

Stock Contractors Representatives Report

The 1996 rodeo year is rapidly drawing to a close and the finals series will soon be upon us. As most of you are oware the finals this year will be run by private promoters and held over four rounds at four different locations. By allowing private promoters to run the finals it has enabled more rounds to be run than would be possible is the NRA were to run them themselves, as in the past, which is definitely a benefit to the competitors and the sport. However, one of the disadvantages to this format is that the best stock available are no longer chosen to perform at the finals which is really what it's all about There is no easy solution to this problem but one must be found as I

the that the best competitors and stock should be show at our finals rodeos.

The performance of our contract stock throughout this year has been exceptional and credit must be given to the NRA-stock contractors for providing such quality stock each week. Although the nominations for Bucking Stock of the Year were not available at the time of me writing this report I have given a summary of what 1 believe are the leading contenders in each

Bucking Bull of the Year

The competition for the 1996 Bucking Bull of the Year is one of the most open in many years with some contractors having a number of bulls worthy of nomination. The Johnson Brothers have the biggest headache in trying to decide who to nominate with defending ohampion "The Stud" "Paleface", "Dr Feelgood" and "Cotton Eye Joe" all being outstanding bucking bulls. Campbell Frame also has a number of possible nominations with "High as a Kite", "Rodeo Active", and the massive "Indian Outlaw". "Suck Back Buck" from the Laurie Howard string is as good as there is and "Three Chain Road" from Stuart Timms is an outside change.

Bucking Bareback Horse of the Year

"Blue Flame" from the Brian Kofoed string has burst onto the rodeo scene in spectacular fashion this year to be one of the main contenders with 1995 cochampion "Wild Child" from Ace High Rodeo Co. looking to defend the title "Crystal" from the Kerry Hail string is always a consistent performer along with "Cobble Creek", 3 from the Stuart Grayson pen.

Bucking Saddle Horse of the Year

The competition for this title really boils down to what I believe are two of the greatest bucking horses in the country. They are the defending champion from the Stuart Grayson pen, "Charlies Pride", and the spectacular "Kriss Kross" from the Kerry Hall string. The voting for this title will be so close that even Stuart Grayson, who has had a number of wins and been thrown off "Kriss Kross", will have trouble deciding. (Right Stuart???)

Finally, this will be my first and last report as the Stook Contractors Representative as I will be running for a position on the Executive Board for the 1997/98 seasons. It is important that everybody has a say on who will be running the association so ensure that you all fill in your ballot forms (preferably with a tick next to my name) and send them back.





In mid 1994 Kriss Kross found her true calling and joined the Hall Rodeo Company bucking string. She soon established herself as not only the number one horse in the string but one of the best bucking horses in the country and was thosen to perform at the 1995 Pro Masters National Rodeo Finals.

Although Kriss Kross is a good Bareback horse she is at her spectacular best in the Saddle Ride competition. She is generally a high jump kick type horse but, like any exceptional athlete, she adapts her bucking style for different situations to do her utmost to dislodge the cowboy from the saddle.

Testimony to her extraordinary bucking ability lies in the fact that the current leader for the 1996 NRA Saddle Ride Champion, Clayton Hodgetts, has been aboard her on four occasions this year and has only lasted the required eight seconds once.
