers' and to Casey Clarke & 'Strike' for the use of those wonderful horses in the grand entries. They are both a pleasure to ride. Thanks also to Christine Pennell who took over the reins at Kenilworth, and who also helped to organize the grand entry at Maryborough while I was 'detained' in the chutes.

Congratulations to Fiona Townsend who won the Tyalgum Rodeo Queen after much deliberation by our judges. Thankyou to Joanne Johnson for taking the time to judge and also for her generosity in lending 'King' to one of the girls, so as to boost the numbers. This was certainly appreciated, not only by the competitor but by the committee as well.

I wish all those competitors who have made it to the finals all the best. And to those competitors who haven't made it this year - there is always next year, so don't give up, and I hope we will see you at each round of the finals showing your fellow competitors your encouragement and support. And to ALL COMPETITORS show our junior you do care by attending their NRA Junior Finals.

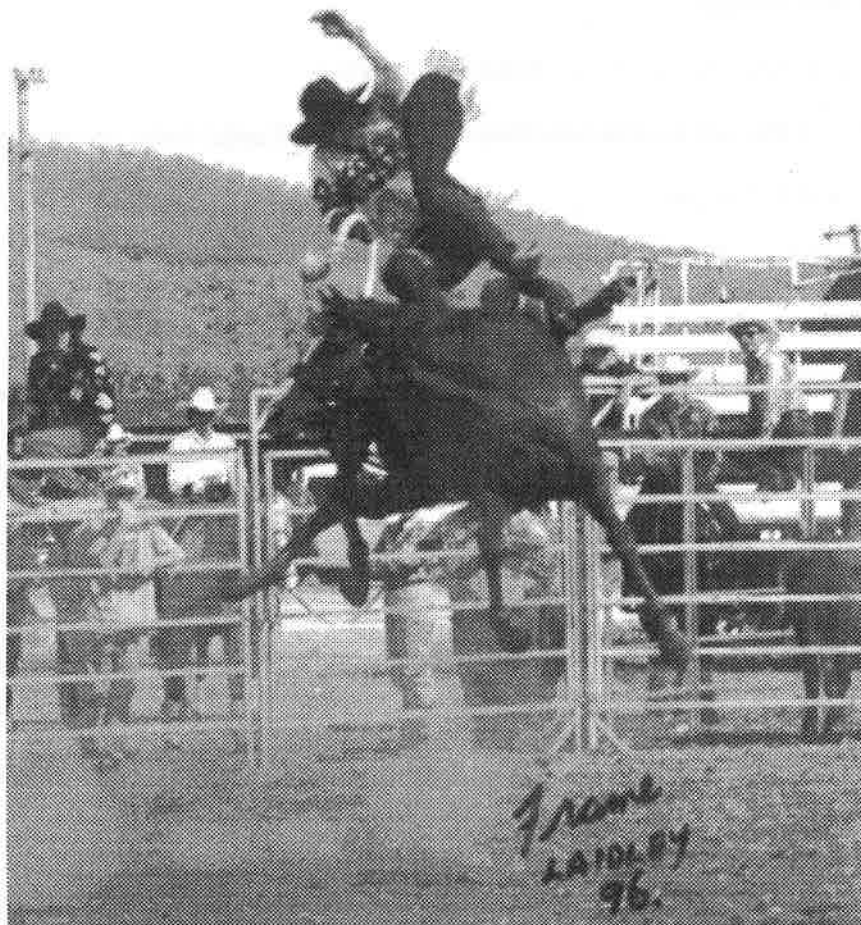

8. Steer Undecorating; Male Hazer pts be allowed for Steer Undecorating.
9. Jerk down rule; A Judge may confer with two other officials regarding the Jerk down rule at completion of the round.



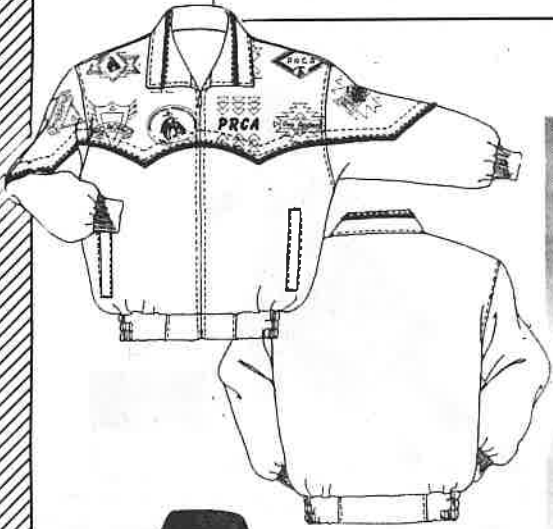

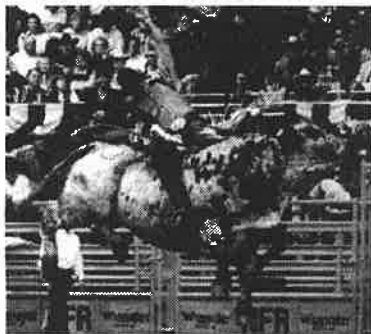

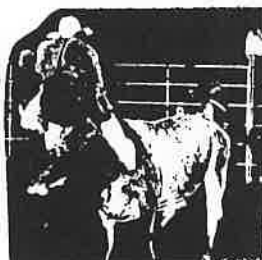
