

Friendly Reminders

REFERENCE NUMBERS:

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number there will be NO investigation of your inquiry, if there are any problems with your entries at a Rodeo.

Please have a pen ready and write your reference number in the space provided on the Central Entry Page of your newsletter.

CANCELLATIONS:

When cancelling, either by phone or on answering machine you must state the name of the Rodeo, your name, reference number, and membership number. Without this information, cancellations cannot be processed and will not be accepted.

PAYMENT OF FINES:

Any money owed for (fines, turnouts etc) must be paid in full by Monday prior to the rodeo at which you next wish to compete. If an infringement occurs on the day of the Rodeo, the Central Entries officer at that Rodeo has the facility available to accept any owings for turnouts or fines etc on that particular day. This will ensure your entries will be valid for the next rodeo you have intered.

MEDICAL OUTS / INSURANCE CLAIMS:

If a Medical out is found necessary at a Rodeo, if injured on the day, and unable to compete again, a medical certificate must be obtained from the Ambulance on the grounds and submitted to the Central Entries Officer on the day, before the event concludes. This is essential, otherwise a turn out fine is manditory.

Insurance Claims forms, if applicable, are available from the Central Entries Officer (on the day) and must be completed and faxed through to the office (0754 957384) by Monday following the Rodeo.

(You may find that by trying the Central Entries on Wednesday that it is easier to get through and less of a headache)



Laurie & Nancy Howard

20 years is a long TIME!!

Too many years ago for most of us to remember - back in the 40s, a very young Laurie Howard began his Rodeo Career in Darwin. These beginnings included competing in Rodeos of the times, travelling with Tent Shows such as Tex Mortons.

This interest continued over the years and after moving to Imbil, Laurie competed and became interested in contracting bulls for S.E.Q.R.R.A.

The Bull Contractors of these days were the Kelihers and Mahwinneys and Morgans.

Starting out and getting a "String" together was not an easy task.


As an example Laurie once bought 100 bulls and did not get one Rodeo Bull out of them!!!

Speaking to Pat Speedy one day while looking at his bulls Laurie said," I like the look of those bulls" Pats reply was "Take them home and you'll like them better"

Laurie reckons there is no breed which makes a good bucking bull - mongrel breds make the best bucking bulls -you want then hookin' and lookin'. It has been heard said that you would never want one of Laurie Howards bulls in your herd.

He often told Bill Urquhart to "Hang in there, we'll get there, I'll get a string together" and get it together he did. Laurie and Nancy Howard started contracting in 1977 and continued through tragedy and triumph until 1997.


Laurie continued his illustrious Rodeo Career riding "Point Look Out" for a record 77 points at S.E.Q.R.R.A. Rodeo at Pomona in 1978 (for which he received \$120 and a ribbon). This record was held for three years when it was equalled.



In 1980 they built their own arena and started Practice days. Their first bull riding school was held in 1982 and was run by Steve Hilton. Names also mentioned here were Norm Hilton. Dale Laffey, Mark (Sparrow) Brennan and Shane Connoly to name a few. Some we still see competing today.

Laurie "rode" his last bull at Kenilworth in 1987, "Holy Muskalilly". We have proof he was really on the bull!!!!

The first Mary Valley Rodeo was run at Lawrie and Nancy's Arena by S.E.Q.R.R.A. in 1981 and continued until 1989.



The tragedies: A truck accident going to Mt Mee in 1989 lost six (6) bulls "Turn or Burn", "Old Smokey", "Dairy Hand", "Fogarty", and two young ones. "Freddy Come Lately" was also hurt and had six months off Rodeo.

"Charlie Sampson" Bucking Bull of the Year 1992


Laurie and Nancy Howard were awarded Life Membership of S.E.Q.R.R.A. in 1987 for their support to the Association.

Many of the Howards Bulls really lived up to their names - "Hat Rack" - had horns that you could use as a hat rack and used them really well when he once wrecked a car. "Holy Muscally" - named after a saying of Alan Henderson - a sports comentator of the region. "Charlie Sampson" - a World Champion and a world champion bull. "Shirralee" - was a burden to begin with, being reared by the house cow "Daisey" and a bucket, going on to buck as a junior bull then into open bulls for nine years with nine qualified rides and two years unridden in that time. Obviously he didn't like the burden of a cowboy on his back.

"Idi Ahmin" a real threat to all and cowboys, was a bucking bull from 1978 to 1990. He was a real favourite of the Howards and his horns are mounted on their lounge room wall. At home he was like a pussy cat but in the arena with a cowboy on his back he was really something to be contended with. Once in Laurie's Arena, Laurie was bucked off him and while clambering up the mesh

fence. It separated, leaving a hole above his head, which Idi took advantage of and jumped through the hole and out into the paddock where he was very content!



Insight into bucking horse stock

In 1990, Stuart Grayson and his wife Kris purchased a line of bucking horses, lead by the legend HONKY TONK. Stuart being a competitor for what is now 15 years, knows that competitors ride for the challenge. So with this in mind the Graysons fulfil this challenge by scouting Australia for top bucking horses to add to their existing string.

One horse in particular, CHARLIE PRIDE, a small bay mare with a big heart is proving a handful to all competitors, with scores of no less than 75 points if ridden.

The Grayson's home is an endless mantle piece with trophies and memorabilia showing a life lived with Rodeo. The great HONKY TONK, 1992, 1993, and 1994 Bareback Horse of the Year, CHARLIE PRIDE, 1994 Saddle Bronk Horse of the Year, and again in 1995 by the Australian Rodeo Council, all taking center stage.

Stuart knows his stock individually and his pick up team have safety as first their priority. This priority is an example of why Stuart will always pick up his stock and why he was chosen 1995 Pick Up Man of the Year by the National Rodeo Council.

Anyone who is close to Stuart and Kris Grayson knows that their stock takes first priority in their lives. The horses are not just bucking horses but are added to the list of family. That's why the death of HONKY TONK in May 1995 was a private matter and songs and poems written are something to remember.

As the interest in Rodeo for young people in the last few years has increased, so has the demand for Stuart to instruct at his own schools.

Stuart has numerous titles to his belt and is still heavily involved in Rodeo.

### **Central Entry Rules and Guidelines**

#### Entry Times

Regular entry times **Wednesday 10am - 2pm** and **Thursday 5pm - 9pm.** If there are more than two Rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries, if not already printed in Newsletter.

When **NOMINATING** you must have your **membership number** as no entries will be accepted without it. When **CANCELLING** you must give your **reference number** AND **membership number**, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

#### Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait to be given your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

**Resignation** from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

### Day members

Day members must enter as above to obtain a reference number. Men \$15, Ladies \$12 (you must sign day membership book before competing at the rodeo and you will receive a \$5 refund) and Juniors \$5 day membership (a parent's or guardian's signature is required on the form before any junior will be eligible to compete).

All entry money plus day membership money must be received by 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in your entry not being accepted.

### Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

#### Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. All late entries must be automatically accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$5 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number.

#### Cancellations

Any cancellations from 12 noon Monday to Thursday 9pm preceding the rodeo incur a payment of committee levy plus \$5 (with or without Vet/Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet/Doctor's certificate is supplied, then only the committee levy and \$5 will be paid. After 12 noon Friday NO cancellations will be accepted by the NRA office.

#### Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. No messages are to be left on the answering machine after Thursday as the Central Entries Office is closed. Any entries not paid by the end of the first round will incur a late payment fine of \$25.

### **Contractors**

The numbers for the following rodeo will be available at 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo. Any queries contact the Executive Director of Events Steve Doneathy.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE 12 NOON MONDAY PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRIES NOT BEING ACCEPTED.
