entral Entries Report

This is my first report as Mrs Jones and my first report for a long time but as usual I have allot to say with my new but old position as Central Entries for the National Rodeo Association I will say not always good news either

Firstly to nominate for Rodeos please state 1. Name of Rodeo 2. You Name 3. Your Membership Number 4. The events you compete in 5. Open or Novice.

If you cannot nominate yourself for a Rodeo and have asked someone to nominate for you please make sure they have your membership number as we will not be excepting any nominations without membership numbers excluding Day Members. Along with Any cancellations Without Membership Numbers and Reference Numbers will also not be excepted.

Any Unnotified Cancellations or Scratchings to the Central Entries Office will incur a Full Entry fee along with a Turn Out Fine \$25.00 Regardless if the message was passed to a Cowboy/girl which never was received by the office prior to the Draws. This is up to the individual to make sure the office has received their cancellations Before the draws as it is not

the responsibility of the N.R.A. that no one has passed the message on.

Any Medical outs or Scratchings will incur a committee Levy along with a \$5.00 administration Fee per rodeo. Late Entries will be excepted up until 12 noon Monday preceding the Rodeo, all late entries are automatically accompanied with a \$20 late fine for seniors and \$5 late fine for Juniors, If you object to the late fine, you do not have to enter. To submit a late entry ring the Office during Office hours on Friday and Monday till 12 to put your late entry in and receive you Reference Number as no late entries will not be excepted if left on the answering machine with no reference number.

Please keep your reference number on hand as if your entries are not in on the day and you have no reference number this will not be look into any further, as without a reference number no further investigation will take place.

All entries must be paid up before the second half of the Rodeo as no Entries will be taken on the start of the second half and any unpaid entries will receive a \$25.00 non payment Fine as the second half the office is non stop with payout breakdowns, Accounting

and balancing from that day, as we have only one lady to do all the work for the day.

As of the 1st September all entries will increase by \$0.50 due to the Insurance Increase please note this increase the Calendar has not yet been changed.

Invoices have been sent to those who have outstanding dues and if those competitors that have not yet paid will not be able to compete until their finances are back up to date, This invoice states that the account must be paid before you next compete or within seven days, please abide by our rules as they are not their to ignore.

DO NOT READ THIS!!" !! Catch your eye, it normally does. For this reason that I have said this is because it is very important to read the Central Entries procedure as you may get caught one day upsetting the Central Entries officer than finding out that you have not updated yourself with the Central Entries Rules and regulations and feeling this big (*) for a misunderstanding.





"TRIBUTE TO DOC & BOB".

There is a saying, "Lightning never strikes twice in the same place". One would have to doubt this theory if you were to know the Gall family of Peak Crossing.


Luke Gall's world of Rodeo fell apart when he lost his horse, "Doc", on the 21st January 96. Then on July 18th 1996, Greg's horse "Bob" fell victim to a similar acute illness that Doc had suffered. Despite frantic efforts by vets, and the dedication and care given by the Galls - both had to be put down.

Doc, a flashy chestnut gelding by DOC'S T Bar, joined the Gall family five years ago. Luke and Doc became a tough twosome in the arena, competing in Junior Barrel races, Breakaway roping and in more recent times, open Rope & tie, where they won the novice title for the 95 season. Hervey Bay in January was one of Doc's last appearances where Allan Flood won the Rope & tie on him in 10.25sec. Not only did Luke lose a top contest mount, but also his partner and friend.

In 1984, Greg purchased "Bob" and schooled the chestnut/taffy gelding to be a calf roping horse. Bob became a trusty dependable mount and would have to be rated amongst the best in the country. During a ten year span from the mid 80's to the mid 90's, the stout gelding, by Go Far Bar Bob, carried many ropers to the pay window. In earlier days to name a few; Tom Tamini, Jeff Keppel, Brian Elliott and Adam Purse.

Into the 90's and Bob was the back-bone to Champion Calf Ropers, Mick Duffy, Tony McIntyre and Allan Flood. The absence of Doc and Bob has been greatly felt by all who gather at the "timed event" end of the arena. To Greg, Jan and Luke - Our heart felt thoughts are with you on the parting of two loved family members.
