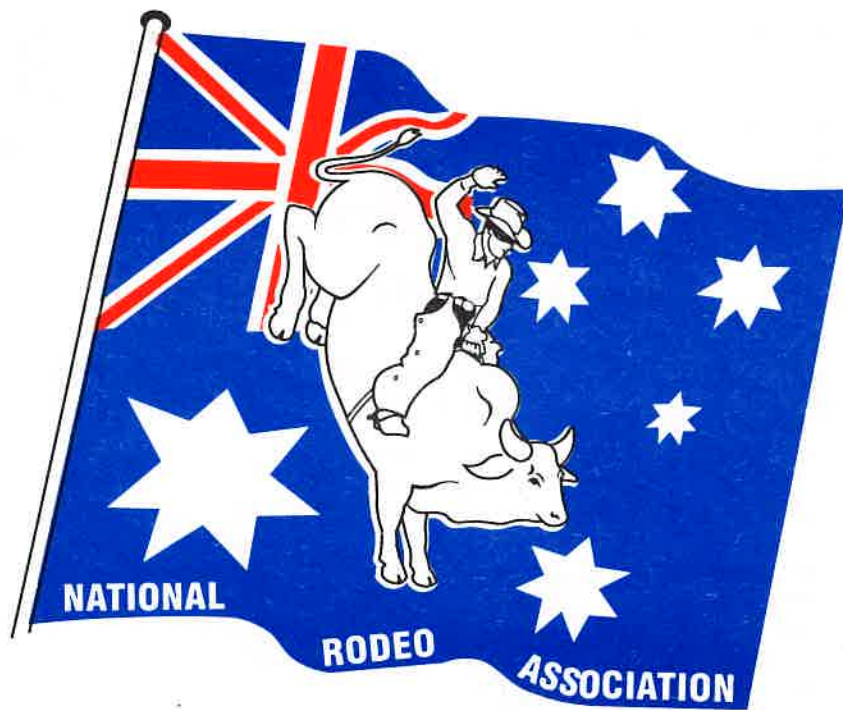

FRIENDLY REMINDERS

REFERENCE NUMBERS:

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number there will be NO investigation of your inquiry, if there are any problems with your entries at a Rodeo.

Please have a pen ready and write your reference number in the space provided on the Central Entry Page of your newsletter.

CANCELLATIONS:

When cancelling, either by phone or on answering machine you must state the name of the Rodeo, your name, reference number, and membership number. Without this information cancellations cannot be processed and will not be accepted.

PAYMENT OF FINES:

Any money owed for (fines, turnouts etc) must be paid in full by **Monday prior to the rodeo** at which you next wish to compete. If an infringement occurs on the day of the Rodeo the Central Entries officer at that Rodeo has the facility available to accept any owings for turnouts or fines etc on that particular day. This will ensure your entries will be valid for the next rodeo you have entered.

MEDICAL OUTS / INSURANCE CLAIMS:

If a Medical out is found necessary at a Rodeo, if injured on the day, and unable to compete again, a **medical certificate** must be obtained from the Ambulance on the grounds and submitted to the Central Entries Officer on the day, before the event concludes. This is essential, otherwise a turn out fine is mandatory.

Insurance Claims forms, if applicable, are available from the Central Entries Officer (on the day) and must be completed and faxed through to the office (0754 957384) by **Monday following the Rodeo**.

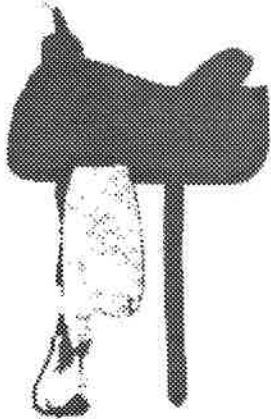

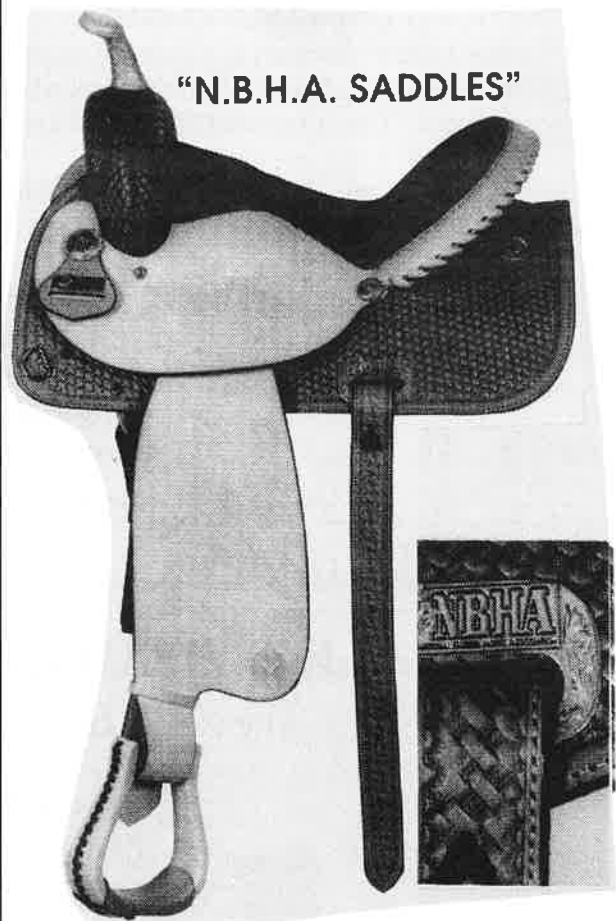

Appaloosa Queen Rides High for Murgon

"Numb all over!"

That's what Murgon's Nicki Kennedy felt when she was crowned Australian Appaloosa Queen at the 25th National Appaloosa Anniversary show this year.

Her success has put Murgon on the map nationally and internationally.

"It was something I have wanted for some time and it came true. It was so unbelievable," she said. "I haven't come down yet. I am still up in the clouds."

Mrs Kennedy will still be up in the clouds when she flies to Oklahoma City as part of her prize. She will represent Australia at the 50th Anniversary Appaloosa show and spend two weeks in the United States. People from all over America will be attending the show and she said she was looking forward to taking part in the opening pageant.

"I will take part in their Grand Entry which I am really looking forward to," Mrs Kenney said. "As well, I will be taking part in a parade of western clothes. It will really be full on during the time I am there but I hope I will be able to get into the country to see some farms."

Mrs Kennedy was crowned before an audience of 300 at the presentation dinner in Tamworth. She said the quest is one of Australia's most prestigious because the prize is an overseas trip.

"The Americans provide accommodation and I will be staying with the current Miss Appaloosa America, Lisa Lang," she said. "I met her at Tamworth and will now be her 'roomie'."

To win her title, Mrs Kennedy was the highest quest



fund-raiser and also won the appearance and personality and knowledge sections. She was only one point off winning the horsemanship section. Part of Nicki's prize also was a beaded crown designed here in Australia but made by an American Blackfoot Indian. Each year the design is different. Nicki's crown has the Australian Wattle at the front with the Australian Appaloosa Association Ltd Logo on either side and flowers which come from an Indian beadwork design.

Nicki has a very busy schedule this year with the USA trip, Dubbo NSW State Show in September, Victoria in December and hopefully New Zealand in Jan/Feb 1998. She will also be attending many other functions and shows throughout the year.

Nicki is hoping during her reign to promote the Appaloosa in Rodeo as there are some very talented horses already on the circuit.

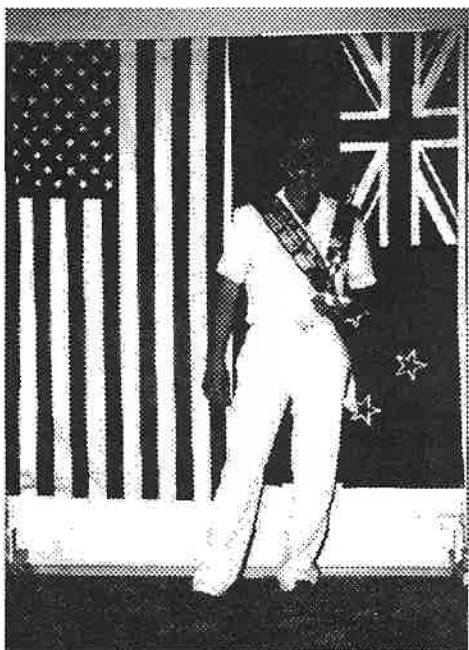

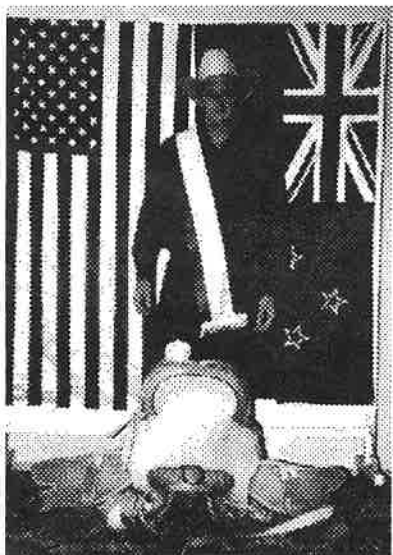

Besides, we wouldn't want to make a liar out of that spectator now, would we?

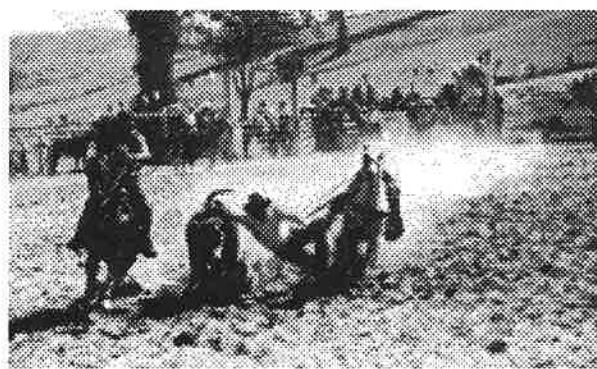

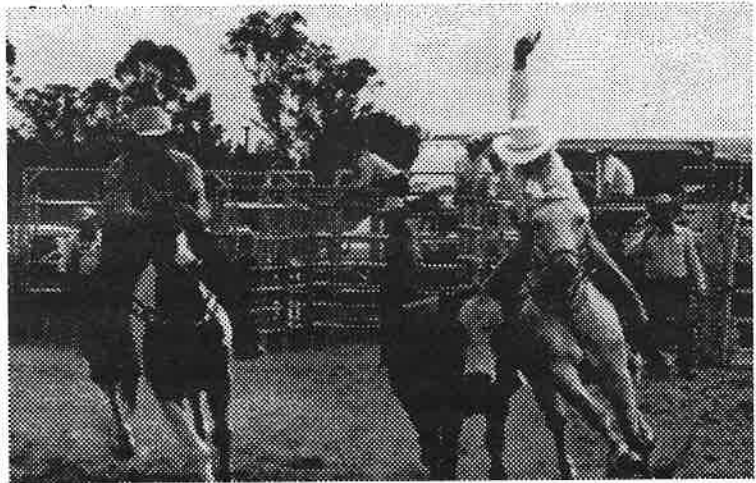

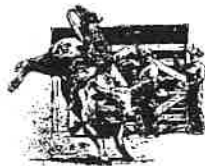

Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

Entry Times

Regular entry times **Wednesday 10am - 2pm** and **Thursday 5pm - 9pm**. If there are more than two Rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries, if not already printed in Newsletter.

When **NOMINATING** you must have your **membership number** as no entries will be accepted without it. When **CANCELLING** you must give your **reference number AND membership number**, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait to be given your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

Day members

Day members must enter as above to obtain a reference number. **Men \$15, Ladies \$12** (you must sign day membership book before competing at the rodeo and you will receive a \$5 refund) and **Juniors \$5** day membership (a parent's or guardian's signature is required on the form before any junior will be eligible to compete).

All entry money plus day membership money must be received by **12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo**. Failure to receive this money will result in your entry not being accepted.

Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. All late entries must be automatically accompanied by a **\$20 late fine** and **Juniors \$5 late fine**. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number. It is up to the discretion of the committees whether late entries will be accepted or not.

Cancellations

Any cancellations from 12 noon Monday to Thursday 9pm preceding the rodeo incur a payment of **committee levy plus \$5** (with or without Vet/Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur **full payment of entry fee** unless a Vet/Doctor's certificate is supplied, then only the **committee levy and \$5** will be paid. After 12 noon Friday **NO** cancellations will be accepted by the NRA office.

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur **full entry fee plus \$25** turn out fine. *No messages are to be left on the answering machine after Thursday as the Central Entries Office is closed.* Any entries not paid by the end of the first round will incur a **late payment fine of \$25**.

Contractors

The numbers for the following rodeo will be available at 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo. Any queries contact the Executive Director of Events Steve Doneathy.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE 12 NOON MONDAY PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRIES NOT BEING ACCEPTED.
