It has been brought to my attention that there have been instances where stock contractors have allowed bulls to be entered into draws without the horns being correctly tipped. Please remember that all horns are to be tipped to a 20 cent piece. All stock not tipped will be withdrawn from the event and the onus will be on the contractor to find replacement stock for the draw.

It appears that there have been some queries with regard to the judging of some events. If you have any queries regarding the judging of a particular event, these queries should be channelled through your Event Director, who would take the case up on your behalf. Whilst judges are paid to adjudicate as they see fit, their decision is final.

To finish on a more cheery note, plans are well under way for our end of year finals, with the best stock and cowboys to be available. This should hopefully prove to be a big crowd puller.

If anyone has any queries or needs any advice regarding rodeo activities, please do not hesitate to contact myself.

Insurance Claims

Insurance Claims must be faxed through to office (07 5495 8668) by Monday following the Rodeo. If a Medical Out is found necessary at a Rodeo, if injured, and unable to compete again on that day, a Medical Certificate must be obtained by the Ambulance on the grounds and submitted to the Central Entries Officer on the day. It is necessary for the Payouts and must be submitted as soon as possible.

OFFICIALS PLEASE NOTE - Re INSURANCE

For persons officiating in the arena at a rodeo eg bullfighters, judges etc, insurance is available at \$5.00 per day. It is their responsibility to contact the Central Entries person on the day before the rodeo commences if they require this cover.

Central Entry Rules and Guidelines

Entry Times

Regular entry times **Wednesday 10am - 2pm** and **Thursday 5pm - 9pm.** If there are more than two Rodeos, an additional entry time may be added and will be on the answering machine after Thursday's entries, if not already printed in Newsletter.

When **NOMINATING** you must have your **membership number** as no entries will be accepted without it. When **CANCELLING** you must give your **reference number** AND **membership number**, as without these no cancellation will be accepted.

Members

When nominating please state the rodeo, your name, your membership number, the events and if you are a novice. Wait to be given your reference number.

Unfinancial members - nominations will not be accepted until membership is paid in full.

Resignation from the association is required in writing. Such person/s will not be eligible to compete using day membership within a period of three (3) calendar months from the date of resignation.

Day members

Day members must enter as above to obtain a reference number. Men \$15, Ladies \$12 (you must sign day membership book before competing at the rodeo and you will receive a \$5 refund) and Juniors \$5 day membership (a parent's or guardian's signature is required on the form before any junior will be eligible to compete).

All entry money plus day membership money must be received by 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. Failure to receive this money will result in your entry not being accepted.

Reference Number

Your reference number is unique to you. Without this number, there will be no investigation of your claim if there are any problems with your entry.

Late Entries

Late entries will be accepted up until 12 noon of Monday preceding the Rodeo. All late entries must be automatically accompanied by a \$20 late fine and Juniors \$5 late fine. To submit a late entry, call Central Entries on Friday during Office hours or Monday before 12 noon preceding the Rodeo and you will be given a reference number.

Cancellations

Any cancellations from 12 noon Monday to Thursday 9pm preceding the rodeo incur a payment of committee levy plus \$5 (with or without Vet/Doctor's certificate). Any cancellations after 9pm Thursday preceding the rodeo and draw will incur full payment of entry fee unless a Vet/Doctor's certificate is supplied, then only the committee levy and \$5 will be paid. After 12 noon Friday NO cancellations will be accepted by the NRA office.

Fines

Turn out or scratching will incur full entry fee plus \$25 turn out fine. No messages are to be left on the answering machine after Thursday as the Central Entries Office is closed. Any entries not paid by the end of the first round will incur a late payment fine of \$25.

Contractors

The numbers for the following rodeo will be available at 12 noon Tuesday preceding the rodeo. Any queries contact the Executive Director of Events Steve Doneathy.

ALL OUTSTANDING MONIES OWING MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE 12 NOON MONDAY PRECEDING THE RODEO. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUEST WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRIES NOT BEING ACCEPTED.
