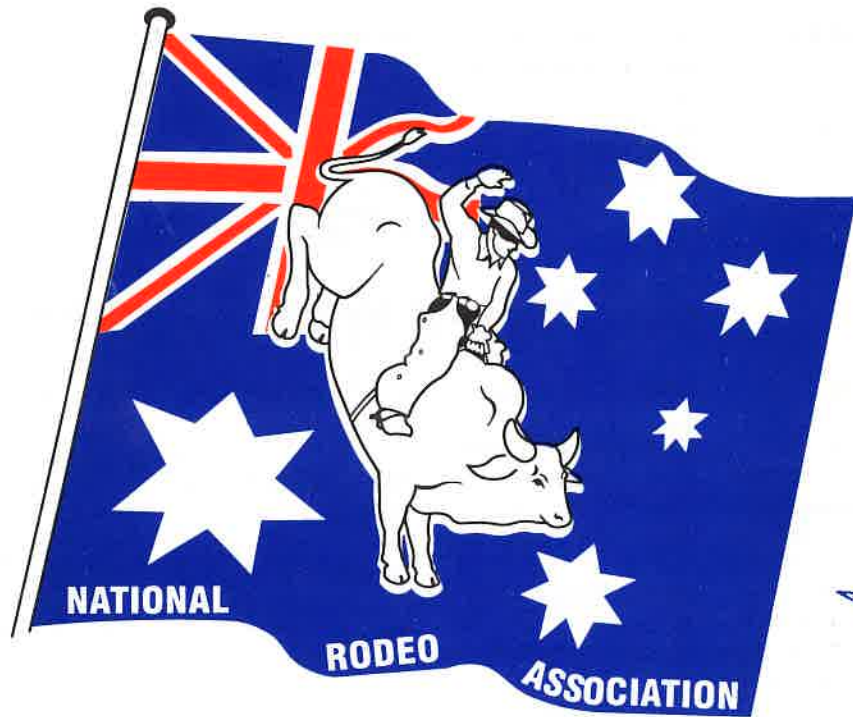

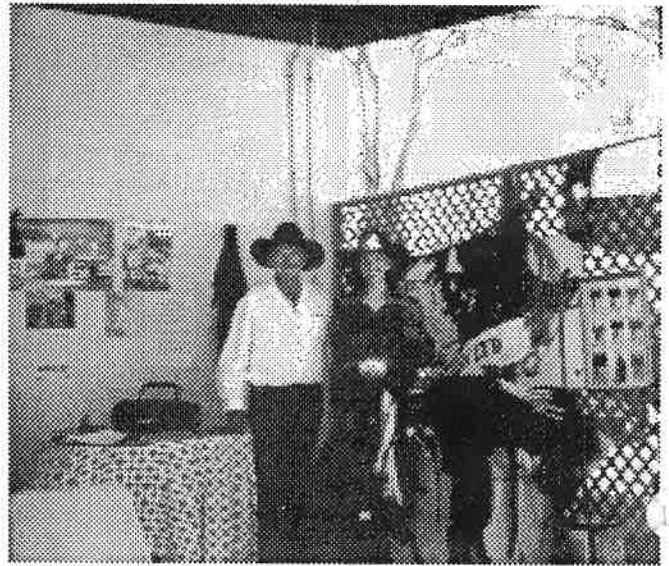
Report: Marketing Administrator

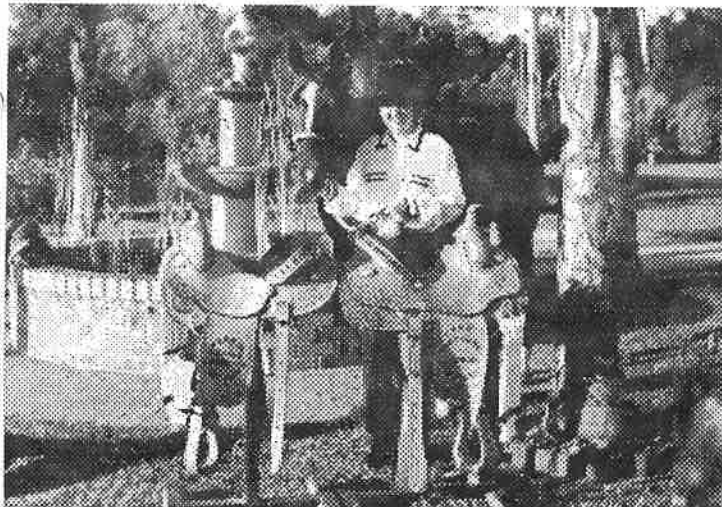

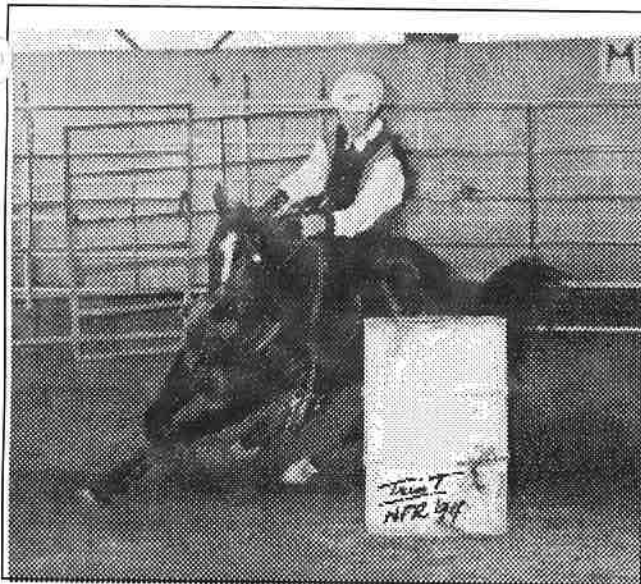


Long standing CHAMPION Yvonne Wallace and Current CHAMPION Brooke Frahm have many things in common when it comes to Barrel Racing.

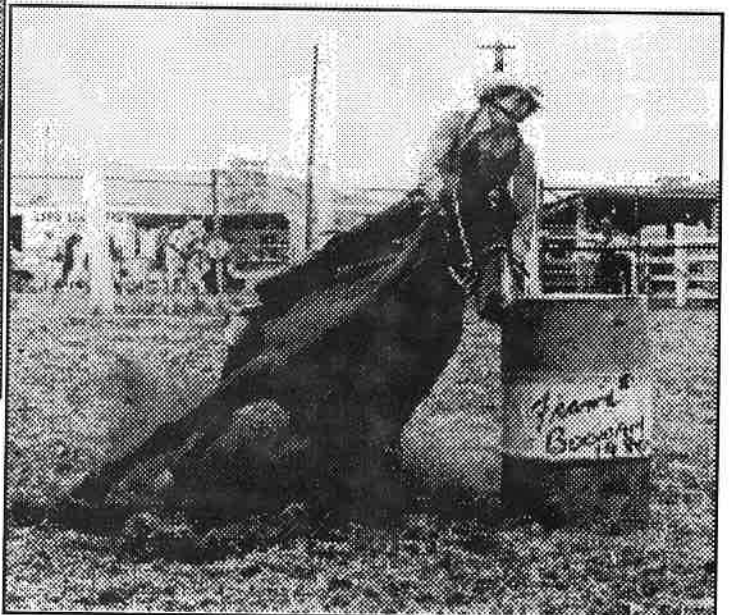

NRA Ruling - Membership

A person who has been a member and has not resigned in writing:

1. Unfinancial member up to and including December 1995, ie membership not renewed, the following conditions will apply:

- (a) To renew membership: a \$50 delinquent fine plus membership, plus 1997 late fine, plus \$50 bond.
- (b) Membership not renewed by 1/7/97 will be declared null and void and monies not refunded.

2. Member 1996, unfinancial 1997.

To renew membership for current year, membership fee plus \$10 1997 late fine up to 1/7/97. If membership not paid by the above date membership will be cancelled and bond not refundable.

Resignations in writing prior to 1st July will be accepted without penalty (ie bond refunded).

If membership cancelled in writing the resignation rule applies (ie a member cannot compete as a day member for a period of three (3) calendar months after said date).

3. Item 2 will be effective as of 1st March 1997 and continue until future amendments.



NRA Ruling - Rookie and Novice

Rookie Competition

- A Rookie is a member / competitor in their first or second year of Rodeo.
- A Rookie title can be won in first or second year of membership. Points are accrued from Open Competition only.

Rookie breaks Open:

- (1) Wins a title
- (2) Accrues 1000 points in an event
- (3) Completes second year of membership

In all of the above the competitor will then be deemed to be an open competitor only.

Novice Competition

- A Novice competitor is a person competing in an event not before competed in by said member, and has been a financial member for at least two (2) years.
- A Novice competitor is allowed 1000 points and one (1) year as a novice and competes for money only.

*All Rookie and Novice Competitors will start 1997 with nil points.
All Rookie and Novice Competitors must advise in writing their status.*

Insurance Claims

Insurance Claims must be faxed through to office (07 5495 8668) by **Monday following the Rodeo**. If a **Medical Out** is found necessary at a Rodeo, if injured, and unable to compete again on that day, a **Medical Certificate** must be obtained by the **Ambulance** on the grounds and submitted to the Central Entries Officer on the day. It is **necessary for the Payouts** and must be submitted as soon as possible.

Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

Entry Times

Regular entry times **Wednesday 10am - 2pm** and **Thursday 5pm - 9pm**. If there are more than two Rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries, if not already printed in Newsletter.

When **NOMINATING** you must have your **membership number** as no entries will be accepted without it. When **CANCELLING** you must give your **reference number AND membership number**, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait to be given your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

Day members

Day members must enter as above to obtain a reference number. **Men \$15, Ladies \$12** (you must sign day membership book before competing at the rodeo and you will receive a \$5 refund) and **Juniors \$5** day membership (a parent's or guardian's signature is required on the form before any junior will be eligible to compete).

All entry money plus day membership money must be received by **12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo**. Failure to receive this money will result in your entry not being accepted.

Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. All **late entries** must be automatically accompanied by a **\$20 late fine** and **Juniors \$5 late fine**. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number.

Cancellations

Any cancellations from 12 noon Monday to Thursday 9pm preceding the rodeo incur a payment of **committee levy plus \$5** (with or without Vet/Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur **full payment of entry fee** unless a Vet/Doctor's certificate is supplied, then only the **committee levy and \$5** will be paid. After 12 noon Friday **NO** cancellations will be accepted by the NRA office.

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur **full entry fee plus \$25** turn out fine. *No messages are to be left on the answering machine after Thursday as the Central Entries Office is closed.* Any entries not paid by the end of the first round will incur a **late payment fine of \$25**.

The numbers for the following rodeo will be available at 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo. Any queries contact the Executive Director of Events Steve Doneathy.
